







METHOD USED TO FIND A JOB, 2016








100 UNEMPLOYMENT BY EDUCATION LEVEL, 2017









POPULATION PYRAMID (1 January 2017)












POPULATION AT RISK OF POVERTY OR SOCIAL EXCLUSION









YOUNG PEOPLE AGED 17-28 IN TERTIARY EDUCATION, 2015/16




TERTIARY EDUCATION GRADUATES AGED 21-29











OFFENDERS BY AGE GROUP, 2016







CRIMINALITY OF YOUNG PERSONS AGED 7-29
