## 2011 Population and Housing Census

## Fertility Statistics

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT), after having processed and checked all the variables included in the questionnaires of the 2011 Population-Housing Census, announces the results on women's fertility in Greece.

Fertility is among the demographic variables covered by the Population-Housing Census. It should be noted that ELSTAT has already announced data on the main demographic characteristics (sex, age, marital status, citizenship, data on households and family nucleus) of the population in other press releases.

The number of women aged 10 years and over in Greece amounted to $5,000,444$; out of this number $1,710,051(34.2 \%)$ women have not given birth to any children. In Greece, the mean age of mother at birth of the first child is 25.5 years.

Table 1 presents the distribution of women aged 10 years and over by age group, according to the number of children they have given birth to.

The data provided in the above table indicate that $80 \%$ of women aged 20 years and over, belonging to the age group $20-29$, have not given birth to any children, while for the age group 30-39 years the corresponding share is $34.4 \%$.

In Greece, the average number of children per woman that has given birth to a child is 2.15 children.

Table 2 shows the distribution of women aged 10 years and over according to the number of children they have given birth to, by Region.

Graph 1 below depicts the percentage distribution of women aged 10 years and over, according the number of children they have given birth to, by Region.

Graph 1. Percentage distribution of women aged 10 years and over by number of children they have given birth to and Region (NUTS 2)


Available data on the percentage distribution of women aged 10 years and over in each Regional Unit, in relation to the number of children they have given birth to, indicate that: the Regional Unit of the Central Section of Athens accounts for the largest share of women that have not given birth to any children, with $42.1 \%$; Syros with $18.8 \%$ accounts for the largest share of women who have given birth to 1 child; Thasos records the highest percentage, $44.8 \%$, of women that have given birth to 2 children; Evrytania, with $30.20 \%$, accounts for the largest share of women that have given birth to 3 or more children.

Graphs 3 and 4 below illustrate the percentage distribution of women aged 10 years and over that have given birth to at least one child, according to the mother's age at birth of the first and last child, respectively. It should be noted that out of the total number of women in Greece aged 10 years and over, 1,710,051 (34.2\%) women have not given birth to any children.

Furthermore, on the basis of the wealth of information made available by the Population-Housing Census, data can be compiled on the distribution of women aged 10 years and over by educational attainment, employment status and citizenship according to the number of children they have given birth to. The aforementioned variables are presented in Tables 4, 5 and 6. Similarly, Tables 4A, 5A and 6A illustrate the distribution of women aged 18 years and over by the variables mentioned above and according to the number of children they have given birth to.

## METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

## 1. Legal Framework

The conduct of the General Censuses of Population-Housing and Buildings is provided for in article 10 of the Law 3832/2010 "Hellenic Statistical System (ELSS) Establishment of the Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) as an independent authority". In particular, the 2011 Censuses of Buildings and of Population - Housing were conducted on the basis of Presidential Decree 168 (Government Gazette 223, issue A/2008) and in compliance with the methodological principles of Regulation (EC) 763/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council and its implementing Regulations related to Population and Housing Censuses, the Joint Ministerial Decision 1524/Г5-473 (Government Gazette 425, issue B/2011) and its amendment (Government Gazette 783, issue B/2011), and with the Legislative Act relating to the Conduct of the Population-Housing Census (Government Gazette 106 issue A/2011), as it was ratified by the Law 3995/2011 (Government Gazette 166 issue A/2011).

## 2. Purpose

The purpose of the General Censuses is to collect data on the Resident Population of the Country, the demographic, economic and social characteristics of the population, their housing conditions and the characteristics of their dwellings, along with data on the stock of buildings of the Country.

## 3. Statistical concepts and definitions

3.1 Resident Population: the total number of persons normally residing in a specified geographical area for a period of at least 12 months prior to the date of conduct of the Census, or who have arrived at the place of usual residence during the last 12 months, with the intention to reside in the area for at least 1 year.
