PRESS RELEASE SURVEY ON TERTIARY EDUCATION (TECHNOLOGICAL INSTITUTIONS) END OF SCHOOL YEAR 2016/2017

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces statistical data on Tertiary Education (Technological Institutions) for the end of school year 2016/2017. On the basis of available survey data:


- The number of enrolled undergraduate students in all Technological Institutions (TEI) in the academic year 2016/2017 increased by 1.3% in comparison with 2015/2016 (from 221,730 to 224,611). A significant increase is observed for the Higher Schools for Services (20.3%) and for TEI of Athens (18.5%) during the same period (Table 1).
- Teaching staff in all Technological Institutions in the academic year 2016/2017 increased by 6.2% in comparison with 2015/2016, with the largest increases being observed in ASPETE (45.2), TEI of Eastern Macedonia & Thrace (31.3%) and TEI of Ipeiros (21.5%). However, the Technological Institutions of Western Greece and Ionian Islands recorded a decrease of 11.4% and 10.3%, respectively (Table 2).
- The number of graduates from undergraduate programs in the academic year 2016/2017 decreased by 10.1% in comparison with 2015/2016. However, there was an increase of graduates from the TEI of Athens, Merchant Marine Academies and Artistic Schools by 1.7%, 16.9% and 64.7% respectively (Table 3).
- Enrolled postgraduate students in the academic year 2016/2017 increased (32.6%) in comparison with 2015/2016 because new postgraduate programmes were launched in various Technological Institutions (Table 4).
- Postgraduate students that graduated in the academic year 2016/2017 increased by 20.0% in comparison with 2015/2016. The highest rates are observed in ASPETE and the TEI of Athens (Table 5).



EXPLANATORY NOTES

Survey on Tertiary Education (University Sector)	Tertiary Education consists of two domains: i) University Sector including Universities, Polytechnic Schools, the Athens School of Fine Arts and ii) the Technological Sector including the Technological Educational Institutes (TEI), the School of Pedagogical and Technological Education (ASPETE), the Academies of Merchant Shipping, Ecclesiastical Academies, Schools of Services and Artistic Schools. The current survey refers to the Technological Sector and is conducted annually. The aim is to collect data on enrolled undergraduate, postgraduate and doctorate students, undergraduate and postgraduate students that graduated, as well as the number of the teaching staff.
