COMMERCIAL TRANSACTIONS OF GREECE : February 2017

(Provisional Data)

The total value of imports-arrivals, in February 2017 amounted to 4,085.2 million euros (4,334.8 million dollars) in comparison with 3,588.6 million euros (3,968.9 million dollars) in February 2016, recording an increase, in euros, of **13.8%**. The corresponding change excluding oil products in February 2017 recorded an increase of 72.8 million euros or 2.5% and the corresponding change excluding oil products and ships in February 2017, recorded a drop of 69.1 million euros or 2.5% (Table 1).

The total value of exports-dispatches, in February 2017 amounted to 2,107.4 million euros (2,249.6 million dollars) in comparison with 1,908.5 million euros (2,123.4 million dollars) in February 2016, recording an increase, in euros, of **10.4%**. The corresponding change excluding oil products recorded in February 2017 a drop of 17.2 million euros or 1.1% and the corresponding change excluding oil products and ships in February 2017 recorded a drop of 14.5 million euros or 1.0% (Table 1).

The deficit of the trade balance, in February 2017 amounted to 1,977.8 million euros (2,085.2 million dollars) in comparison with 1,680.1 million euros (1,845.5 million dollars) in February 2016, recording an increase, in euros, of **17.7%**. The corresponding change of deficit excluding oil products in February 2017 recorded an increase of 90.0 million euros or 6.2% and the corresponding change excluding oil products and ships in February 2017 recorded a drop of 54.6 million euros or 4.4% (Table 1).

The total value of imports-arrivals, for the 2-month period from January to February 2017 amounted to 8,560.8 million euros (9,071.4 million dollars) in comparison with 6,524.1 million euros (7,147.1 million dollars) for the corresponding period of the year 2016, recording an increase, in euros, of **31.2 %⁽¹⁾**, mostly on account of the imports of ships from Third Countries in January 2017. The corresponding change excluding oil products recorded an increase of 1,154.8 million euros or 21.5% and the corresponding change excluding oil products and ships recorded an increase of 203.4 million euros or 4.0% (Table 5).

The total value of exports-dispatches, for the 2-month period from January to February 2017 amounted to 4,242.5 million euros (4,522.7 million dollars) in comparison with 3,624.4 million euros (3,992.4 million dollars) for the corresponding period of the year 2016, recording an increase, in euros, of **17.1%**. The corresponding change excluding oil products recorded an increase of 75.9 million euros or 2.7% and the corresponding change excluding oil products and ships recorded an increase of 53.4 million euros or 1.9% (Table 5).

The deficit of the Trade Balance, for the 2-month period from January to February 2017 amounted to 4,318.3 million euros (4,548.7 million dollars) in comparison with 2,899.7 million euros (3,154.7 million dollars) for the corresponding period of the year 2016, recording an increase, in euros, of **48.9%⁽¹⁾**, mostly on account of the imports of ships from Third Countries in January 2017. The corresponding change excluding oil products recorded an increase of 1,078.9 million euros or 42.4% and the corresponding change excluding oil products and ships recorded an increase of 150.0 million euros or 6.7% (Table 5).

The monthly data of Intra EU transactions, have been adjusted to the total trade transactions with EU countries, (including the transactions below the statistical threshold ⁽²⁾), on the basis of the Recapitulative Statements of Intra-EU Deliveries and Acquisitions that are submitted by the enterprises in the Ministry of Finance. Accordingly, the provisional data from the "incomplete customs declarations" have been incorporated in the monthly data on trade with third countries and, after having been completed, they will be replaced by the final data.

⁽¹⁾ The big increase in imports for the 2-month period from January to February 2017 depicted in Tables 5,6 and 7 reflects, to a great extent, the increase in the imports of ships from Third Countries in January 2017. This increase has also an impact on the significant increase in the deficit of the trade balance for the 2-month period from January to February 2017.

⁽²⁾ By virtue of EU Regulations on the compilation of intra-EU trade statistics, Member States set out a "statistical exemption threshold". On the basis of the exemption threshold, the enterprises whose transactions are below the statistical threshold are exempted from the obligation to submit data on their intra-Community transactions (Intrastat declaration). The aim is to reduce the burden on enterprises. The statistical exemption threshold, valid for each year, is specified and released by ELSTAT on a yearly basis.

Diagram 1. Imports - Arrivals, Exports - Dispatches including oil products, February 2015-2017, million €



Diagram 2. Imports - Arrivals, Exports - Dispatches excluding oil products, February 2015-2017, million €



Diagram 3. Imports - Arrivals, Exports - Dispatches excluding oil products and ships, February 2015-2017, million €





Diagram 5. Imports - Arrivals, Exports - Dispatches excluding oil products, January - February 2017, million €



Diagram 6. Imports - Arrivals, Exports - Dispatches excluding oil products and ships, January - February 2017, million €



Diagram 7a. Percentage (%) distribution of E.U. arrivals by SITC sections, February 2017




Diagram 7b. Percentage (%) distribution of Third countries imports by SITC sections, February 2017




Diagram 8a Percentage (%) distribution of E.U. dispatches by SITC sections, February 2017




Diagram 8b. Percentage (%) distribution of Third countries exports by SITC sections, February 2017




Diagram 9. Imports - Arrivals E.U. & Third countries by SITC sections, Jan. - Feb. 2017 million €




Diagram 10. Exports - Dispatches E.U. & Third countries by SITC sections, Jan. -Feb. 2017 million €







EXPLANATORY NOTES

Commercial Transactions of Greece	The Commercial Transactions of Greece are recorded on a monthly basis aiming at monitoring the total value of Imports-Arrivals, Exports-Dispatches as well as the relevant changes of the above-mentioned categories. Transactions referring to services are not included, while they are taken into account for the compilation of the National Accounts tables, along with the commercial transactions.
Legal Framework	<p>The survey is conducted in compliance with the requirements laid down in the following E.U. In compliance with the obligations provided in the EU Regulations regarding the compilation of external trade statistics, these transactions are calculated on the basis of the Recapitulative Statements of Intra-EU Deliveries and Acquisitions that all the enterprises are obliged to submit to the Ministry of Finance.</p> <p>ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION: Intrastat declarations are submitted electronically via the following links: http://eurostat.statistics.gr or www.statistics.gr.</p> <p>EXTRASTAT: It is a statistical survey where data are collected by administrative sources.
