

PRESS RELEASE SURVEY ON TERTIARY EDUCATION (UNIVERSITIES) END OF ACADEMIC YEAR 2016/2017

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces statistical data on Tertiary Education (Universities) for the end of academic year 2016/2017. On the basis of available survey data:

- The number of **enrolled undergraduate students** in all universities in the academic year 2016/2017 increased by 3.2% in comparison to 2015/2016 (from 396,814 to 409,413) (Table 1).
- Teaching staff in all universities in the academic year 2016/2017 increased by 5.9% in comparison to 2015/2016. However, the School of Fine Arts, the National Technical University of Athens and the Agricultural University of Athens recorded a decrease of 28.8%, 2.5% and 1.6% respectively (Table 2).
- The number of graduates from undergraduate programmes in the academic year 2016/2017 decreased by 3.2% in comparison to 2015/2016. The highest decrease was observed at the Athens School of Fine Arts (24.7%), the University of Western Macedonia (23.2%), the University of Thrace (17.8%) and the University of Athens (13.2%) (Table 3).
- Enrolled postgraduate students in the academic year 2016/2017 increased by 25.2% in comparison to 2015/2016. The highest increase was observed at the Athens School of Fine Arts, the University of Peloponnese and the University of Western Macedonia by 66.4%, 53.4% and 45.6% respectively. On the contrary, a decrease was observed in the Agricultural University of Athens (25.4%) and the National Technical University of Athens (5.8%) (Table 4).
- Postgraduate students that graduated in the academic year 2016/2017 increased by 15.2% in comparison to 2015/2016 apart from the Ionian University, the University of Macedonia, Harokopio University, the National Technical University of Athens, and the Agricultural University of Athens where there was a decrease of 42.3%, 13.1%, 10.5%, 7.5% and 6.2% respectively (Table 5).
- Enrolled doctorate students in the academic year 2016/2017 decreased by 14.3% in comparison to 2015/2016 given the fact that from year to year the number of new entrants to doctoral programmes varies (Table 6).
- **Doctoral students that graduated** in the academic year 2016/2017 decreased by 6.3% in comparison to 2015/2016 (Table 7).









The aim is to collect data on enrolled undergraduate, postgraduate and doctorate students, undergraduate and postgraduate students that graduated, as well as the number of the teaching

staff.
