



PRESS RELEASE

Persons injured on board of ships and in sea areas of port authorities, 2016

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces the results of the 2016 survey on persons injured on board of ships and in sea areas under the competency of port authorities. Particularly:

- The number persons who were injured on board of ships or in areas under the competency port authorities amounted to 327. The total number of injured persons increased by 2.2% in 2016 compared with 2015. Similarly, the corresponding number in 2015 had increased by 7.7% in comparison with 2014. Out of the 327 persons who had an accident, the majority (80.4%) had a fatal accident (Table 1).
- Out of the 263 fatal accidents, 248 (94.3%) occurred in sea areas under the competency of port authorities and 15 (5.7%)) on board of the ships. Accordingly, out of the 64 not fatal accidents, 44 occurred in sea areas of port authorities and 20 on board of the ships (Table 1).
- As regards the age of the persons who were injured on board of ships or in sea areas, in 2016 58.7% (192 persons) were older than 65 years old, while the corresponding percentage for the same age group in 2015 was 60.3% (193 persons) and in 2014 56.2% (167 persons) (Table 2).
- Out of the 35 persons who were injured on board of ships in 2016, 15 persons were fatally injured (drowning or other cause of death) and 18 were slightly injured (sprain, strain or fracture). Out of the 292 persons who were injured in sea areas under the competence of port authorities, 248 persons were fatally injured (drowning or other cause of death), 23 persons suffered sprain, strain or fracture and 21 other injuries (Table 3).
- The total number of drowning increased by 13.0% (from 192 to 217), in 2016 compared with 2015, while, in 2015 it had increased by 8.5% (from 177 to 192) compared with 2014 (Table 3).
- Table 4 presents data on fatal accidents and missing persons from illegal entry in sea areas under the competency of Greek port authorities for the period 2010-2016. These data are not included in Tables 1-3.







EXPLANOTARY NOTES

Survey on persons injured in maritime accident

The survey on persons injured on board of ships or in areas of port authorities is conducted since 1975 on an annual basis. The purpose of the survey is to fully record the accidents (various injuries) of persons on board and accidents of persons in the sea, which took place in a port or on the coast area under the competency of the port authorities.

Legal framework

The survey is conducted pursuant to the provisions of the Permanent Circular No 1 of the Ministry of Economy and Finance and $\Gamma\Gamma$ ESYE dated 16/1/1975, which was replaced by the Permanent Joint Circular dated 15/4/1998, with retroactive effect since 1/1/1998.

Reference Period

The results of the survey refer to the year of 2016.

Coverage

The survey covers persons injured on board of the ships and in the port or on the coast areas under the competency of the port authorities. Particularly, it covers all cases of casualties for which a preliminary inquiry is conducted by the competent port authorities.

Definitions

Ship: Seagoing self-propelled vessel, of at least ten NRT, designed for the carriage of goods, transport of passengers, for fishing, towing or especially fitted out for other maritime activities.

Accidents: Refers to accidents that result to Contusion, strain, fracture, burn or scald, amputation, cerebral contusion, caisson disease, drowning and other cause of death.

Methodology

The domestic port authorities report to ELSTAT information about the persons injured on board of ships or in areas of port authorities. The information includes the sex, the year of birth, the place of birth, the citizenship, the marital status, the occupation and in particular, whether the injured persons was a seafarer or employed in the port area, whether he was a visitor, bather or on duty, where exactly the accident occurred, the date of the accident, who was responsible for the accident, the cause of the accident, the direct impact of the accident, the type of body injury. Besides that, information is recorded regarding accidents and missing persons who entered the country illegally sent to ELSTAT by the Headquarters of Port Authorities, Ministry of Shipping and Island Policy.
