

## Ad hoc Survey on labour market situation of migrants and their descendents

### User Oriented Quality Report

<b>Survey on labour market situation of migrants and their descendents</b>	The ad hoc module on labour market situation of migrants and their descendents was conducted during the 2 <sup>nd</sup> Quarter of 2008 together with Labour Force Survey. Main target of the survey was to collect information on the labour market situation of the persons that were born abroad and of the persons of foreign nationality. Additionally, and in order to identify "second generation migrants", all interviewed persons were asked about the country of birth of their parents. Information was collected also about the country of birth.
<b>Legislation</b>	Survey's specifications were determined by Commission Regulation 102/2007.
<b>Reference Period</b>	The reference period for the main survey variables was year 2008.
<b>Coverage</b>	Population 15 – 74 years old residing in private households, and staying (or intend to stay) at least 1 year in Greece. Individuals who permanently reside in collective houses (i.e. hospitals, hotels, asylums, homes for the elderly, orphanages, etc) are not covered by the survey.
<b>Definitions</b>	<p><b>Descendents of migrants:</b> Persons with at least one parent born in another country.</p> <p><b>Years of residence in Greece:</b> Years that elapsed since the last entrance of the person in the country, with the purpose of residing in Greece (and when the period from the last time that the person was residing in Greece was less than 1 year)</p> <p><b>Employed</b> are persons aged 15 years or older, who during the reference week worked, even for just one hour, for pay or profit or they were working in the family business, or they were not at work but had a job or business from which they were temporarily absent.</p> <p><b>Unemployed</b> are persons aged 15-74 who were without work during the reference week (they were not classified as employed), were currently available for work and were either actively seeking work in the past four weeks or had already found a job to start within the next three months.</p> <p><b>Inactive</b> are those persons who are neither classified as employed nor as unemployed.</p> <p><b>Economically active population (labour force)</b> are persons either employed or unemployed.</p> <p><b>Unemployment Rate</b> is the ratio of unemployed divided by total labour force.</p>
<b>Methodology</b>	The estimations of the Survey on labour market situation of migrants and their descendents are produced by a suitable unbiased estimator which takes in to account a) the probability of selection of every sampled household, b) the response rate in every primary sampling unit, c) the estimated population for the 2 <sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2009, allocated by NUTS II areas, gender and age group).
