**Building Activity Survey: February 2013**

According to provisional data published by the Hellenic Statistical Authority, in February 2013 the total Building Activity (private-public), in the whole country-which is calculated on the basis of the number of issued building permits in the whole country amounted to 1,240. This figure corresponds to 191,5 thousand m<sup>2</sup> of surface, and 761,3 thousand m<sup>3</sup> of volume, reflecting respectively a 45.3 % decrease in the number of building permits, a 48.0 % decrease in surface and a 47,0 % decrease in volume, compared to the month of 2012 (Table 1).

Private Building Activity, in the whole country, summed to 1,230 building permits, corresponding to 189.0 thousand m<sup>2</sup> of surface and 748.8 thousand m<sup>3</sup> of volume. In comparison with the same month of 2012, there is a 45.4 % decrease in the number of building permits, a 46.2% decrease in surface and a 44.8 % decrease in volume (Table 2).

Public Building Activity in the whole country in February 2013 amounted to 10 building permits, corresponding to 2.4 thousand m<sup>2</sup> of surface and 12.5 thousand m<sup>3</sup> of volume. The Public Building Activity accounted for the 1.6% of the total building volume in February 2013.

In the last twelve months, from March 2012 until February 2013, the total Building Activity (private-public) in the whole country, calculated on the basis of the number of issued building permits, amounted to 20,791. This figure corresponds to 3,917.4 thousand m<sup>2</sup> of surface and 15,311.9 thousand m<sup>3</sup> of volume, reflecting a 42.9 % decrease in the number of building permits, 36.1 % decrease in surface and a 34.7 % decrease in volume, compared with the corresponding period of March 2011 until February 2012 (Table 3).

In the same period from March 2012 until February 2013, Private Building Activity in the whole country recorded a 43.0 % decrease in the number of issued building permits, a 36.7% decrease in surface and a 35.3 % decrease in volume, compared with the respective period from March 2011 until February 2012 (Table 4). For the same period, the Public Building Activity accounted for the 4.1 % of the total building volume.

During the period January- February 2013, the total Building Activity (private-public) in the whole country recorded a 40.9 % decrease in the number of building permits, a 41.4 % decrease in surface and a 39.5 % decrease in volume, compared with the same period of the year 2012 (Table 5).

During the same period, January- February 2013, Private Building Activity in the whole country recorded a 40.6% decrease in the number of issued building permits, a 38.5 % decrease in surface and a 36.2 % decrease in volume, in comparison with the same period of January- February 2012 (Table 6).





## EXPLANATORY NOTES

|                                 |   |
|---------------------------------|---|
| <b>Building Activity Survey</b> | The Building Activity Survey has been providing data on a monthly and yearly basis, since 1964. The purpose of this survey is to register the total number of building permits issued by the responsible administrative authorities, which are devolved to complete the questionnaire. The survey covers all the features of building activity, such as the type of building permit, the type of construction, the type and the characteristics of the building and its auxiliary spaces, as well as building usage, surface, volume and value. |
| <b>Legal Framework</b>          | The survey is fully harmonized with the European legislation. The primary legislative act is Regulation (EU) 1165/1998, as it was amended according to Regulation (EU) 1158/2005.   |
| <b>Reference Period</b>         | 01/2/2013 to 28/2/2013  |
| <b>Coverage</b>                 | The survey is exhaustive and covers the total number of issued building permits across the country.   |
| <b>Definitions</b>              | <b>Building Permit</b> refers to all types of building permits. These are permits for new buildings or permits for additions, repair, renovation, demolition, legitimization, amendment and modification of a building.   |
|                                 | The denotation of "built-property" is equal to "building".  |
|                                 | <b>Building</b> is every permanent and independent structure, which has walls and a roof and consists of one or more rooms and other complementary spaces. Normally, buildings feature four walls. However, a construction open from one or even two sides will be considered a building, as long as it has a roof.   |
|                                 | <b>New building</b> is any built-property raised on an uncovered site or in the place of an old building that has been demolished.  |
|                                 | <b>Building Addition</b> is every construction that adds building volume (space) to an existing building, in terms of surface, height or both and creates a residence, a shop or both.  |
|                                 | <b>Building volume</b> (the net building volume) refers to the area that is included between the external surface of the external walls, the lowest level (the basement or the sub-basement, if it exists) and the roof of the building. If there is an open ground floor not enclosed within walls between the lower floor and the roof, its volume is taken into account. The relevant authorities calculate the volume of the building during the issuing of the building permit.  |
|                                 | <b>Surface of new-built property</b> is considered to be the sum of each floor space along with the outer space of the outer walls.   |
| <b>General Remark</b>           | Any delineation that may occur between the sum of sub totals and the totals is due to rounding.   |
