PRESS RELEASE

SURVEY ON PHYSIOTHERAPISTS, 2015

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) publishes, for the first time, a Press Release presenting data on physiotherapists, on the basis of the annual census survey on physiotherapists of the year 2015. The source data derive from the Pan-Hellenic Association of Physiotherapists of Greece, on the basis of its registered members. For comparability purposes, data for the years 2010-2014 are also provided.

During the period 2010-2015 the number of physiotherapists in Greece has been recording an increase. More specifically, the annual growth rate for the years 2010 to 2013 amounts, steadily, to 9%, for the years 2013-2014 to 3% and for 2014-2015 to 6% (Table 1, Graph 1).





The Region of Attiki accounts for almost the majority of the physiotherapists in Greece (45.5%), followed by Central Macedonia (17.3%), Western Greece (5.4%), Thessaly (5.3%) and Eastern Macedonia & Thrace (5.0%). The percentage distribution of physiotherapists in the other Regions is lower than 5.0%, with North Aegean, South Aegean and West Macedonia recording the lowest percentages (Graph 2).
