FOLLOW UP OF THE NUMBER OF PHYSICIANS AND DENTISTS, year 2017

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces data on the number of Physicians and Dentists, for the year 2017.

In 2017, the number of physicians, registered in the Physicians Associations all over Greece, amounted to 65,499, recording a decrease of 1.0% in comparison with the revised data of 2016¹. (Table 1, Graph 1)

The biggest percentage increase in the number of physicians was recorded in Ionia Nisia (4.9%) and in Thessalia (4.2%), while the biggest decrease was observed in Peloponnisos (-5.3%) and in Attiki (-2.3%).



As regards the breakdown of data by gender, it is observed that in 2017 the number of male physicians recorded an decrease of 0.2% compared with 2016 and the same trend was observed for female physicians who decreased by 2.1% (Tables 2a and 2b).

As regards medical specialties, the six most important, in terms of number of physicians for Greece total, were as follows: Pathologists, Paediatricians, Microbiologists, Cardiologists, General Practitioners and Obstetricians-Gynaecologists. In year 2017, an increase in the total number of physicians belonging to the six specialties above was observed compared to 2016, while a decrease was observed to the physician with other or without specialty (Table 3 and Graph 2).

In 2017 compared with 2016, no important change was recorded as regards the ratio of physicians to 10,000 inhabitants, by six main groups of specialties, for Greece total (Table 4, Graph 3).



Graph 3. Number of physicians per 10,000 inhabitants, by group of specialties, 2017




The total number of dentists in Greece has been increased in the last year. In 2017, the number of dentists registered in Dentists Association all over Greece amounted to 13,261, recording an increase of 0.3% in comparison with 2016. The biggest percentage increase in the number of dentists was recorded in Anatoliki Makedonia & Thraki (2.2%), followed by Dytiki Ellada (1.3%), while the biggest decrease was observed in Notio Aigaio (-3.9%) and Dytiki Makedonia (-2.9%) and Kriti (-2.4%) (Table 5, Graph 4 and 5).



As regards the breakdown of data by gender, it is observed that in 2017 compared with 2016, the number of male dentists recorded an increase of 0.8%, while the number of female dentists recorded a decrease of 0.2% (Tables 6a, and 6b).





Graph 6a. Male dentists by NUTS 1 Regions, 2012-2017




Graph 6b. Female dentists by NUTS 1 Regions, 2012-2017



EXPLANATORY NOTES

Survey on physicians and dentists	The Survey on physicians and dentists records, on a yearly basis, the number of physicians and dentists, who are registered in the Physicians and Dentists Associations all over Greece.
Reference period	The survey results refer to the 31th of December of the reference year.
Coverage	The survey covers Greece total. The data are collected at the level of the Regional Unit and published at the level and of the Region (NUTS 2) and at the level of the Department (NUTS 3).

Methodology	<p>The survey is a census survey conducted at the level of the Regional Unit and the data derive from the local Associations of Physicians and Dentists of Greece. As regards physicians, the surveyed variables are the number of physicians by gender, Regional Unit, age group, and specialty.</p> <p>As regards dentists, the surveyed variables are the number of dentists by gender, Regional Unit and age group.</p> <p>In Table 3 and Graph 2, the specialties presented in the group of specialties are in line with the joint Eurostat/OECD/WHO questionnaire as follows:</p> <p>“General medical practitioners” (include general practitioners, social medicine practitioners, and rural medical doctors), “General paediatricians” (include paediatricians), “Obstetricians-gynaecologists”, “Psychiatrists” (include psychiatrists, neurologist-psychiatrists and paedopsychiatrists).</p> <p>The “Medical group of specialists” encompasses Cardiologists, Endocrinologists, Gastroenterologists, Respiratory medicine practitioners, Oncologists, Immunologists, Neurologists, Oto-rhino-laryngologists, Radiologists, Microbiology-bacteriologists, Haematologists, Dermatologists, Pathologists, Occupational medicine practitioners, forensic doctors.</p> <p>The “Surgical group of specialists” includes surgeons, neuro-surgeons, vascular surgeons, plastic surgery, anesthesiologists, urologists, ophthalmologists, orthopedics surgery, nephrologists, children surgery, physical medicine and rehabilitation doctors.</p>

Legal frame The survey is conducted in line with the Statistical Law 3832/2010, as amended and in force. Furthermore, from 2010 onwards, the survey is conducted through the joint Eurostat/OECD/WHO questionnaire, under the name: “Eurostat Joint Questionnaire on non-monetary Health Care Statistics”.
