


MATERIAL COSTS INDEX IN CONSTRUCTION OF NEW RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS: January 2013

The Material Costs Index in Construction of New Residential Buildings in January 2013 compared with January 2012 recorded a decrease of 0.4%. The index in January 2012 had recorded an increase of 0.7% compared with January 2011 (Table 1).

The Material Costs Index in January 2013 compared with December 2012 recorded a decrease of 0.2%. The index had recorded an increase of 0.3% between January 2012 and December 2011 (Table 2).

The twelve-month average index, from February 2012 to January 2013, compared with the same index of the period from February 2011 to January 2012, increased by 0.5%. The previous year the twelve-month average index had increased by 2.2% (Table 3).

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METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

Generally	The compilation of the Material Costs Index in Construction of New Residential Buildings started in 1975. The index, in its current form, is compiled since January 2005, when it replaced the previous index with base year 2000.
Purpose of the index – definitions	The purpose of the index is to measure the monthly rates of change in the prices of building materials paid by the constructors and are consumed in the construction of new residential buildings.
	The Material Costs Index is a monthly index and consists a sub-index of the overall cost index in construction of new residential buildings.
	For the compilation of the index the selected prices of the materials are those which are actually paid by the construction enterprises for materials supplied at the site and do not include VAT.
Legal basis	The compilation of the Material Costs Index is governed by Council Regulation (EEC) No.1165/98 concerning short-term statistics and by Regulation No.1158/05 (amending the above mentioned Regulation) of the European Parliament and of the Council.
Reference period	Month
Base year	2005=100.0.
Revision	The Material Costs Index is a fixed base index. Pursuant to the provisions of Council Regulation No 1165/98 concerning short-term statistics, the index in question is updated every five (5) years on years ending in 0 or 5.
Statistical classification	The national classification which includes 89 categories of materials aggregated in 15 groups is followed.
Geographical coverage	The Index covers the whole of the country. The prices are collected in the biggest cities of the country (Greater Athens, Thessaloniki, Patras, Volos, Larisa and Herakleion).
Coverage of economic activities	The Material Costs Index in Construction of New Residential Buildings is an input index that refers to the prices paid for building materials by the constructors of new residential buildings.
Statistical survey	A total number of 1477 observations (prices) collected from 270 commercial or industrial enterprises supplying building materials, is used for the compilation of the index.
Publication of data	The index with the new base year (2005) is being released since February 2009, with January 2009 as the first reference month. Times series data with base year 2005=100.0, are available from January 2000 onwards.
