HELLENIC STATISTICAL AUTHORITY

**TERTIARY EDUCATION (UNIVERSITIES AND TECHNOLOGICAL INSTITUTIONS)
END OF ACADEMIC YEAR 2022/2023**

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces data on Tertiary Education (Universities and Technological Institutions) for the end of academic year 2022/2023. Based on the survey data on Tertiary Education:

- The number of **enrolled undergraduate students** in all tertiary education institutions in the academic year 2022/2023 decreased by 0.3% in comparison to 2021/2022 (Table 1).
- **Teaching staff** in all tertiary education institutions in the academic year 2022/2023 decreased by 5.4% in comparison to 2021/2022 (Table 2).
- The number of **graduates from undergraduate programmes** in the academic year 2022/2023 decreased by 0.8% in comparison to 2021/2022 (Table 3).
- **Enrolled postgraduate students** in the academic year 2022/2023 increased by 2.6% in comparison to 2021/2022 (Table 4).
- **Postgraduate students that graduated** in the academic year 2022/2023 increased by 11.5% in comparison to 2021/2022 (Table 5).
- **Enrolled doctorate students** in the academic year 2022/2023 decreased by 1.1% in comparison to 2021/2022 (Table 6).
- **Doctoral students that graduated** in the academic year 2022/2023 increased by 11.4% in comparison to 2021/2022 (Table 7).

Graph 1. Enrolled undergraduate students by educational institution, end of academic years 2021/2022 and 2022/2023

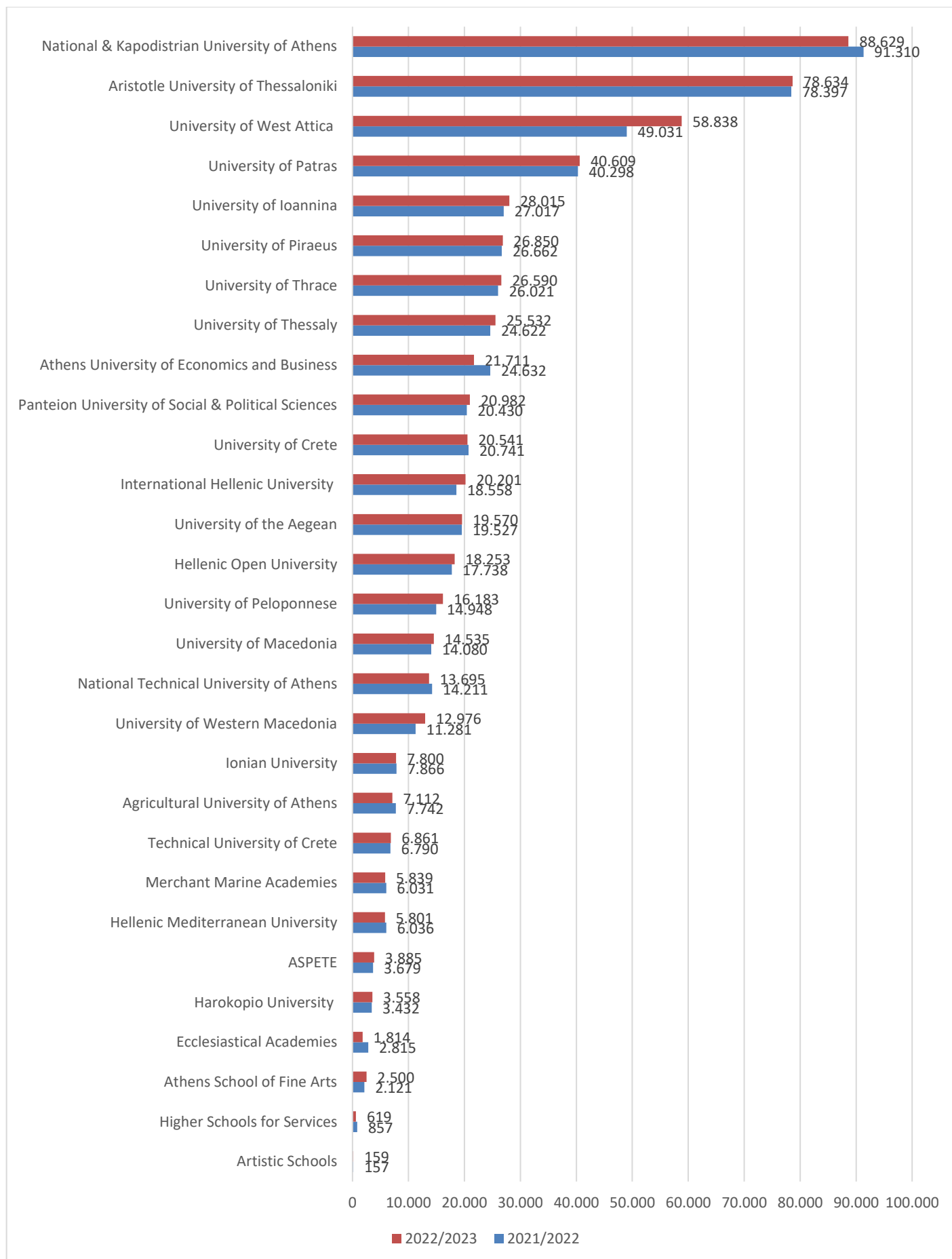

Graph 2. Enrolled postgraduate students by educational institution, end of academic years 2021/2022 and 2022/2023

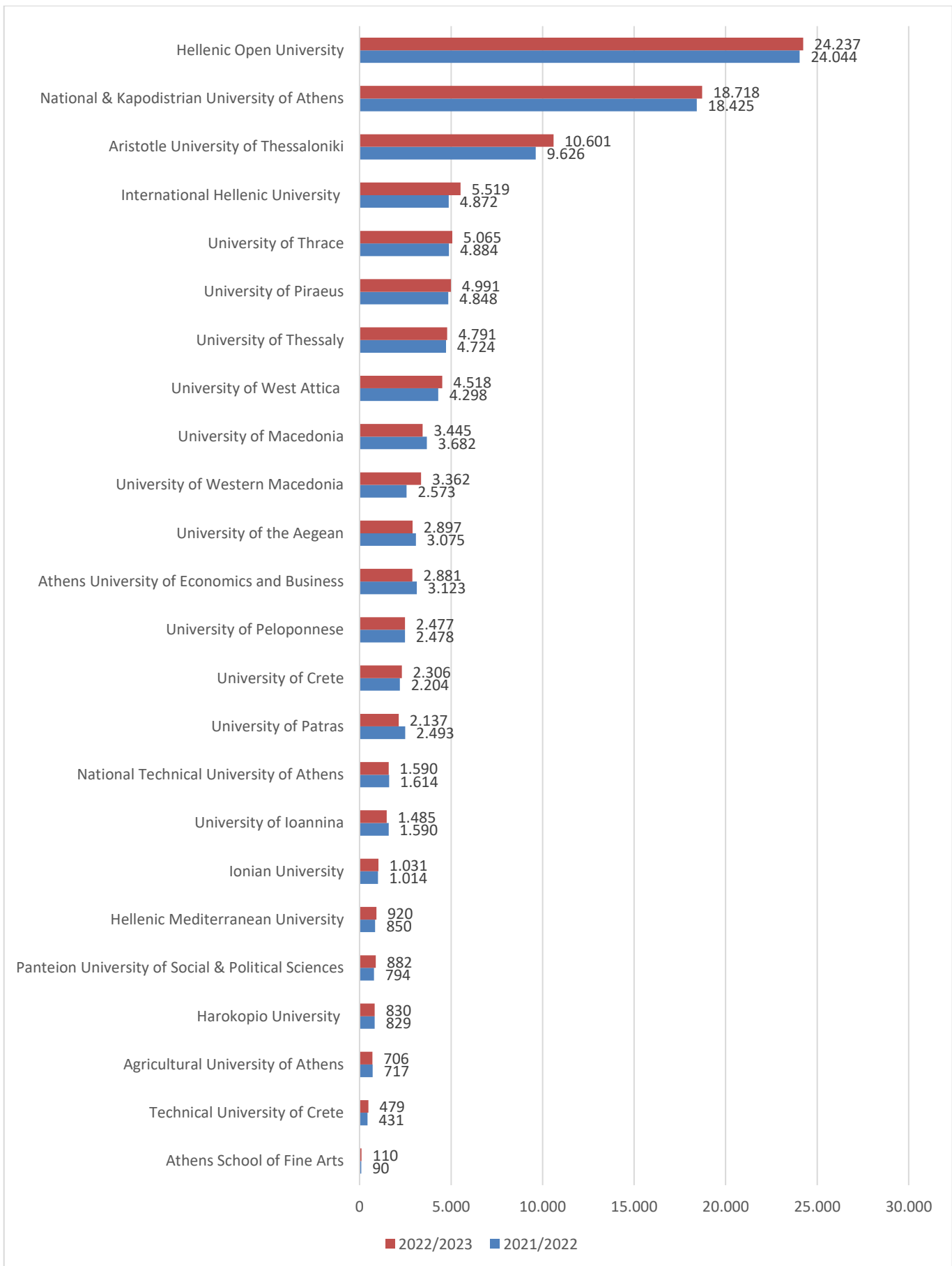

However, undergraduate students that entered TEI in the academic year 2018/2019 or in previous academic years had the right to graduate as Technological Education graduates attending classes from the TEI curriculum which was in place when they entered Tertiary Education. For this reason, in the academic years 2021/2022 and 2022/2023, despite the abolition of TEI, enrolled and graduate students of TEI still appear in the tables.</p> <p>The current survey is conducted annually by all Member States of the European Union. The aim is to collect data on enrolled undergraduate, postgraduate and doctorate students, undergraduate and postgraduate students that graduated, as well as the number of the teaching staff.</p>
