TERTIARY EDUCATION (UNIVERSITIES AND TECHNOLOGICAL INSTITUTIONS) END OF ACADEMIC YEAR 2020/2021

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces statistical data on Tertiary Education (Universities and Technological Institutions) for the end of academic year 2020/2021. On the basis of survey data for Tertiary Education the following can be observed:

- The number of **enrolled undergraduate students** in all tertiary educational institutions in the academic year 2020/2021 increased by 2.5% in comparison to 2019/2020 (from 709,742 to 727,620) (Table 1). The decrease in students observed in the Technological Sector is caused by the abolition of Technological Educational Institutions (TEI) in the academic year 2019/2020. Accordingly, the increase observed in the University Sector in the academic year 2019/2020 is due to the establishment of university departments, which succeeded former TEI departments.
- **Teaching staff** in all educational institutions in the academic year 2020/2021 increased by 5.6% in comparison to 2019/2020 (Table 2).
- The number of **graduates from undergraduate programmes** in the academic year 2020/2021 increased by 19.1% in comparison to 2019/2020 (Table 3). This is due to the fact that undergraduate students of TEI who joined university departments in 2019/2020 had to meet semester completion conditions for obtaining a university degree.
- **Enrolled postgraduate students** in the academic year 2020/2021 increased by 13.0% in comparison to 2019/2020 (Table 4).
- **Postgraduate students that graduated** in the academic year 2020/2021 increased by 11.5% in comparison to 2019/2020 (Table 5).
- **Enrolled doctorate students** in the academic year 2020/2021 increased by 2.5% in comparison to 2019/2020 (Table 6).
- **Doctoral students that graduated** in the academic year 2020/2021 increased by 11.0% in comparison to 2019/2020 (Table 7).

Graph 1. Enrolled undergraduate students, by educational institution, end of academic years 2019/2020 and 2020/2021

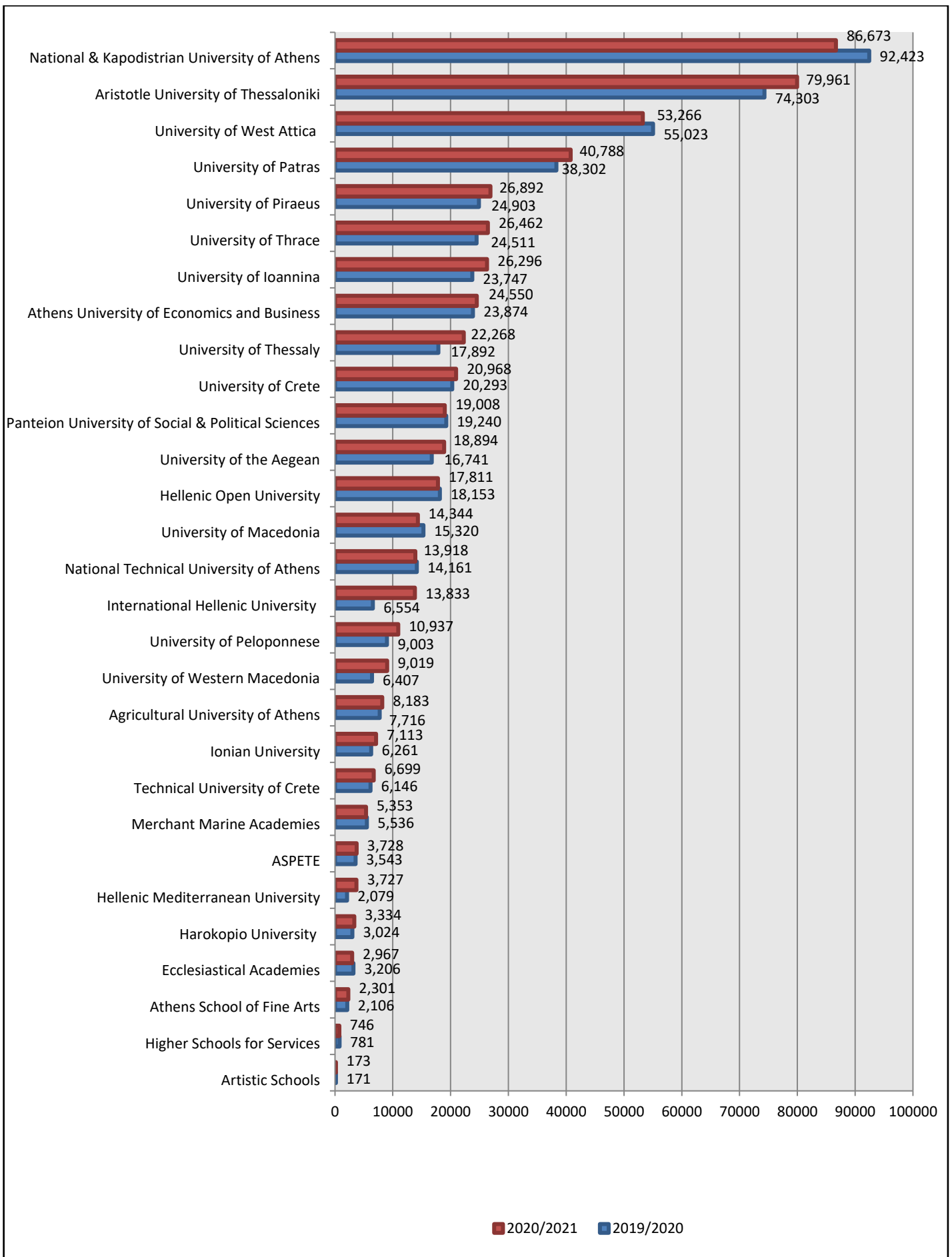

Graph 2. Enrolled postgraduate students, by educational institution, end of academic years 2019/2020 and 2020/2021

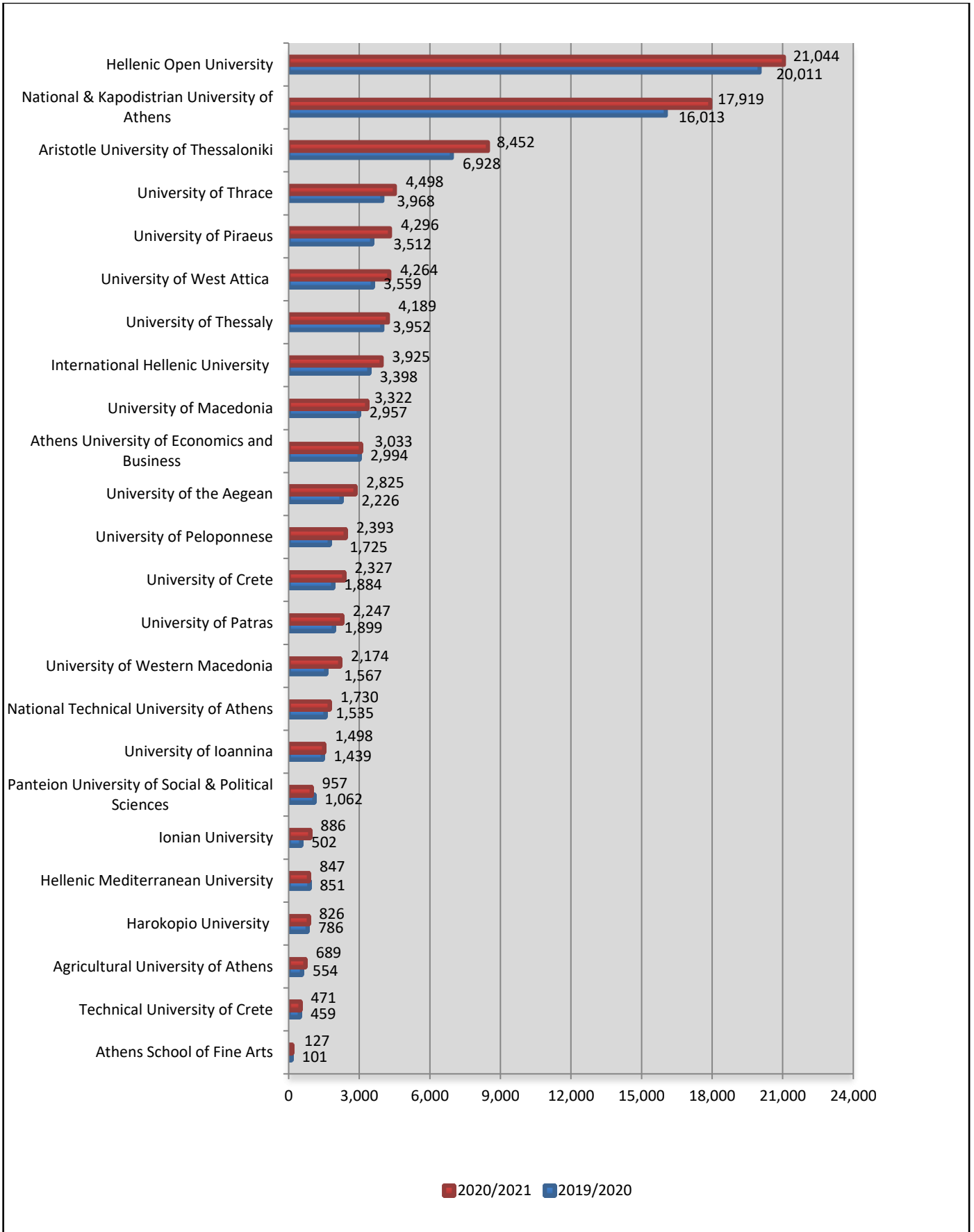

Survey on Tertiary Education (Universities and Technological Institutions)	<p>Tertiary Education consists of two domains:</p> <p>i) University Sector including Universities, Polytechnic Schools, the Athens School of Fine Arts and</p> <p>ii) the Technological Sector including the Technological Educational Institutes (TEI), the School of Pedagogical and Technological Education (ASPETE), the Academies of Merchant Shipping, Ecclesiastical Academies, Schools of Service and Artistic Schools).</p> <p>According to Laws 4559/2018, 4589/2019 and 4610/2019 Technological Educational Institutions (TEI) were abolished and integrated into respective departments of Universities. However, undergraduate students that entered TEI in the academic year 2018/2019 or in previous academic years had the right to graduate as Technological Education graduates attending classes from the TEI curriculum, which was in place when they entered Tertiary Education. For this reason, in the academic years 2019/2020 and 2020/2021, despite the abolition of TEI, enrolled and graduate students of TEI still appear in the tables.</p> <p>The current survey is conducted annually by all Member States of the European Union. The aim is to collect data on enrolled undergraduate, postgraduate and doctorate students, undergraduate and postgraduate students that graduated, as well as the number of the teaching staff.</p>
