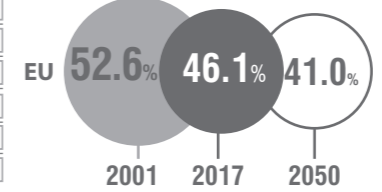

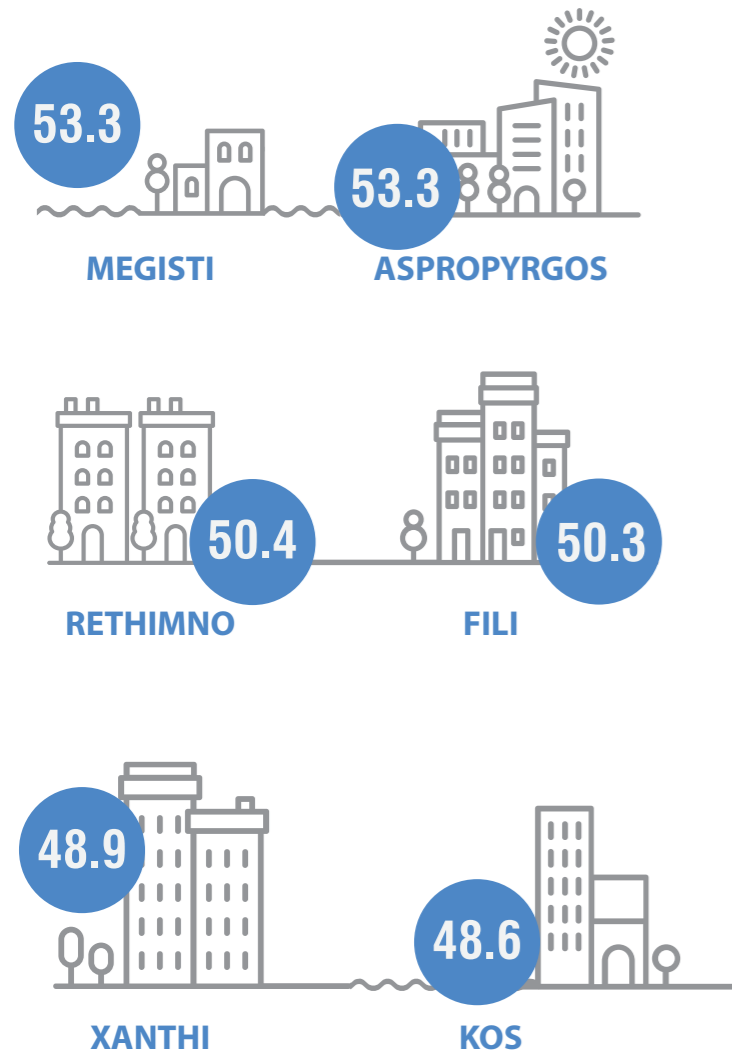

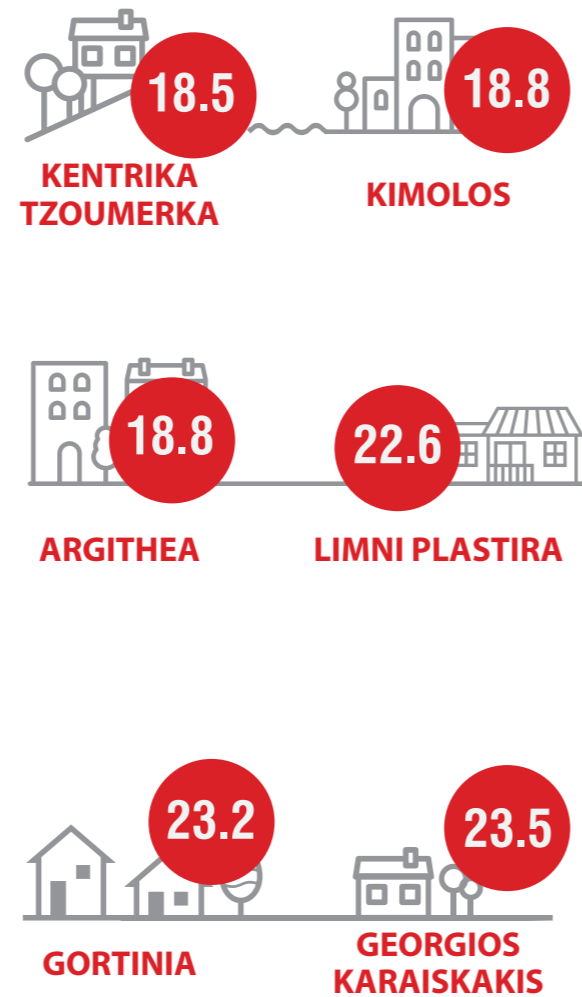

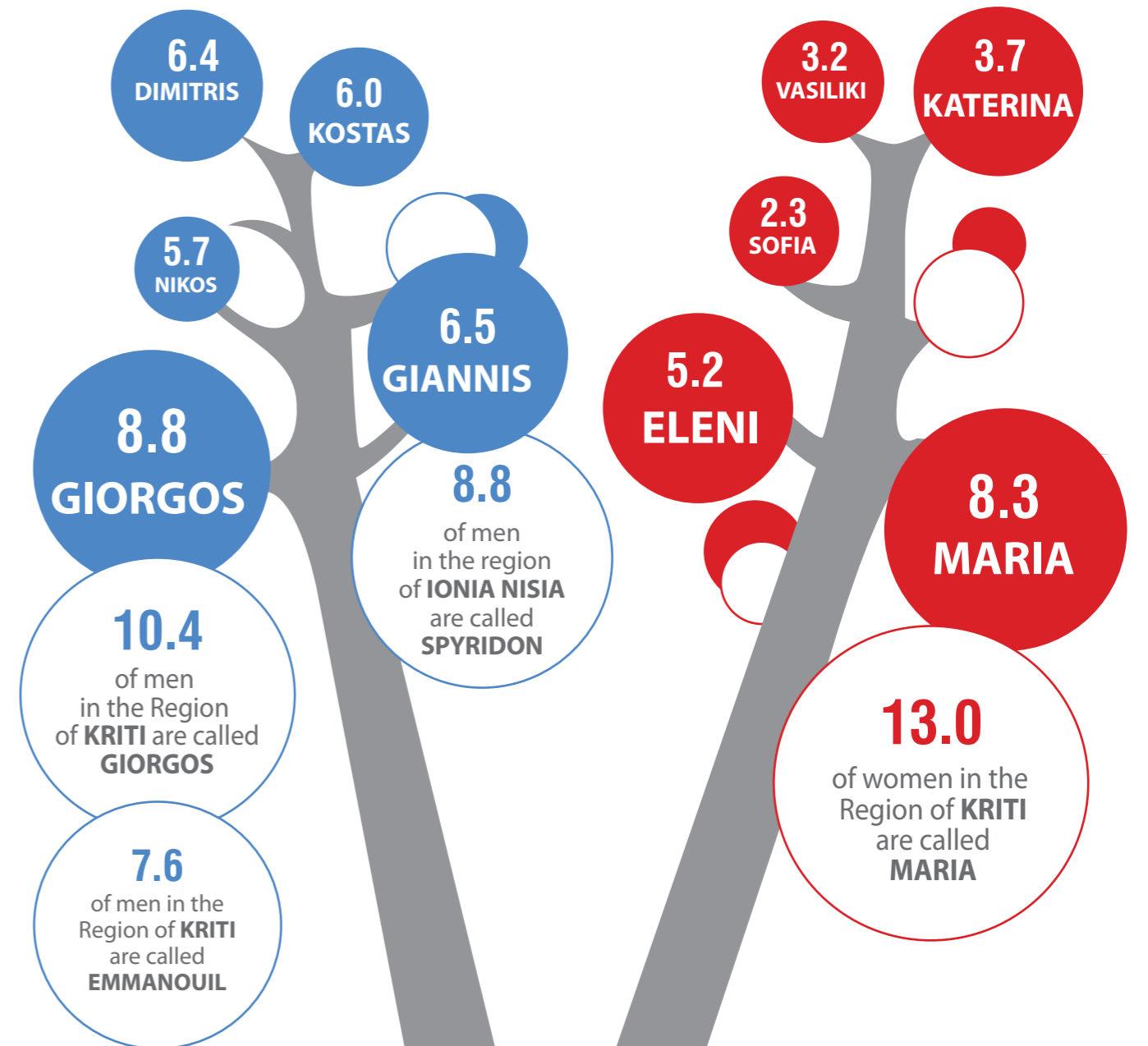
**% WITH THE BIGGEST SHARE OF YOUNG PEOPLE AGED 0-34**

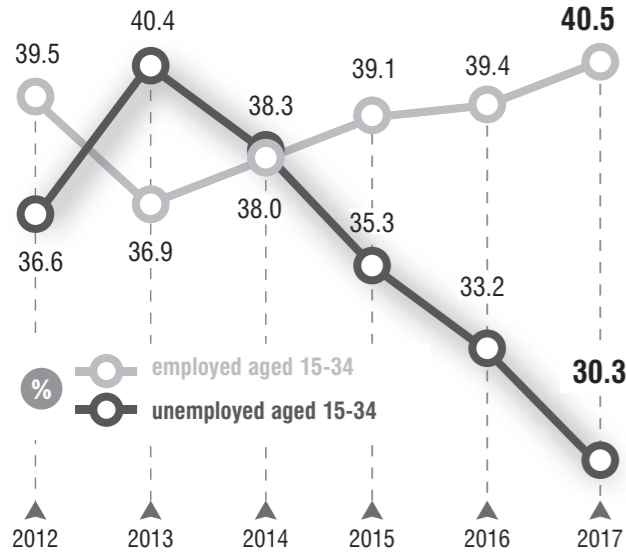

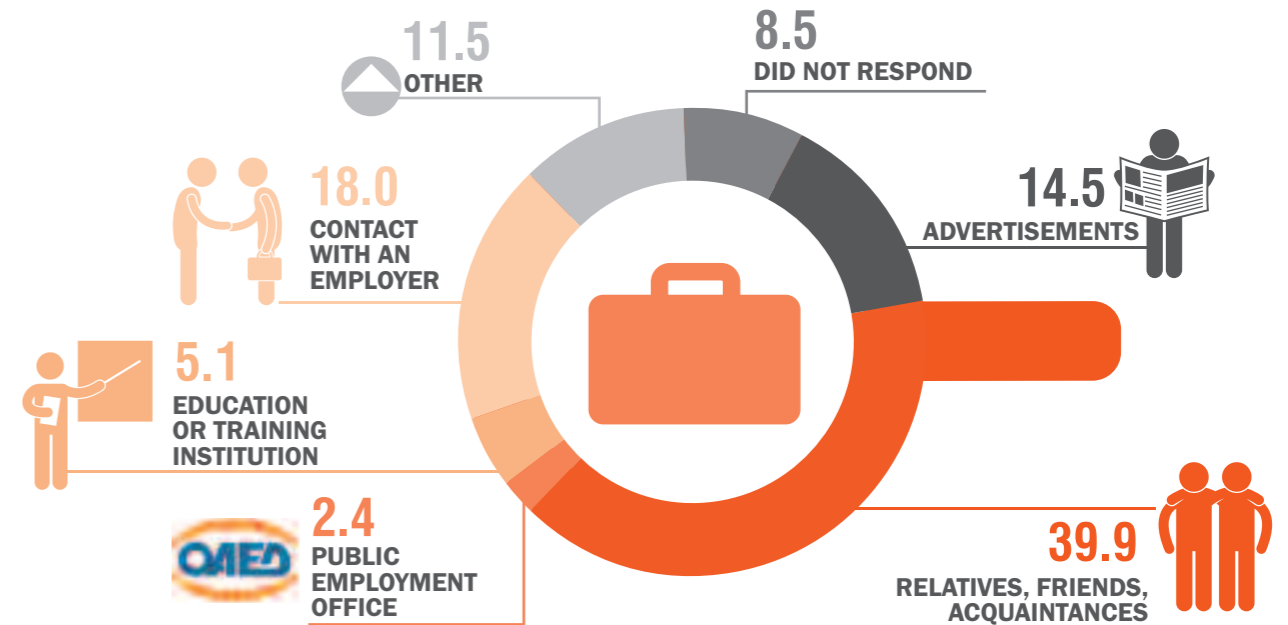

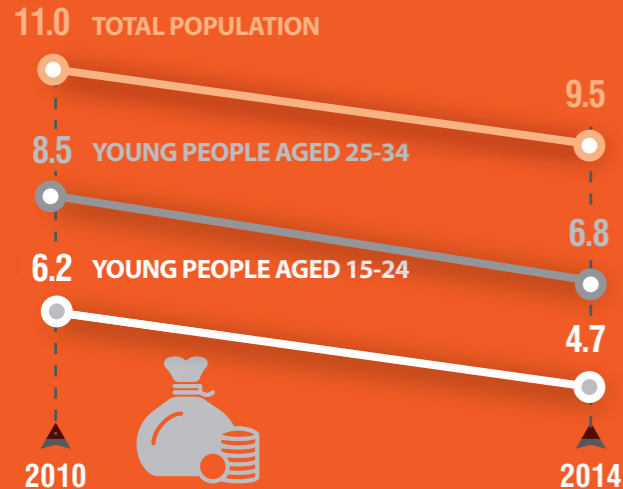
## % UNEMPLOYMENT OF YOUNG PEOPLE, BY GENDER, 2017

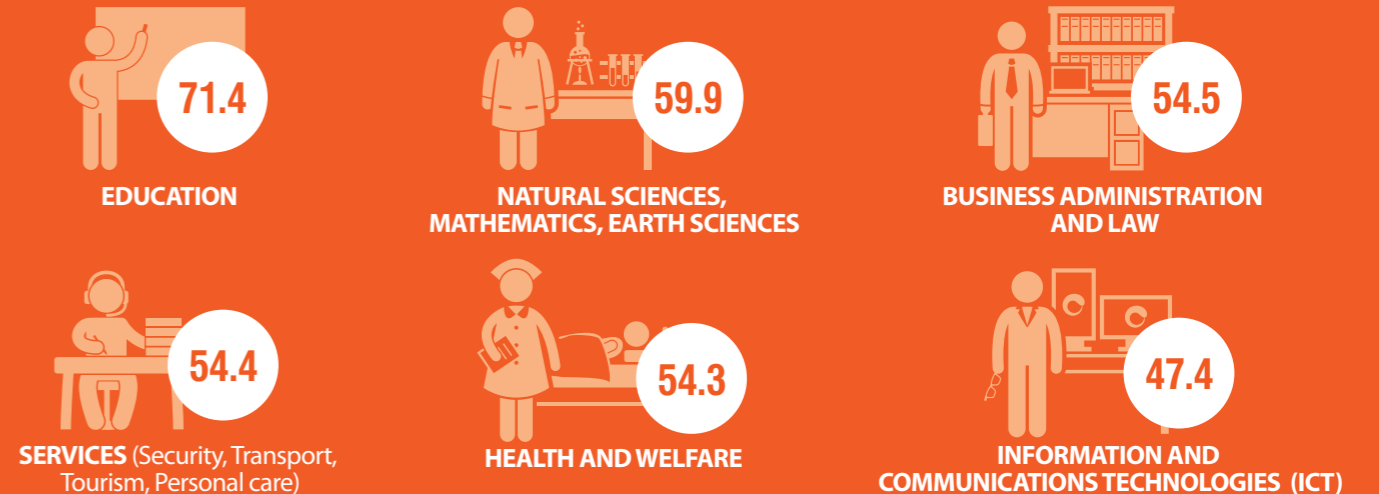
### THE THREE HIGHEST GROSS WAGES OF YOUNG PEOPLE

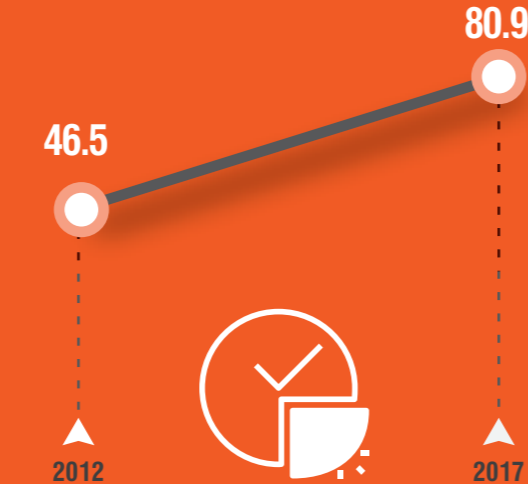

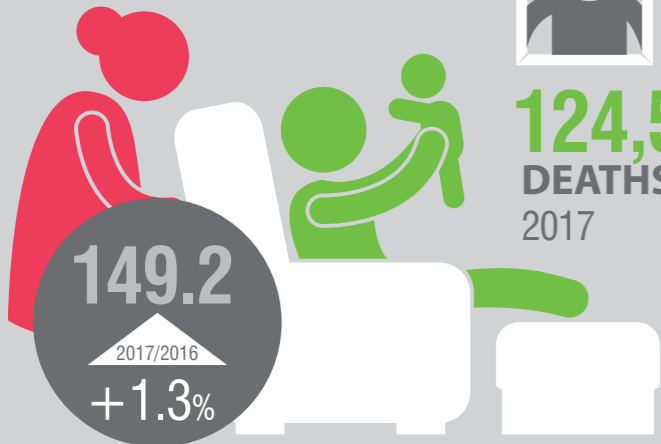

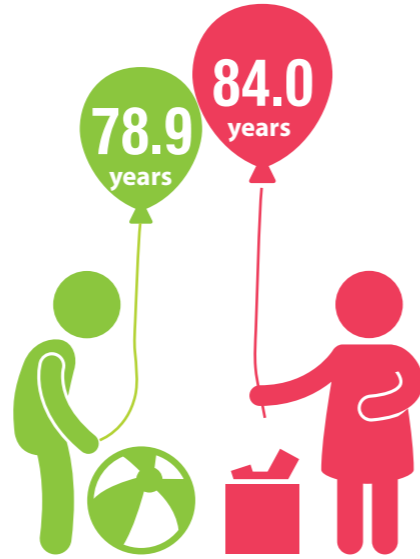

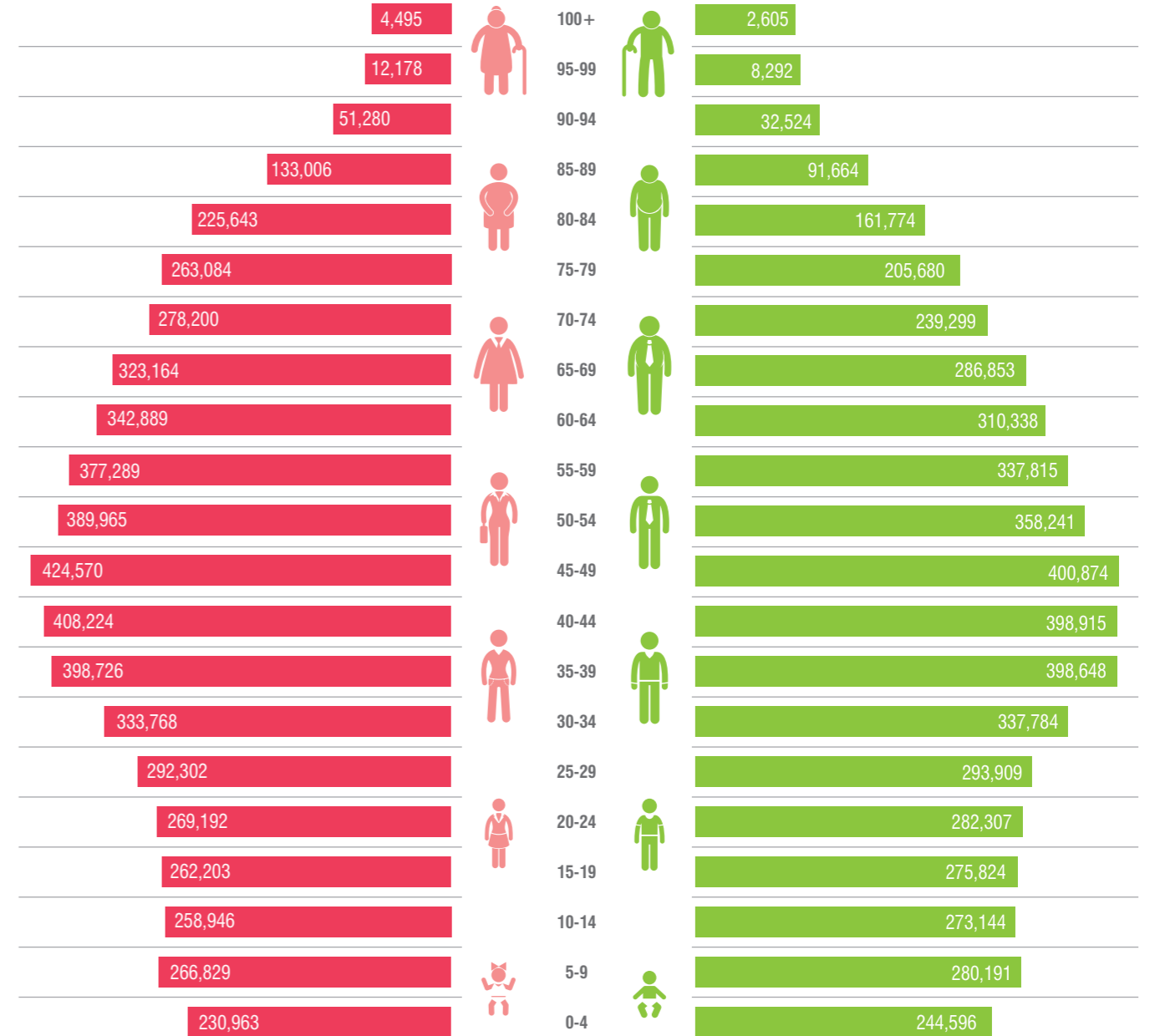

**POPULATION PYRAMID (1 January 2017)**

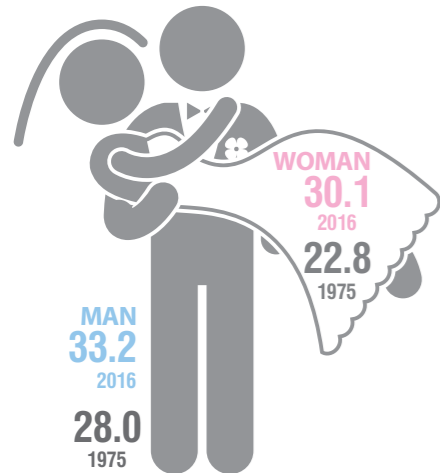

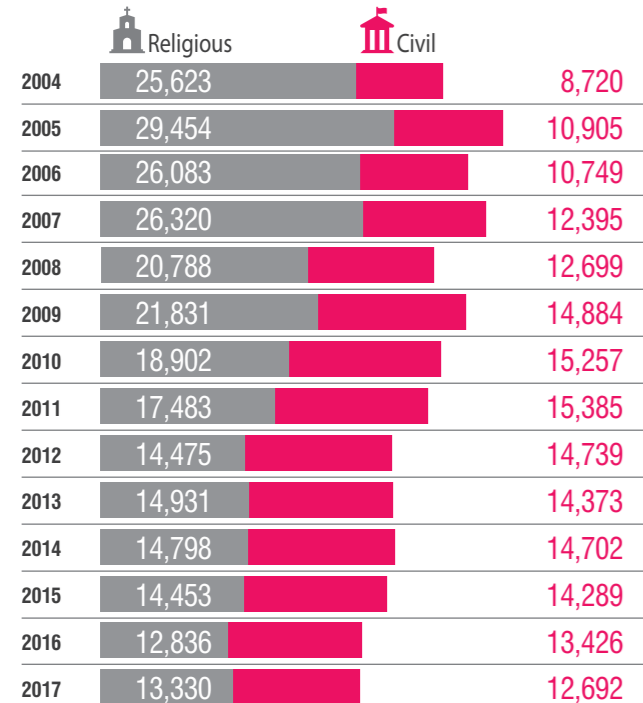

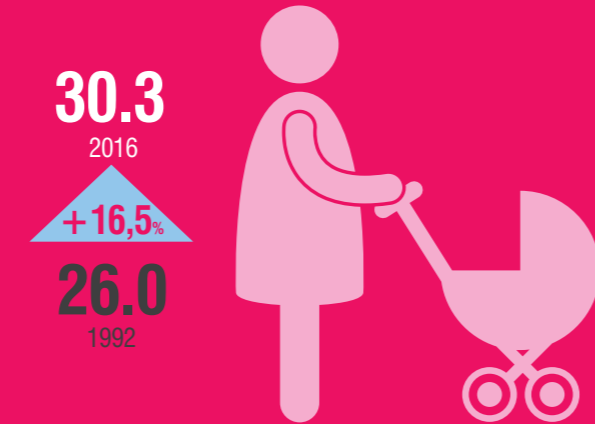

## NUMBER OF MARRIAGES, SPOUSES AGED 15-34

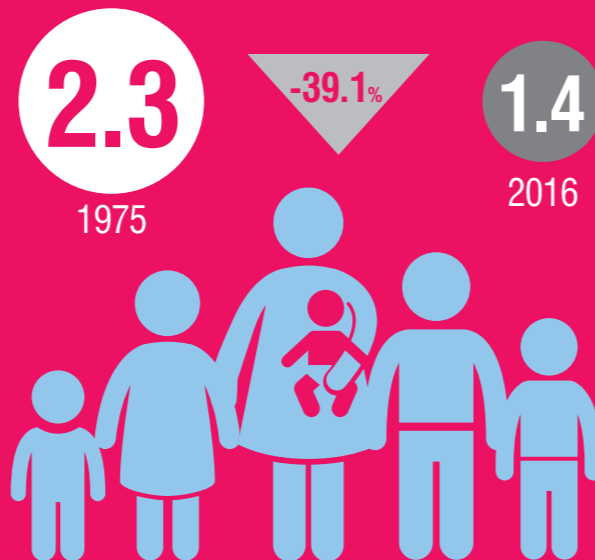

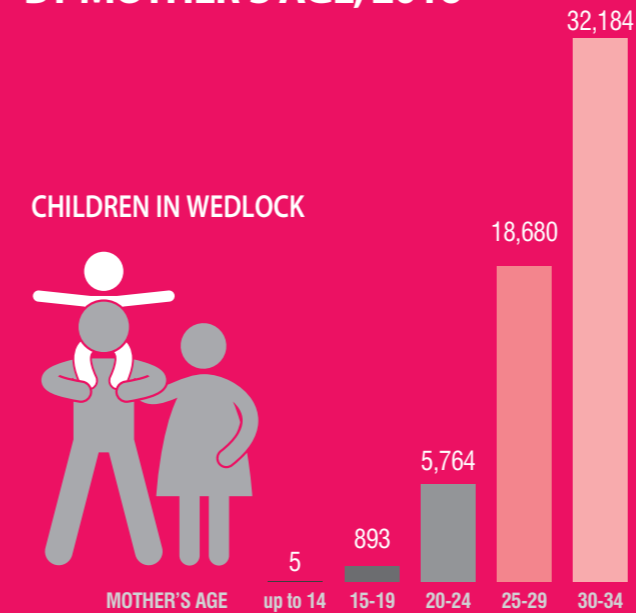

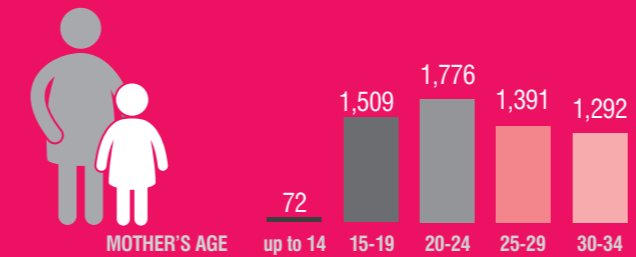

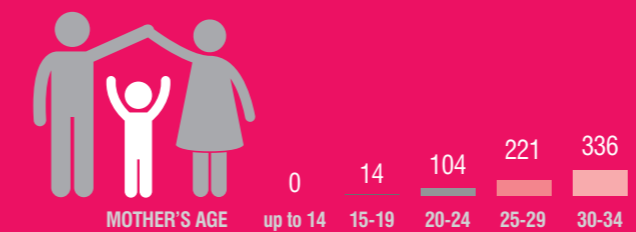
## LIVING CHILDREN BY MOTHER'S AGE, 2016



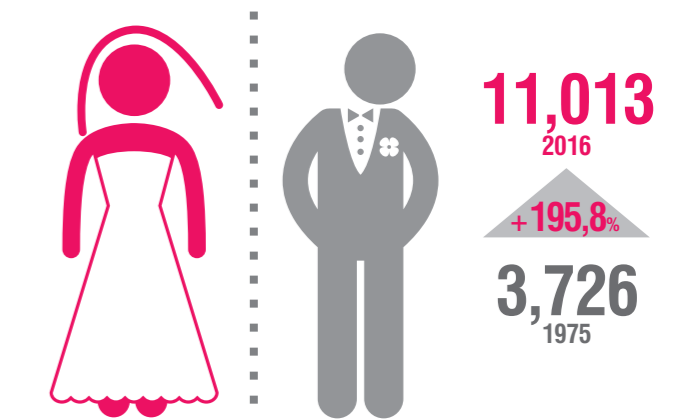

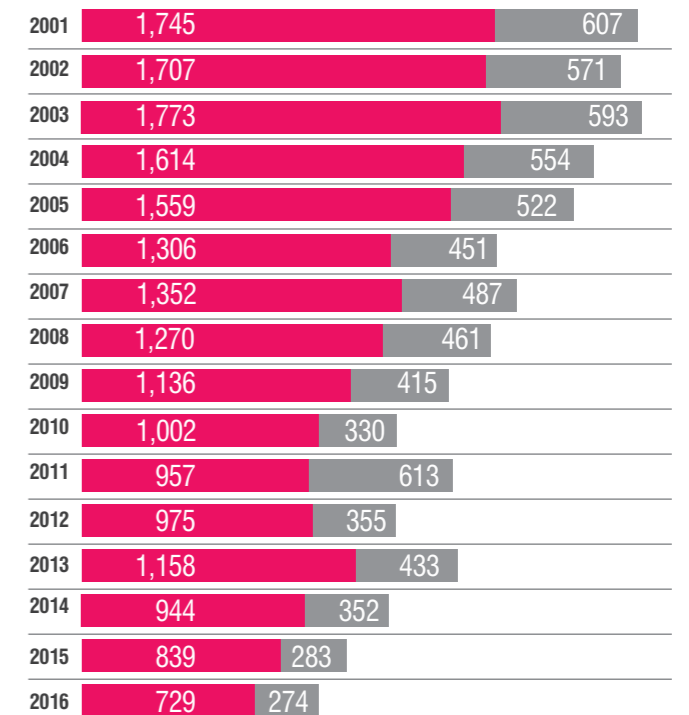

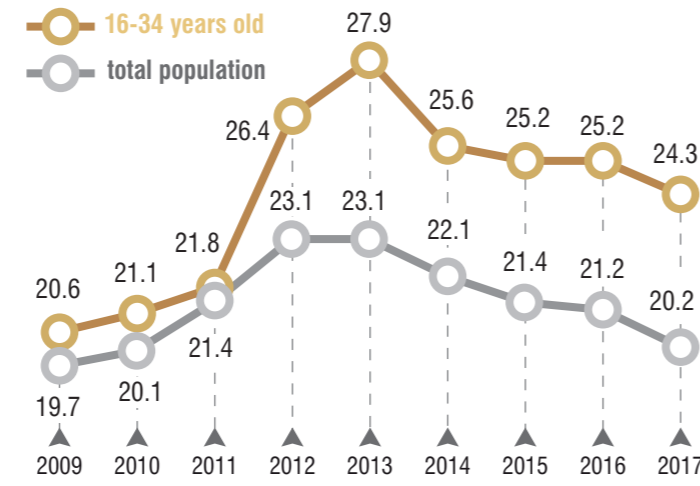

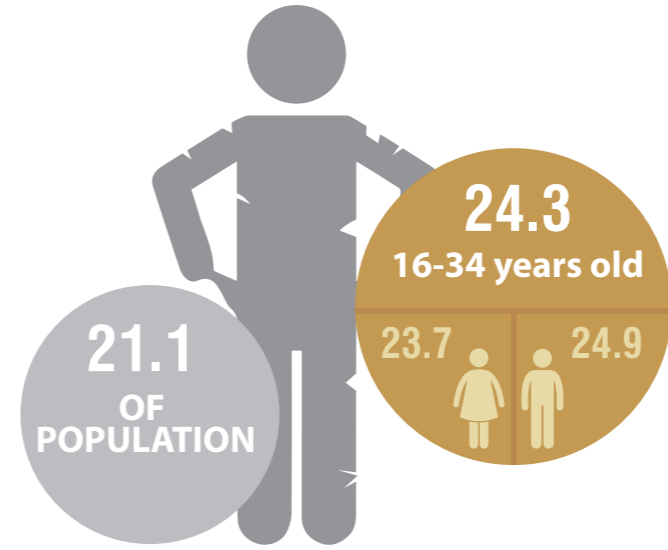
**% POPULATION AT RISK OF POVERTY**

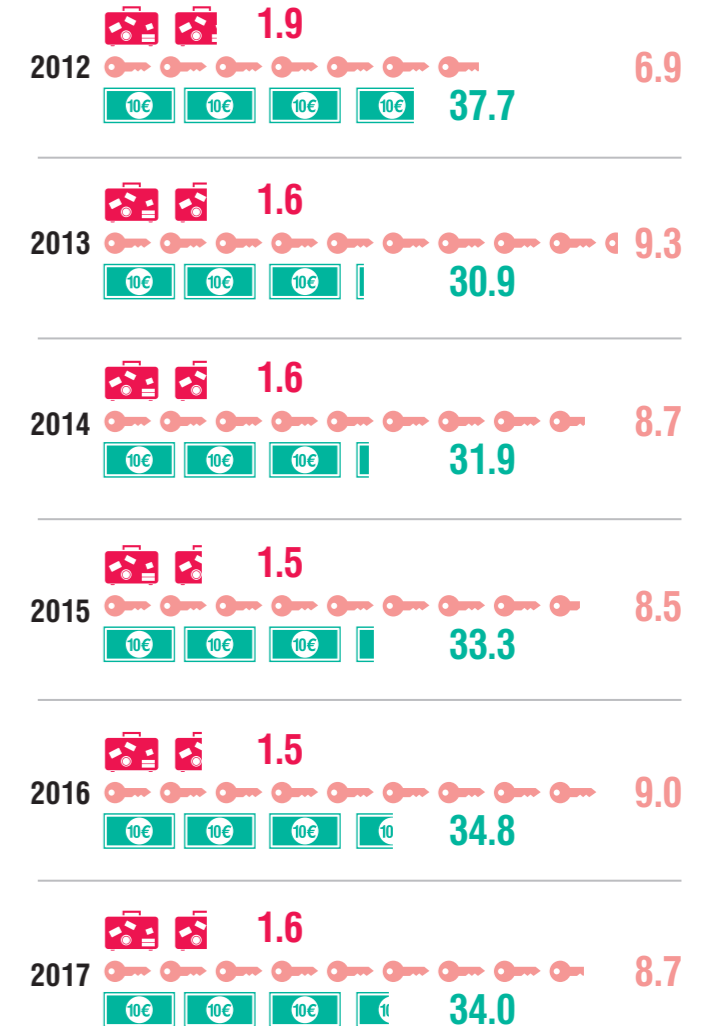

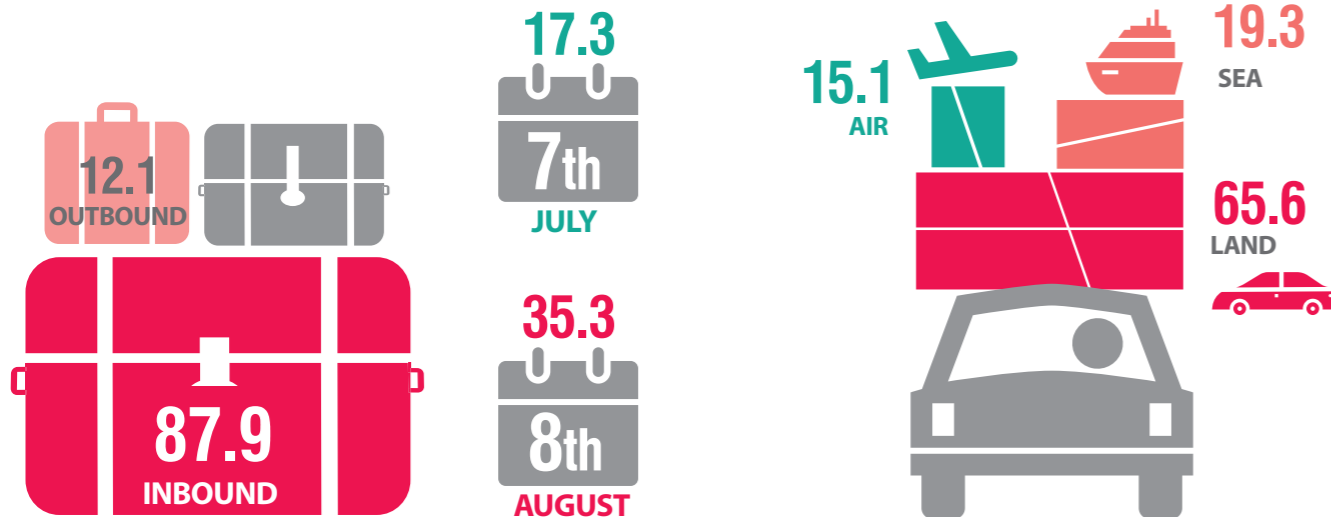

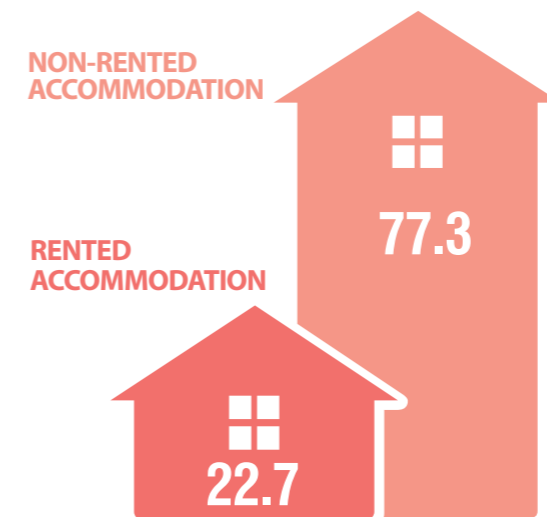

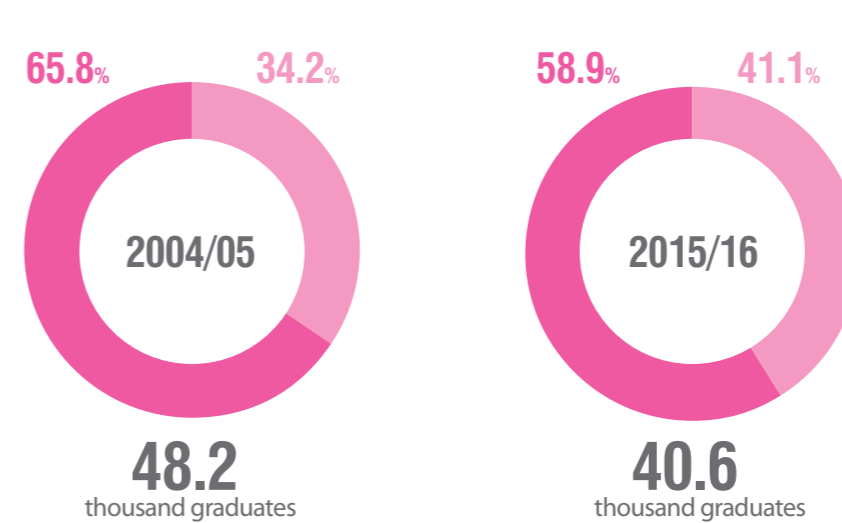


## YOUNG PEOPLE AGED 17-28 IN TERTIARY EDUCATION, 2015/16
