ANNOUNCEMENT

**SCHEDULED CERTIFICATIONS OF STATISTICS OF NATIONAL AUTHORITIES OF THE HELLENIC
STATISTICAL SYSTEM IN 2015**

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) has, according to Article 11, paragraph 6, of the Greek Statistical Law 3832/2010 as in force, the responsibility to certify as “official” statistics which have been produced by other agencies of the Hellenic Statistical System (ELSS).

In order to be certified as “official”, the ELSS statistics will be assessed against the European Statistics Code of Practice. ELSTAT assesses and determines whether the Code of Practice has been complied with in relation to the above statistics. The assessment of statistics of ELSS agencies by ELSTAT will cover all aspects of the work leading to the statistical output and its dissemination.

In this framework, the Hellenic Statistical Authority has scheduled to complete in 2015 a first round of assessments for certification as “official” of statistics produced by the national authorities of ELSS– i.e. the ELSS agencies responsible for the development, production and dissemination of European statistics – after the 2 pilot certification exercises of statistics of national authorities it has already conducted recently.

The assessments for the certification as “official” of statistics produced by the national authorities of ELSS will be conducted according to the following timetable:
