**% MOST POPULAR FIRST NAMES**



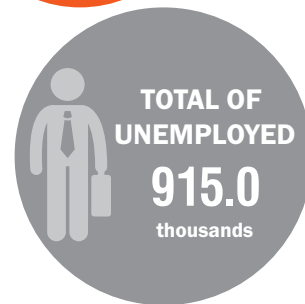
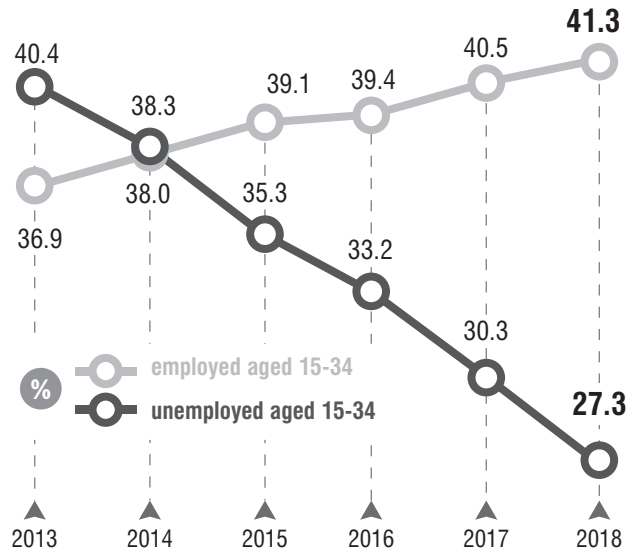

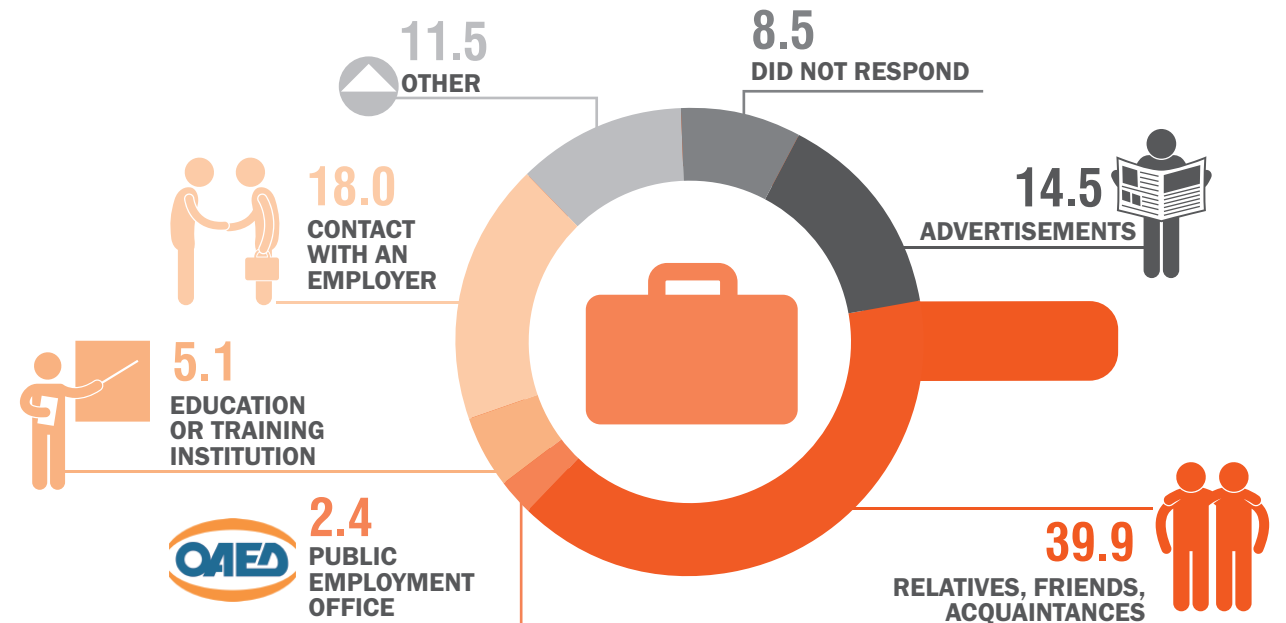

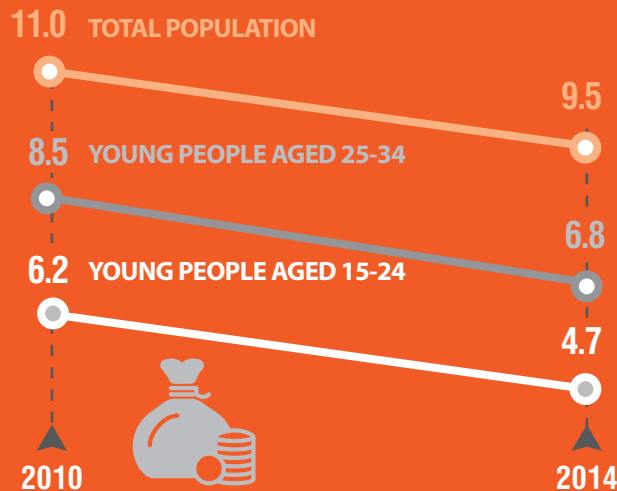
## % UNEMPLOYMENT OF YOUNG PEOPLE, BY GENDER, 2018

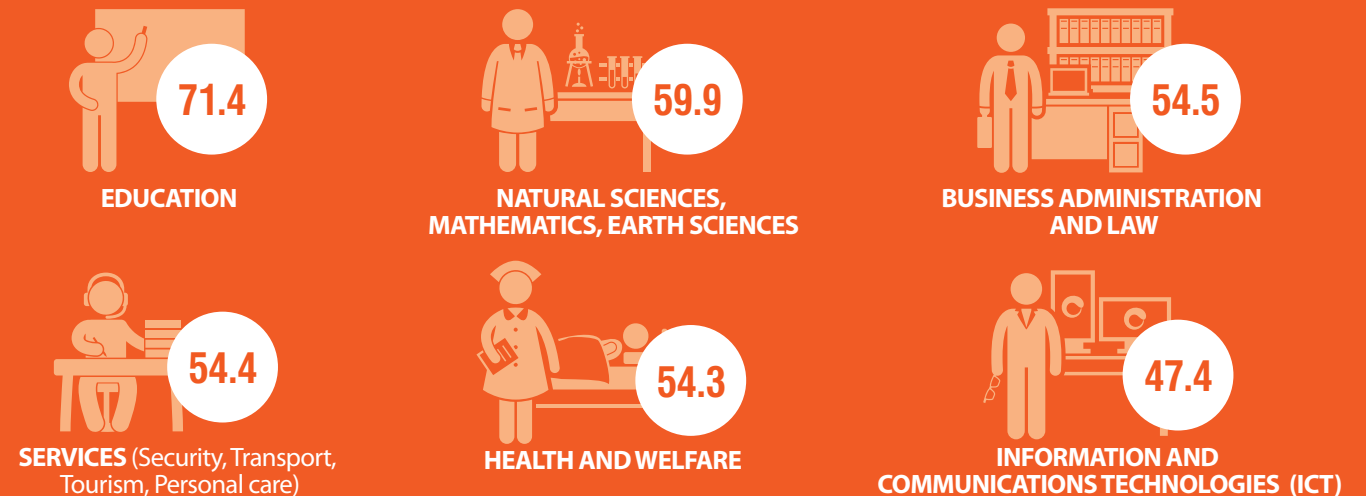

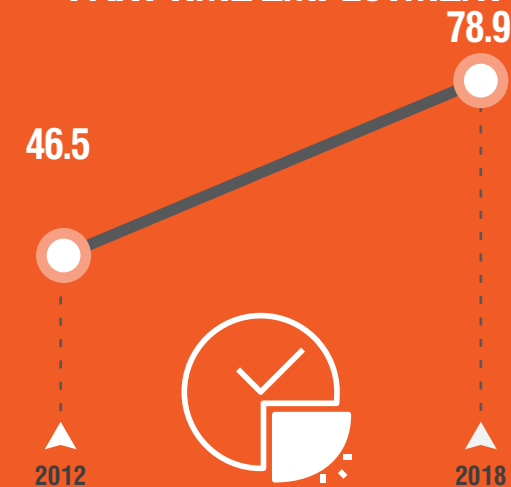
### % UNEMPLOYMENT OF YOUNG PEOPLE BY EDUCATION LEVEL, 2018

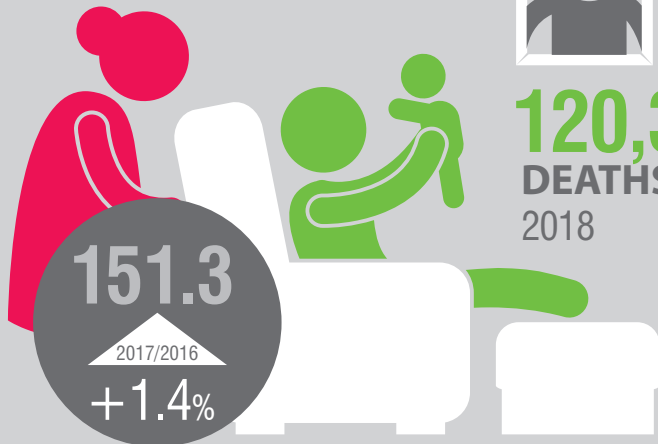

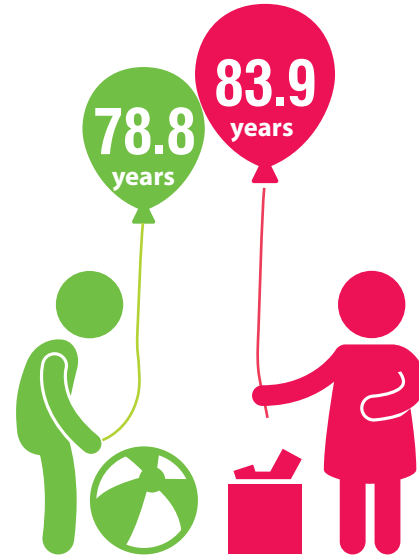

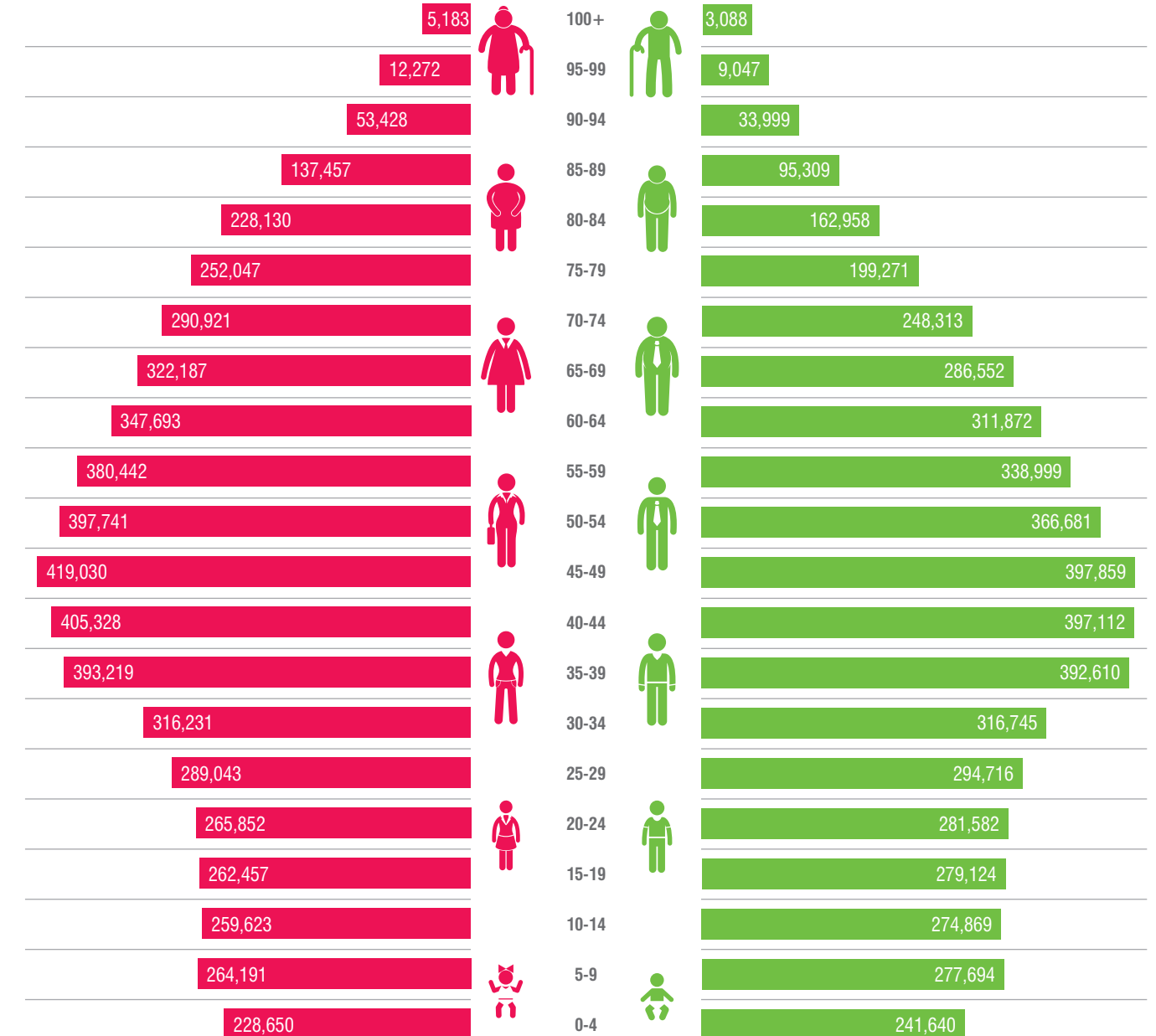

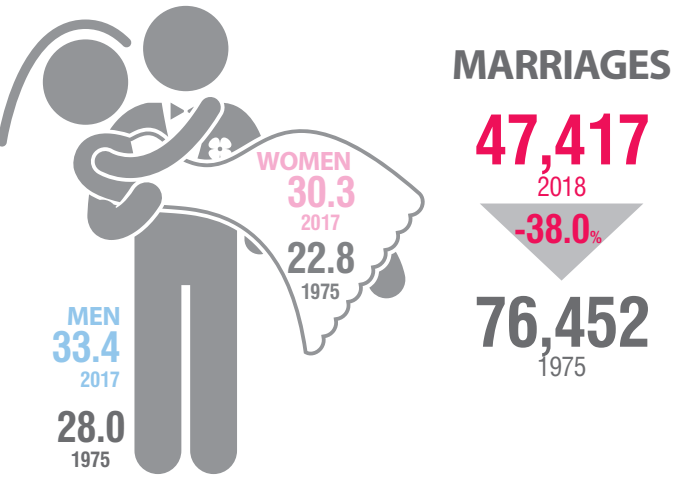
### POPULATION PYRAMID (1 January 2018)

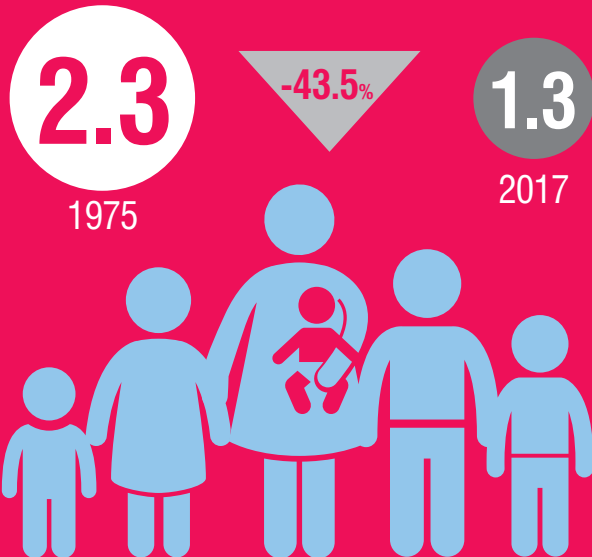

AVERAGE AGE OF MOTHER AT BIRTH OF 1st CHILD

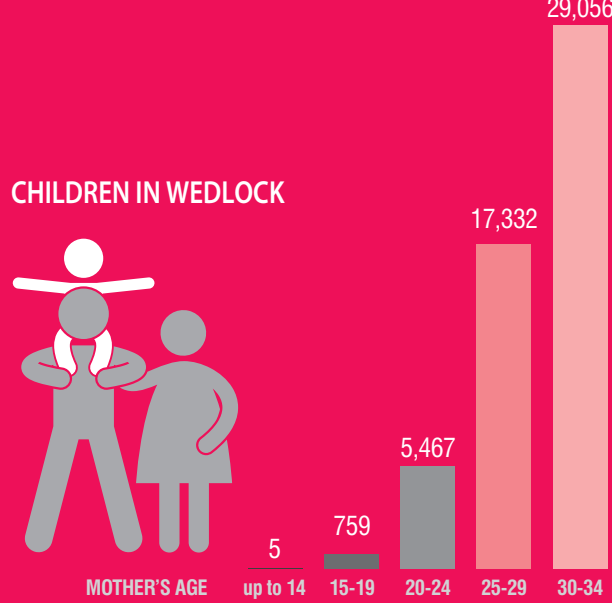


FERTILITY RATE

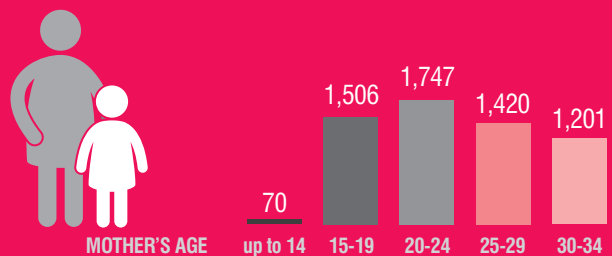
The average number of living children that a woman will give birth to during her lifetime



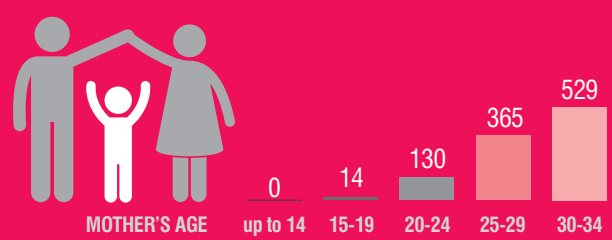
LIVING CHILDREN BY MOTHER'S AGE, 2017



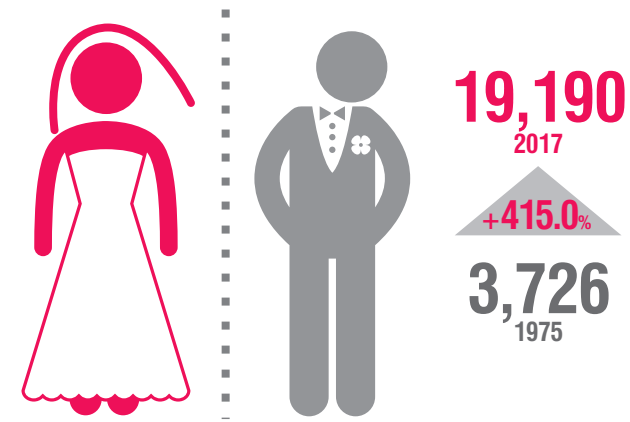

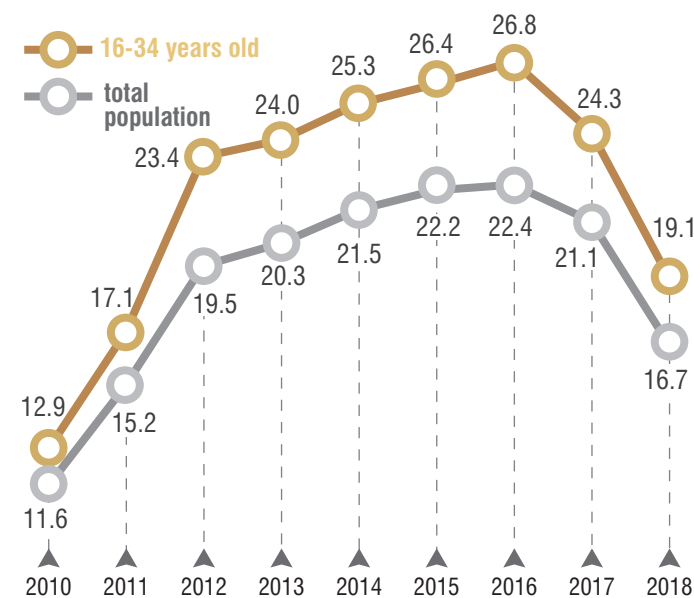
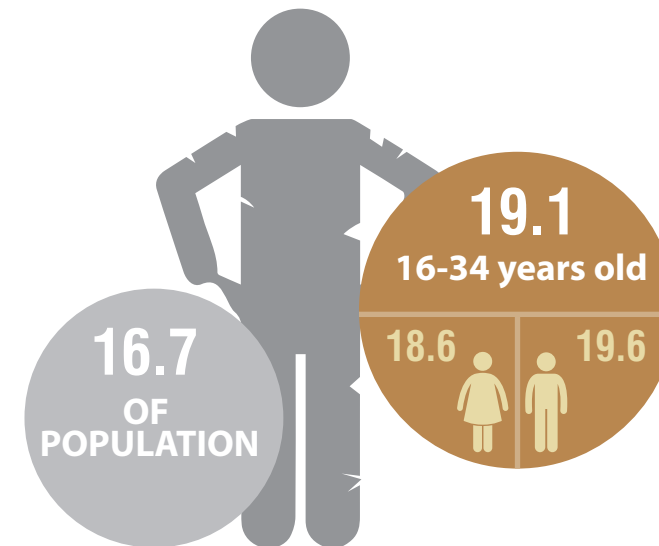
### % POPULATION AT RISK OF POVERTY

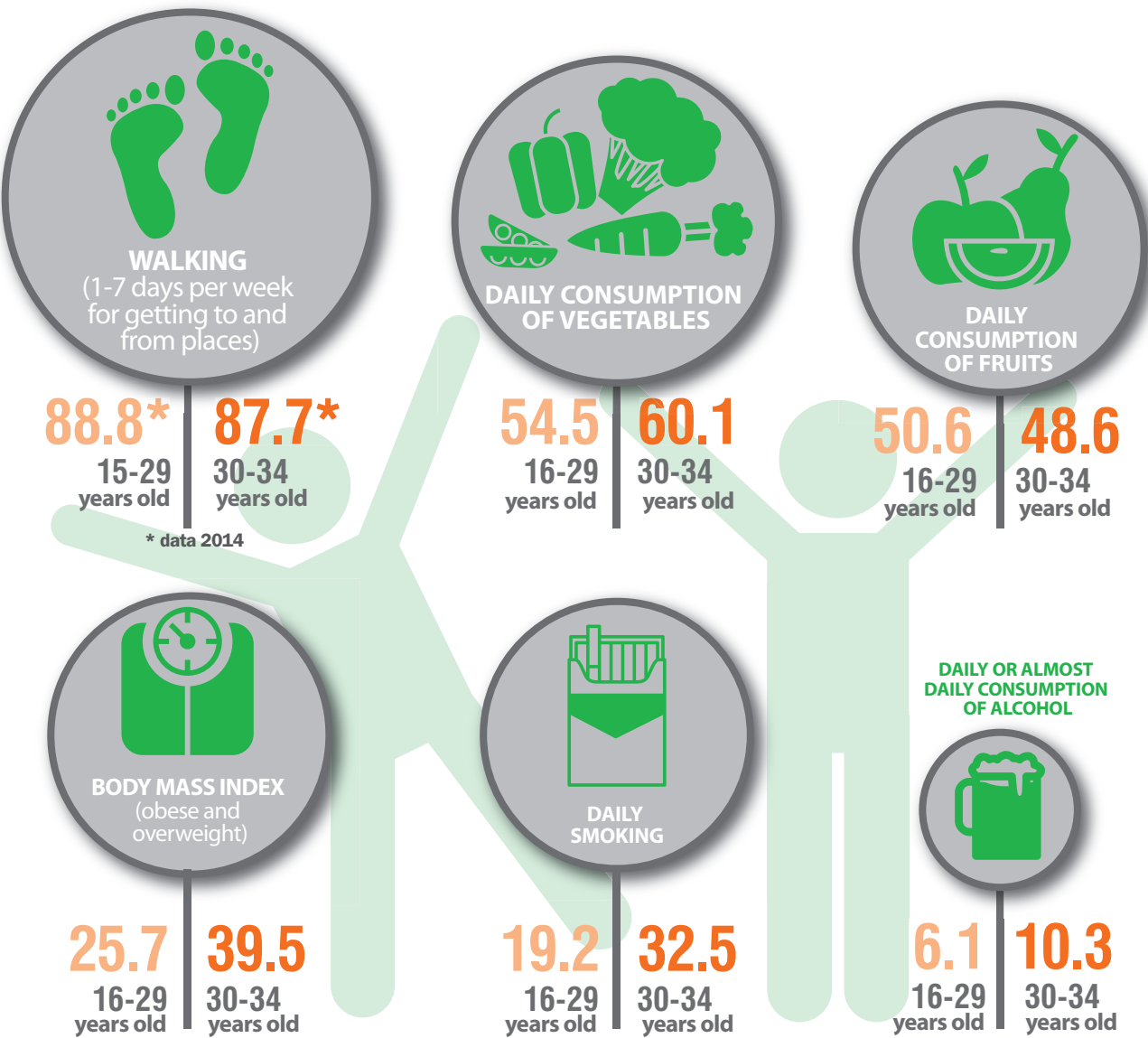

Time spent when sleeping during the night and day but also time spent in bed before or after sleeping.



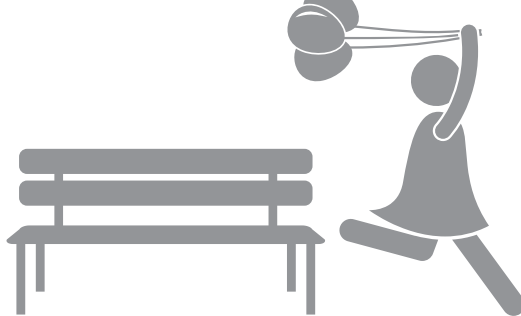
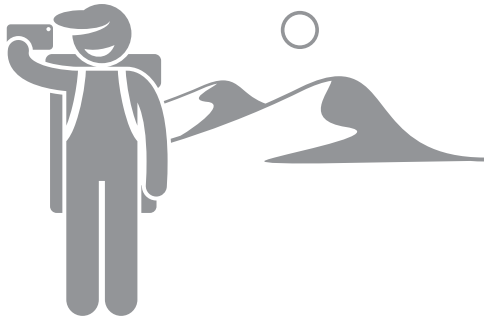
### EMPLOYMENT

The usual job/occupation that a social person does for a living.

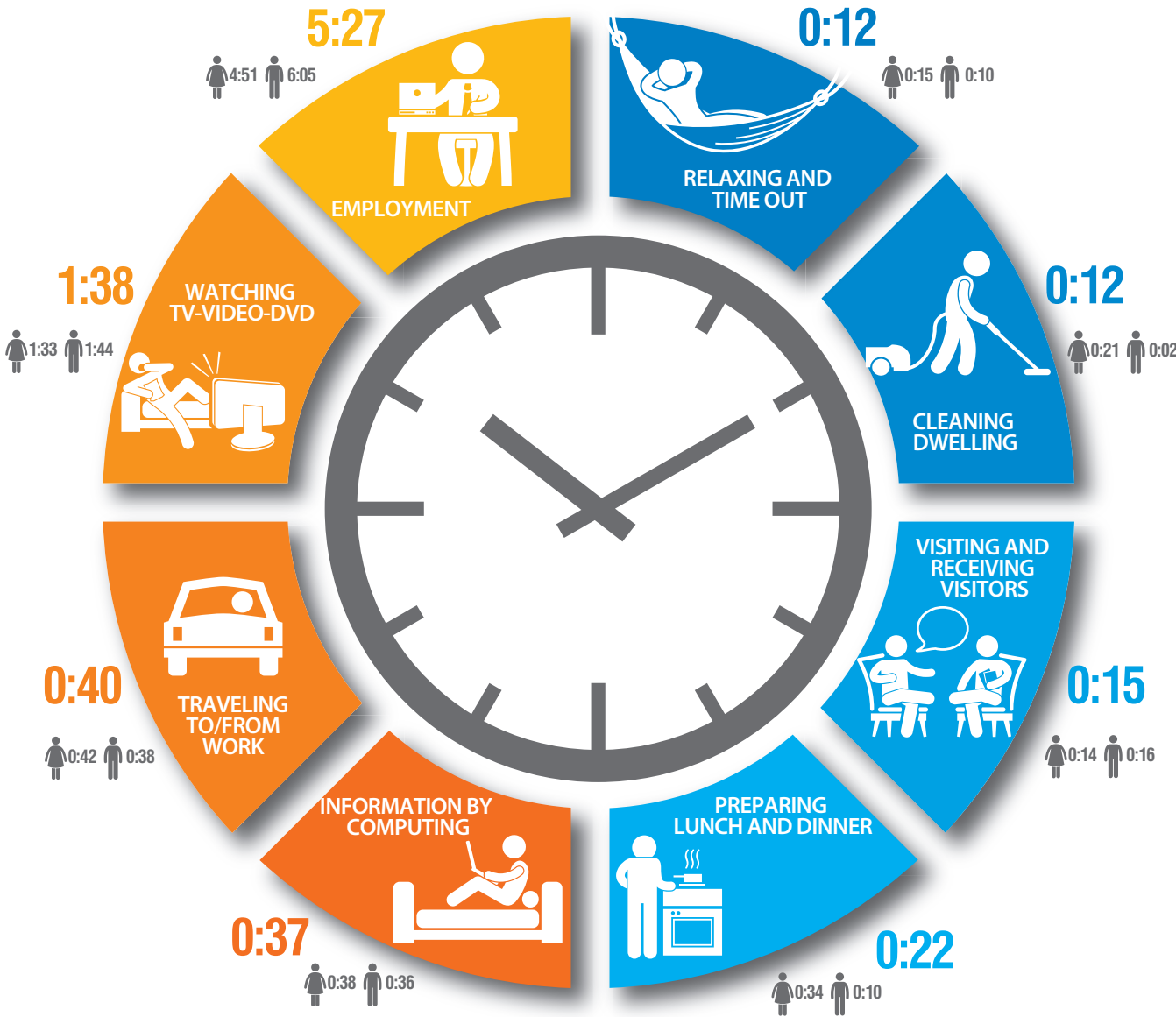


### FREE TIME

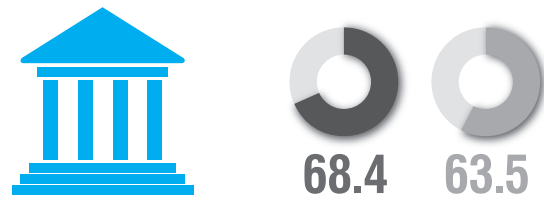

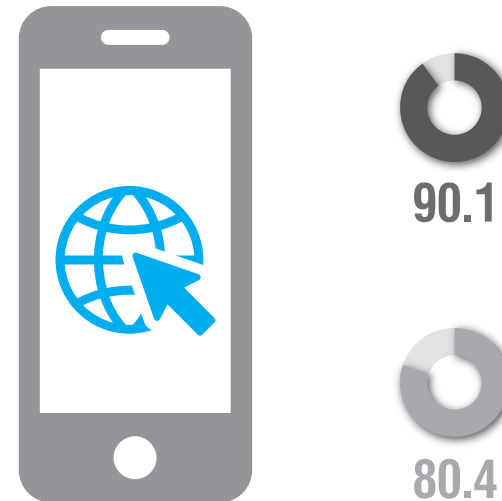

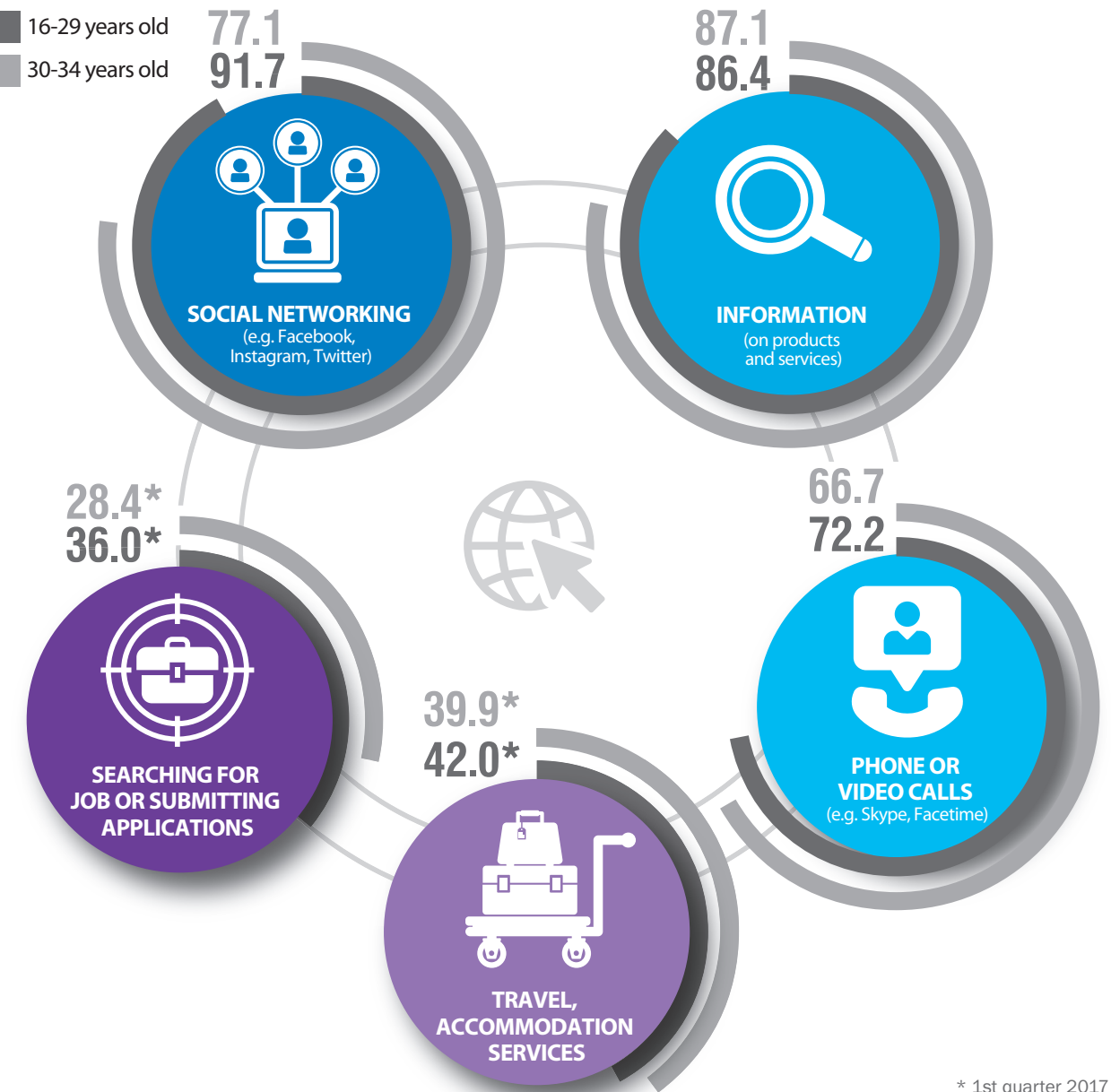


## % MOBILE INTERNET ACCESS (outside home or place of work) 1st quarter 2018

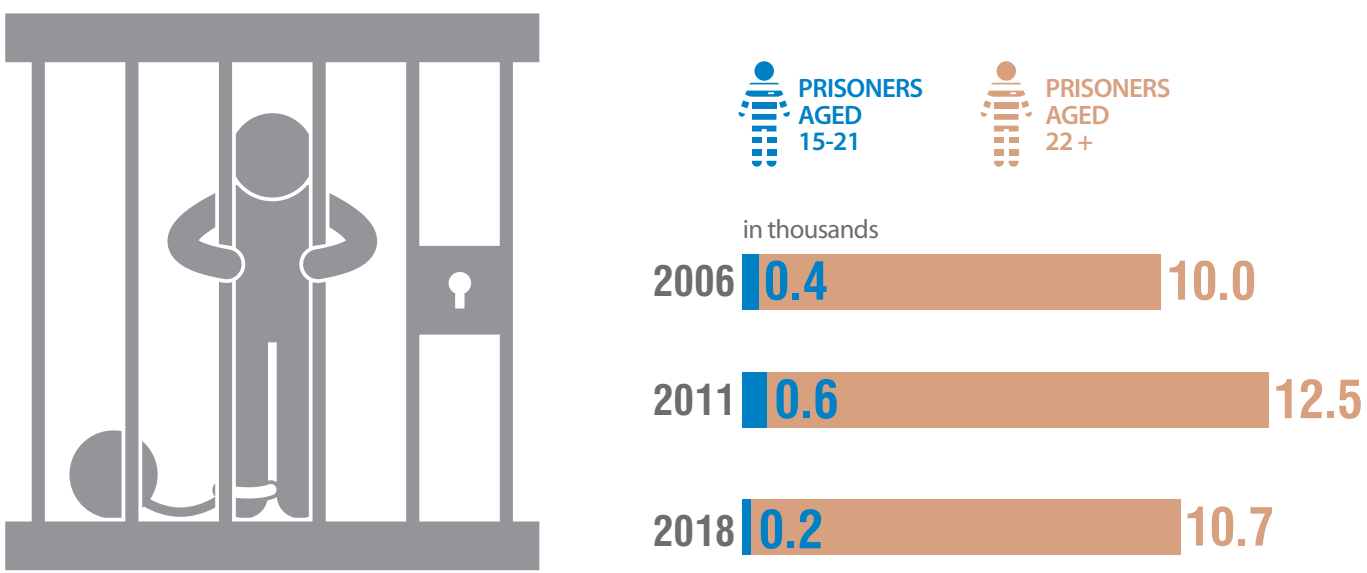

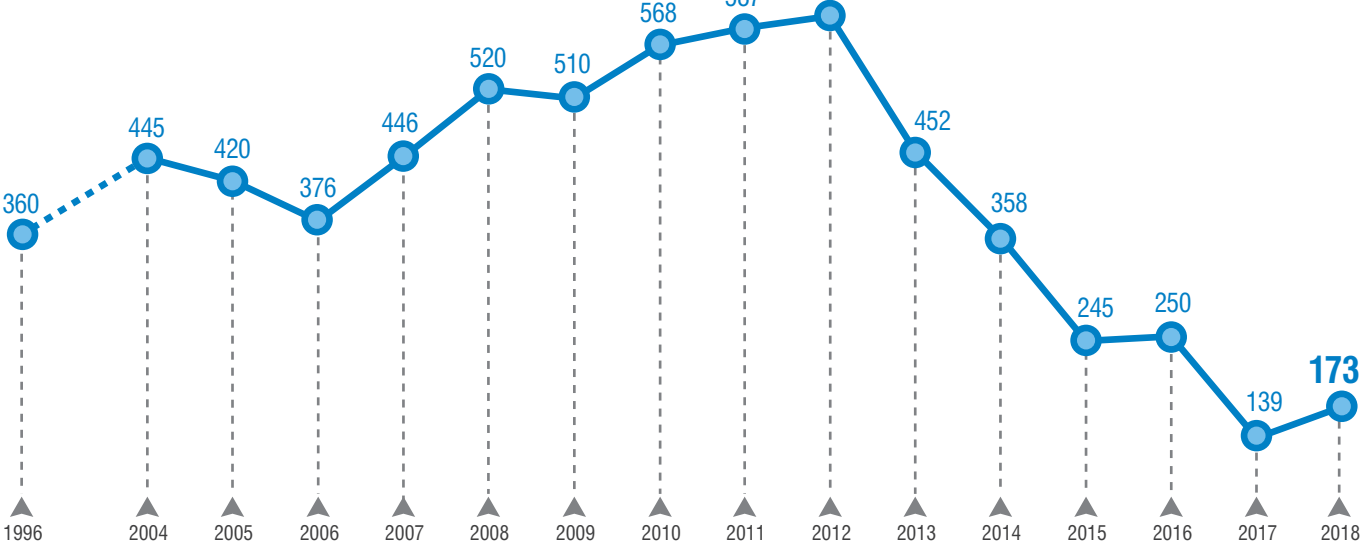
