

## ANNOUNCEMENT

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) republishes the results of the recent survey conducted by the Friedrich Naumann Foundation, which includes, inter alia, an assessment of the citizens' trust in the institutions of the Greek State, making a distinct reference to ELSTAT. The survey was carried out from 14 to 22 October 2020 and the surveyed persons were asked to answer the question: **"How much do you trust each of the following institutions of the Greek State**?". The results and the related ranking in terms of citizens' trust in the institutions are presented below, with ELSTAT holding the third (3rd) place:
