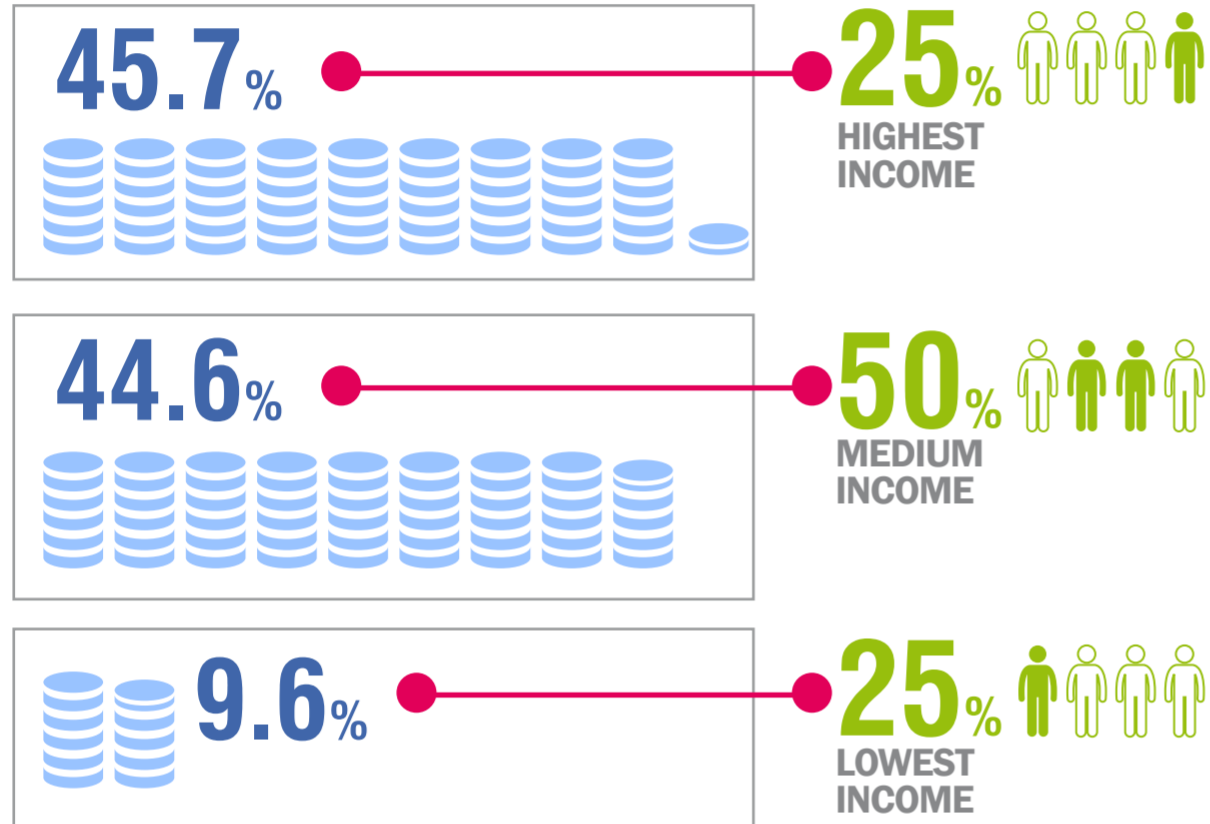

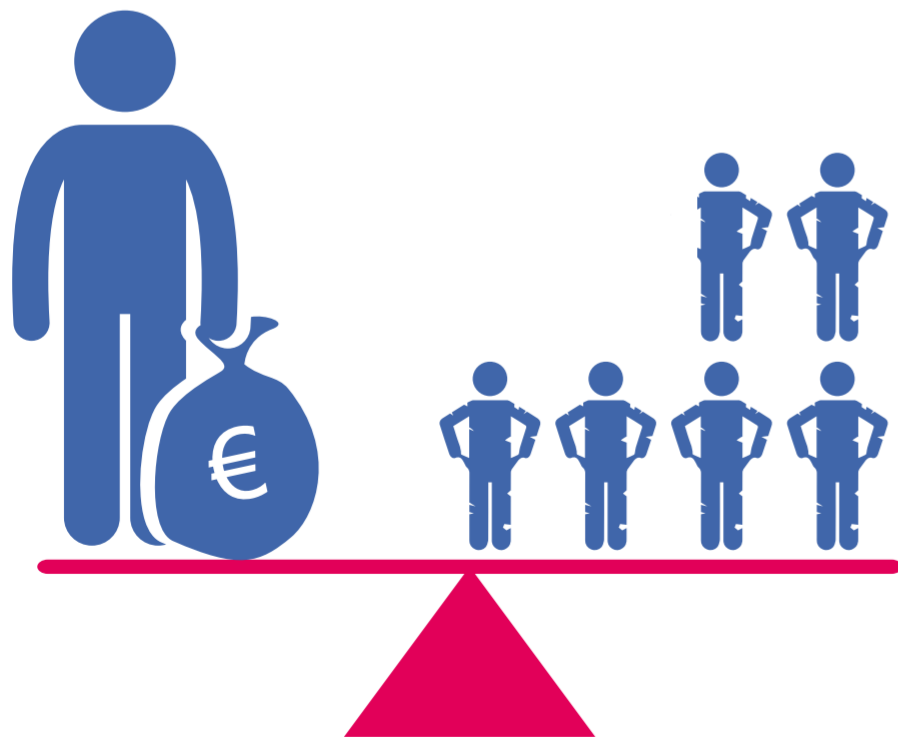
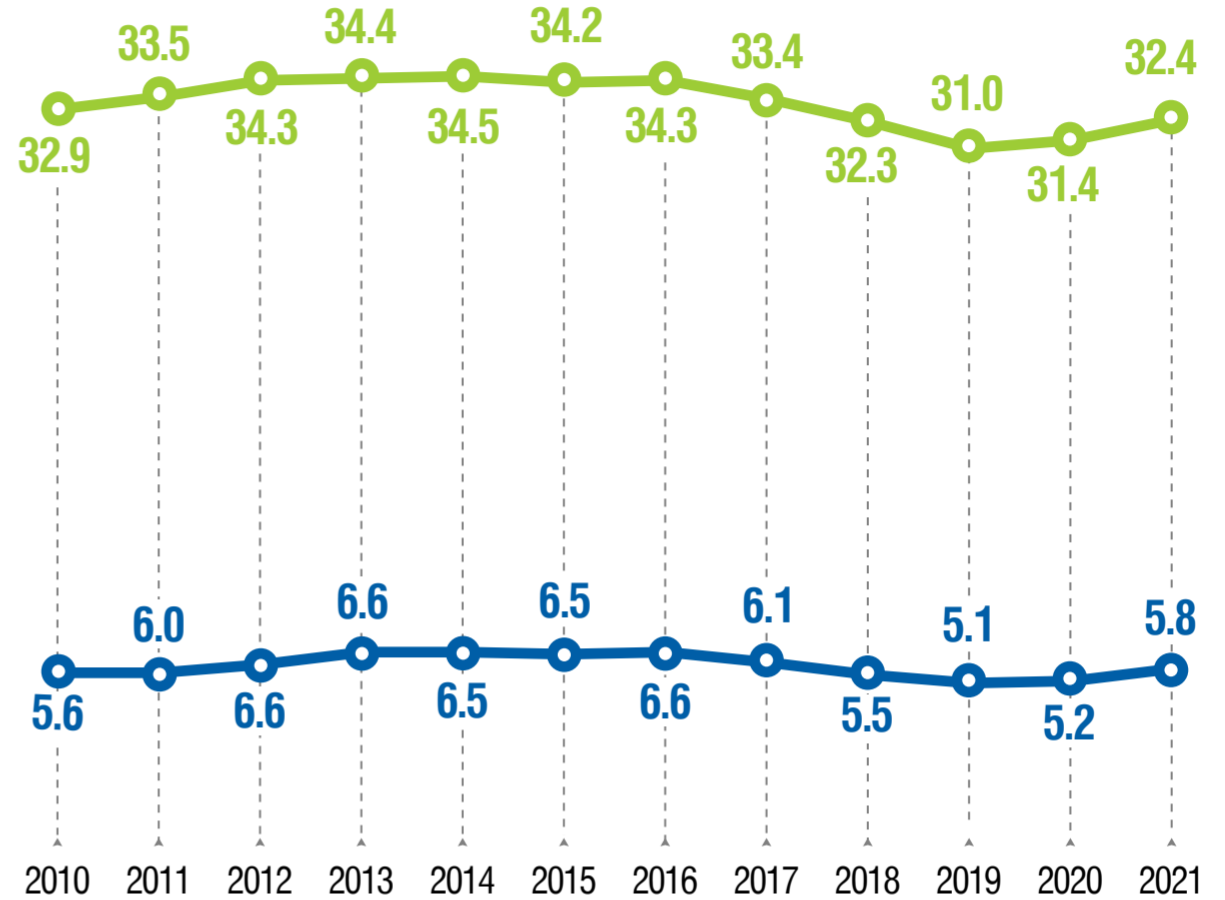
DISTRIBUTION OF INCOME BY QUARTILES

GINI

Gini coefficient is the ratio of cumulative shares of the population arranged according to the level of equalised disposable income to the cumulative share of the total equalised disposable income received by them. For 2021, if we choose randomly 2 persons, the difference between their income is expected to amount to 32.4% of the mean equalised disposable income.

S80/S20

The S80/S20 income quintile share ratio is the ratio of the total of equalised disposable income received by 20% of the country's wealthiest population to that received by 20% of the country's poorest population. In 2021 the share of the income of the wealthiest 20% of the population is 5.8 times higher than the share of the income of the poorest 20% of the population.

THE INCOME OF THE WEALTHIEST 20% OF THE POPULATION IS 5.8 TIMES HIGHER THAN THE INCOME OF THE POOREST 20% OF THE POPULATION
