TURNOVER INDEX IN ACCOMMODATION AND FOOD SERVICE ACTIVITIES SECTOR: 3rd Quarter 2019

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces the **Turnover Index in Accommodation and Food Service Activities Sector** and the indices in the individual subsectors "Accommodation, division 55" and "Food Service Activities, division 56" for the 3rd quarter of the year 2019.

The Overall Turnover Index is compiled as the composition of the individual divisions 55 and 56 of statistical classification NACE Rev. 2, which, according to provisional and reduced data to a typical month, is as follows:

Year-on-Year growth rates


- The Overall Turnover Index (divisions 55 and 56) during the 3rd quarter 2019 compared with the 3rd quarter 2018, increased by 6.1%, while the index for the corresponding period of 2018 had recorded an increase of 9.2%, in comparison with 2017 (Table 1, Graph 2).
- The Turnover Index in division 55 during the 3rd quarter 2019 compared with the 3rd quarter 2018, increased by 4.3%, while the index for the corresponding period of 2018 had recorded an increase of 7.0%, in comparison with 2017 (Table 1, Graph 3).
- The Turnover Index in division 56 during the 3rd quarter 2019 compared with the 3rd quarter 2018, increased by 10.0%, while the index for the corresponding period of 2018 had recorded an increase of 14.4%, in comparison with 2017 (Table 1, Graph 4).


Quarter-on-Quarter growth rates

- The Overall Turnover Index (divisions 55 and 56) during the 3rd quarter 2019 compared with the 2nd quarter 2019, increased by 88.5%, while an increase of 80.6% had been recorded when comparing the corresponding quarter of 2018, thus reflecting the intense seasonality of this sector (Table 1).
- The Turnover Index in division 55 during the 3rd quarter 2019 compared with the 2nd quarter 2019, increased by 112.7%, while an increase of 101.6% had been recorded when comparing the corresponding quarter of 2018, thus reflecting the intense seasonality of this sector (Table 1).
- The Turnover Index in division 56 during the 3rd quarter 2019 compared with the 2nd quarter 2019, increased by 52.1%, while an increase of 46.6% had been recorded when comparing the corresponding quarter of 2018, thus reflecting the intense seasonality of this sector (Table 1).

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Graph 2: Year-on-Year growth (%) of the Turnover Index in accommodation and food service activities sector (divisions 55_56), Base year: 2015=100.0








METHODOLOGICAL NO						
Generally	The Turnover Indices in Accommodation and Food Service Activities Sector are quarterly business cycl indices, which were first released in 2005, with base year (b.y.) the year 2005=100.0.					
Purpose of the index – definitions	The purpose of these indices is to calculate the activity of the surveyed sector in value terms. The turnover comprises the totals invoiced by the observation unit during the reference period (quarter) and correspond to the market sales of goods and services supplied to third parties. Subsidies on goods or services are als included. Turnover excludes VAT and other similar deductible taxes directly linked to turnover as well as a duties and taxes on the goods or services invoiced by the unit. Income classified as other operating income financial income and extraordinary income in company accounts is also excluded from turnover.					
Legal framework	The compilation of the turnover indices in accommodation and food service activities sector is governed b the Council Regulation (EEC) No.1165/98 of 19 th May 1998 concerning "Short Term Statistics" and by the Regulation (EC) No 1158/05 of the European Parliament and Council, amending the original Regulation 1165/98. Additionally, the compilation of the above index is governed by the Regulation No.1893/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 th December 2006, establishing the statistical classification of economic activities NACE Rev.2.					
Reference period	Quarter.					
Base year	2015=100.0.					
Revision	Pursuant to the provisions of Council Regulation No. 1165/98 concerning "Short Term Statistics", the indice are revised every five (5) years, in years ending in 0 or 5. The purpose of revising these turnover indices is t adapt them to recent developments in the structure of the accommodation and food service activitie sector.					
Statistical classification	The NACE Rev.2 statistical classification of economic activities is used in conformity with the Regulation (EC) 1893/2006 of the Council and the European Parliament.					
Geographical coverage	The indices cover the whole of the country.					
Coverage of economic activities	The indices cover the codes for divisions: 55 (accommodation activities) and 56 (food service activities), on NACE Rev.2 statistical classification.					
Statistical survey	The indices include trade and services enterprises with an annual turnover (in year 2015) equal or greate than 220,000€ (for division 55) and than 80,000€ (for division 56), from which a random representativ sample of 284 enterprises was therefore selected and surveyed.					
Calculating the indices	The indices are calculated by the implementation of the chaining method. Initially the moving based index is calculated by comparing the estimated turnover value for the current quarter with the corresponding valu of the previous quarter. Afterwards, the fixed base index for the current quarter is calculated by multiplyin the moving-based index by the fixed base index of the previous quarter. Then, the indices are reduced to typical quarter by multiplying the estimated turnover values by a specific weighting according to the number of working days of each quarter. The typical quarter refers to the actual number of working days.					
Compiled indices series	Timeseries of the indices are compiled from the 1 st quarter 2000 with base year 2015=100.0. After the current revision 2015=100.0, the indices for divisions 55 and 56 are compiled (since 1 st quarte 2010), as well as, the overall index 55_56, resulting from the composition of the two indices.					
Publication of data	The turnover indices in accommodation and food service activities sector (b.y.: 2015=100.0) are release quarterly since 3 rd quarter 2018.
