

ELSTAT Annual Statistical Work Programme 2021

PIRAEUS 2020

A. INTRODUCTION

The 2021 Statistical Work Programme of the Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) includes information on the statistics to be compiled and disseminated during 2021 (see Annex), as well as on the planned changes in the compiled statistics. These changes pertain to the production of new statistics on account of the implementation of new European Regulations, the amendment of currently produced statistics in order to fully comply with existing EU Regulations or to the need to respond more effectively to the needs of national and international users. In addition, the 2021 Statistical Work Programme includes information on the planned actions of ELSTAT for 2021 that aim at further enhancing the quality of its statistical data, as well as the access of users to statistics. The Programme has been compiled on the basis of the Hellenic Statistical Programme (ELSP) for the three-year period 2020 – 2022.

The primary objective of ELSTAT, for 2021 –as for all its annual statistical programmes– is to further improve the completeness, quality and timeliness of its statistics, by unswervingly observing the national and European statistical legal framework⁽¹⁾ in force and by adopting the highest standards and best practices of the European and International Statistical System. In this context, and in line with the prevailing trend in the European Statistical System (ESS), ELSTAT aims to make further use of administrative and other data sources and to use new technologies for the production of its statistics, with the aim of saving human and financial resources and reducing the burden on the surveyed units.

Among the main objectives of ELSTAT, for 2021, is the successful conduct of the General Censuses of Agriculture – Livestock and of Buildings and Population – Housing.

Coordination and cooperation with the agencies of the Hellenic Statistical System (ELSS) on the quality of their statistics is also an important priority of ELSTAT. In this context, in 2021, ELSTAT will continue its actions and initiatives to better coordinate and effectively support the statistical activities of the agencies, with a view to accelerating the completion of the process of certification of their statistics produced.

Among ELSTAT's objectives, for 2021, is also the maintenance of its active role in the ESS, through close cooperation with the other members of the ESS, in the framework of working meetings (Task Forces/Working Groups and Sector/Directors' Groups) organised by Eurostat on various statistical topics, and through active participation in, and material contribution to, European decision-making and coordination bodies for statistical matters.

Recognizing the importance of developing statistical literacy in Greece, in 2021, ELSTAT aims to further develop the actions of its strategy to promote statistical awareness among the general public.

B. NEW AND EXPERIMENTAL STATISTICS

1. Implementing EU Regulations and fulfilling European and international obligations and national needs

The production of new statistics by ELSTAT, in 2021, is driven mainly by Greece's statistical obligations towards the European Commission (Statistical Office of the European Union – Eurostat) and other European and international organisations. These obligations encompass the implementation of new European Regulations, ensuring compliance with existing Regulations, exploiting existing surveys to produce new statistical data, up dating databases, etc.

In addition, as part of its mission to produce topical and relevant statistics for citizens, businesses and policy makers, ELSTAT launched a series of experimental⁽²⁾ statistics whose main objective is to provide direct statistical information on selected important issues of Greece's economic and social life, reflecting, inter alia, the economic circumstances for the near future.

The first thematic field of the series of experimental statistics concerns the estimation of expectations of Greek exporting enterprises, in terms of percentage change in exports of goods, while the second thematic field concerns statistics to monitor the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic; these statistics were first launched in 2020

and will continue for as long as the circumstances so require.

The new and experimental statistics planned to be produced in 2021 for such purposes are presented below, by theme:

1.1. NEW STATISTICS

- POPULATION HOUSING CENSUS
 - Statistics on emigration, in the context of the 2021 Population Housing Census, with a view to improving the relevant estimates for the compilation of the estimated population. These statistics are planned to be disseminated no later than 2024.
- LABOUR MARKET
 - Statistics on accidents at work and other work-related health problems, in the context of an additional ad hoc module in the 2020 Labour Force Survey (Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/1709 pursuant to Council Regulation (EC) 577/98). These statistics are planned to be disseminated in 2021.
 - Statistics on the estimation of gross wage, dependent self-employed and the general health of the population, as well as statistics on the labour market position of immigrants, in the context of an additional ad hoc module, in 2021, of the Labour Force Survey (Regulation (EU) 2019/1700). These statistics are planned to be disseminated in 2022.
 - Statistics on the number of persons employed, hours worked, hours paid and labour costs, in the context
 of the Labour Cost Survey (LCS) in enterprises, with reference year 2020 (Regulation (EC) 530/1999).
 These statistics are planned to be disseminated in 2022.
- INCOME AND LIVING CONDITIONS OF HOUSEHOLDS
 - Statistics on: a) over-indebtedness (loans, number of loans and their purpose, source of financing of the loan, total amount of loans paid in the last month), b) consumption (expenditure on food at home, expenditure on food and drink away from home, expenditure on the use of public transport, expenditure on private transport) and c) wealth (asset status, saving, current value of main residence, period of maintenance of the current standard of living, in case the household does not receive any income in the future), in the context of new ad hoc modules to be added to the 2020 EU Survey on Income and Living Conditions of Households (EU-SILC) (Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/414 pursuant to Regulation (EC) 1177/2003). These statistics are planned to be disseminated in June 2021.
 - Statistics on the adequacy of food (ability or not to provide household members with sufficient food to guarantee each member the nutritional conditions necessary for a healthy living), in the context of new ad hoc modules to be added to the 2020 Survey on Income and Living Conditions of Households (EU-SILC), following an agreement with the UN Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO). These statistics are planned to be disseminated in June 2021.
- HEALTH
 - Statistics relating to 11 variables, including country of work, gender, age, type of work, sector of work and disease, in the context of the Survey on Occupational Diseases, with reference year 2018. These statistics are planned to be disseminated in 2022. This concerns the transmission to Eurostat of variables on occupational diseases, in the framework of the EODS (European Occupation Diseases Statistics) pilot survey of Eurostat.
- EDUCATION AND TRAINING
 - Statistics on the frequency of vocational training in enterprises, the participation of employees, the intensity of continuous vocational training programmes, the costs and educational strategies of enterprises, in the context of the Continuous Vocational Training Survey in enterprises, with reference year 2020. These statistics are to be disseminated in 2022 (Regulation (EC) 1552/2005).
- BUSINESS STRUCTURE
 - Statistics on Quarterly Business Demography, with reference year 2021. These statistics are to be dis-

seminated, on a quarterly basis, from the 2nd semester of 2021 onwards (Regulation (EU) 2019/2152).

- TOURISM
 - Study on the compilation of Tourism Satellite Accounts in cooperation with the Ministry of Tourism, in the context of meeting users' requests (Ministry of Tourism, Eurostat, OECD).
 - Study on the compilation of tourist accommodation statistics, in the context of the Collaborative Economy, using administrative data (Short-Term Property Register and Declarations of Short-Term Leases of the Independent Authority for Public Revenue – AADE).
- INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN GOODS
 - Statistics on global value chains and international sourcing of businesses. These statistics are new statistics, to be compiled on a three-year basis, providing information on how businesses organise their production at global level, such as the extent and location of international sourcing by business functions. The survey will be carried out as a pilot survey in 2021, for the reference years 2018 2020, and will cover information on employment by business function, international sourcing of business functions, incentives and barriers to sourcing and organising global value chains. The data will be broken down, by economic activity of NACE Rev.2 classification, size class of enterprise, geographical area, etc.
- ROAD TRANSPORT
 - Statistics on road traffic on the national road network, expressed in vehicle-kilometers (V-km), for all modes of transport, by type, age of vehicle, fuel, etc., in the framework of the statistical survey on vehicle-Kilometers V-km, with reference year 2019. This is a pilot compilation of statistics fulfilling the obligation to update a relevant international database, following an agreement between Eurostat, International Transport Forum and UNECE. These statistics are planned to be disseminated in the 4rth quarter of 2022.
- INFORMATION SOCIETY
 - Statistics on: a) internet activities (expressing a view on social or political issues in forums or social media, e.g. Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, b) online shopping (problems when shopping online, reasons for not shopping online) and c) e-skills (detection and checking of false or questionable information, videos, photographs, etc., posted on websites), in the context of the 2021 Survey on the Use of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) in Households and by Individuals. These statistics are planned to be disseminated in November 2021 (Commission Implementing Regulation to be adopted pursuant to Regulation (EC) 808/2004).

1.2. EXPERIMENTAL STATISTICS

- BUSINESS REGISTERS
 - Statistics on the evolution of turnover of the enterprises under suspension of operation, due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The purpose of these publications is to monitor and present the evolution of the basic economic figure (turnover from administrative sources) of the enterprises whose operation has been suspended, over time and specifically since the beginning of 2020, throughout the period of the confinement measures and during the period of the gradual lifting of these measure, as well as in comparison with the relevant months of 2019. These data can identify which of the enterprises have been most affected, in terms of turnover decrease, during the period when the confinement measures were in force, as well as which of the enterprises have recovered faster or slower when such measures have been gradually lifted.
 - Statistics on the evolution of turnover enterprises in accommodation and food service activities sector. The purpose of these publications is to map the evolution of the turnover of enterprises in the Accommodation and Food and Beverage Service Activities sectors. These sectors have been in the spotlight over the years because of their weight on the Greek economy as a whole and their extensive dispersion, with a significant presence in all regional units and a significant contribution to the corresponding local economies in Greece, often associated with the tourist product of Greece. The monitoring and dedicated publication of the evolution of the figures of these sectors is imperative, given the direct and indirect impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on them.

- Statistics on the evolution of turnover of enterprises in retail trade. The purpose of these publications is to present in details the evolution of the sales/turnover of all classes of activity in the retail trade sector, which is an important productive tertiary sector of the Greek economy, with a significant contribution to the Gross Domestic Product. The monitoring of the evolution of the figures of the retail trade activity classes is important, given the direct and indirect impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on them, as well as due to the resulting conclusions on the evolution of the consumption (in size, characteristics, preferences and substitution of products) of the Greek society, citizens and enterprises in Greece.

• INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN GOODS

- Statistics on the estimates of exports of goods in terms of percentage change, in order to depict the enterprises' export expectations in the current/following calendar year, providing an ex ante estimate on the trend of the change in Greek exports of goods. These estimates will be disseminated between May and June 2021 and updated estimates will be disseminated in October 2021.
- DEMOGRAPHY
 - Data on weekly deaths; data are provided by the Civil Register Offices. This is an ad hoc processing of data of deaths, for the purpose of depicting the evolution of deaths during the COVID-19 pandemic.

2. 2020 Agricultural – Livestock Census

The Agricultural – Livestock Census is conducted every 10 years and its purpose is to record all the agricultural and livestock holdings in the Country and to collect data on the basic characteristics of their structure and on the population employed in them, in order to monitor the development of agricultural and livestock activities for the purpose of compiling statistics, within the framework of Greece's national, European and international obligations. The 2020 Agricultural – Livestock Census is carried in all Member States of the European Union, in line with harmonised standards and methods, in the framework of the implementation of Regulation (EU) 2018/1091 on Integrated Farm Statistics (IFS).

The Agricultural – Livestock Census had been scheduled to take place in 2020, namely in October to December. However, the exceptional circumstances arising from the COVID-19 pandemic called for the adaptation of the initial planning, in order to take measures to protect public health. The new design is based on the electronic self-enumeration of holders of agricultural, livestock or mixed holdings and, where this is not possible, the data will be collected by telephone interview or in municipal/communal offices and agricultural cooperatives, in compliance with public health protection measures. In contrast, in accordance with the initial planning the data were to be collected physically via an interview with the farmer. Due to the re-design of the Census, it was postponed for 2021. In particular, the Census will be carried out in early 2021, depending on the conditions that will be formed with the COVID-19 pandemic.

On the basis of the data collected during the Census, the Statistical Farm Register will be updated. This register is the basic framework for carrying out many statistical tasks. In the period between two censuses, the Statistical Farm Register will be updated on the basis of the results of the sampling agricultural and livestock surveys, as well as information from administrative records and registers kept by other agencies.

3. 2021 General Censuses for Buildings and for Population – Housing

The purpose of the General Censuses for Buildings and for Population – Housing, which are conducted every 10 years, is to collect data on the building wealth of the Country, the size, composition and housing conditions of households, as well as demographic, economic and social characteristics of the population, aiming a compiling statistics, in the context of national, European and international obligations of the Country.

The 2021 Population – Housing Census will be conducted in all Member States of the European Union, by virtue of Regulation (EC) 763/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the population and housing censuses and its Implementing Regulations (EU) 2017/543, (EU) 2017/881, (EU) 2017/712 and (EU) 2018/1799, as well as the UNECE Recommendations for the 2020 Censuses of Population and Housing.

The General Censuses for Buildings and for Population – Housing were scheduled to be conducted in 2021. The Population – Housing Census was planned to be carried out using the traditional method, i.e., collecting the data by means of paper questionnaires, following a personal interview with a representative of the household, and the Buildings Census using tablets. However, the extraordinary circumstances arising from the COVID-19 pandemic called for the adaptation of the initial planning, in order to take measures to protect public health. The new design is based on the electronic self-enumeration of households and, where this is not pos-

sible, the data will be collected by telephone or physical interview, observing the public health protection measures. In this context, the works to be carried out are as follows:

- Conduct of the Buildings Census using tablets, in order to collect and process data more quickly and locate buildings geographically.
- Conduct of the Population Housing Census with a mixed system. The aim is to self-enumerate the population of Greece via an electronic application, but for households that do not have this possibility, the procedure will be carried out by means of an enumerator, using a paper questionnaire.
- Conduct of the Post-Enumeration Survey to estimate the coverage error.

The field census works, depending on the conditions that will be formed with the COVID-19 pandemic, are scheduled to start in May 2021 and to be completed by the end of the year.

4. Satisfying users' needs

ELSTAT, taking into consideration the comments and contributions made by the participants in the 10 User Conferences it has organised, as well as the results from the User Satisfaction Survey it conducts, has recorded the identified needs of users (including the needs of policy makers) and has included them in its priorities for the three-year period 2020 – 2022.

In this context, in 2021, ELSTAT is planning to:

- Add questions to questionnaires of surveys that are already carried out, in order to produce new statistics, such as inclusion of questions on migratory outputs in the questionnaire of the 2021 Population – Housing Census.
- Compile additional Public Use Files (PUFs)⁽³⁾, as well as standard Scientific Use Files (SUF)⁽⁴⁾ of statistical surveys of ELSTAT, according to predefined anonymisation criteria applied on survey microdata.
- Continue the work on the establishment, by the end of 2022, of safe centers, where authorised researchers
 will be able to access confidential data for scientific purposes, on which no methods of statistical disclosure
 control have been applied.
- Continue the coordination of ELSS bodies to develop and monitor the indicators of the 2030 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the United Nations and in constant cooperation with international custodian agencies, whose responsibility is to develop individual Sustainable Development Indicators.
- Further exploit the data from administrative and other sources, as well as the use of new technologies, in order to improve quality, reduce the time to produce statistical results in different areas, save resources and reduce the burden of respondents.
- Address the occurrence of divergences between statistics referring to the same variable that are produced by different agencies, in the framework of the conduct by ELSTAT of the certification process of the statistics of the ELSS agencies.

C. OTHER CHANGES IN THE PRODUCTION AND DISSEMINATION OF STATISTICS

Compliance with European regulations and adaptation to users' needs, combined with limitations on available human and financial resources, require changes to be made: improvements, revisions or discontinuation in the production and dissemination of statistics.

In the context of modernising European statistics and aiming at increasing their coherence and comparability, while reducing the burden on the surveyed units, the Commission (Eurostat) is to submit, in 4th quarter of 2020, to the European Parliament and the Council a draft Regulation on Agricultural Input and Output Statistics (SAIO).

The draft Regulation aims to consolidate all existing Regulations in the agriculture and livestock sectors, with the exception of those relating to the Agricultural – Livestock Census and the structure of agricultural and livestock holdings, which are covered by Regulation 2018/2091 (IFS).

The draft of the new SAIO Regulation is still under discussion and preparation in the Sectoral Working Groups, as well as in the Group of Directors for Agriculture Statistics. In this context, a Task Force has been set up, in which ELSTAT participates.

In addition, the following changes are planned, for 2021:

- LABOUR MARKET
 - Study of the methodology for monthly unemployment estimates, in the context of the requirements of the new Regulation (EU) 1700/2019 for the Labour Force Survey, on the basis of a model taking into account registered unemployment data provided by the Hellenic Manpower Organisation (OAED) and statistical estimation methods.
 - Change in the classification of the "occupation" in the Labour Force Survey, reference year 2021, which is to be made at 4-digit level of ISCO-08 (Regulation (EU) 2019/1700).
- INCOME AND LIVING CONDITIONS OF HOUSEHOLDS
 - Discontinuation of the production of statistics from the Survey of Income and Living Conditions (EU-SILC), for reference year 2020, relating to intergenerational transmission of economic and social disadvantages, as well as to demographic and social characteristics of household members, when the surveyed member aged 25 to 59 was 14 years old, due to the expiry of Regulation 2018/174 Implementing Regulation (EC) 1177/2003, on the basis of which the above statistics were produced.
- STATISTICAL BUSINESS REGISTER
 - Inclusion in the Statistical Business Register of all the statistical units provided for in Regulation (EC) 177/2008 and the information relating to the classification of institutional units by institutional sector of the economy, as defined in Regulation (EU) 549/2013. The dissemination of these statistics is planned to take place in December 2021.
- BUSINESS STRUCTURE
 - Full implementation of the definition of the statistical unit "enterprise" in Structural Business Statistics (SBS), as part of the obligation of Greece to fully comply with Regulation (EEC) 696/93 on the statistical units for the observation and analysis of the production system in the European Community.
 - Establishment of a single questionnaire of the Structural Business Statistics Survey for all sectors of economic activity covered by the relevant European Regulation (EC) 295/2008, based on the new Regulation (EU) 2019/2152, the first reference year being 2020.
- SHORT-TERM INDICES
 - Calendar and seasonal adjustment of data from the Building Activity Survey, for reference years 2001 2021 (Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/1197).
 - Calendar adjustment of Employment, Working Hours and Wages Indices, for reference years 2000 2021 (Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/1197.
 - Compilation of monthly Turnover Indices in Wholesale Trade and Motor Trade, based on available quarterly data and using data from administrative sources.
 - Integration of Indices of Persons Employed in Retail Trade (Division 47) into the Short-Term Indices of Employment, Hours Worked and Wages in key sectors of the economy and discontinuation of the relevant survey covering only the retail trade sector, from the reference quarter January – March 2021.
- TOURISM
 - Improving tourism statistics, by using administrative data generated due to the pandemic, such as the

Health Protocol for primary tourist accommodation establishments (Hellenic Chamber of Hotels) and non-primary accommodation establishments (Ministry of Tourism) and using them in combination with other data sources (administrative data from VAT and residence tax and data from surveys on nights spent in tourist accommodation establishments) and the development of a new methodology for compiling tourist accommodation occupancy statistics.

- Redesign of the Vacation Survey.
- INFORMATION SOCIETY
 - Discontinuation of the production of statistics of the Survey on the Use of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) in Households and by Individuals, for reference year 2021, concerning: a) trust, security and protection of personal data and b) the Internet of Things, by virtue of an Implementing Regulation to be adopted in the context of Regulation (EC) 808/2004.

D. IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF PRODUCED STATISTICS

In 2021, ELSTAT will continue its actions to ensure and further improve the quality of its statistics and maintain users' confidence in them. These objectives will be achieved through the faithful implementation of the national and EU legislative and institutional framework for statistics and the adoption of best practices and standards of the European and International Statistical System.

The actions to be taken by ELSTAT, in 2021, in order to meet the above objectives include continuing its close cooperation with the ELSS agencies and supporting their statistical activities, as part of the process of certifying their statistics and continuing the self-assessment of its statistical processes and its statistical output, as regards their compliance with the principles of the European Statistics Code of Practice (CoP) and the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation (Regulation (EU) 2016/679).

Furthermore, in the context of the planned 3rd round of the Peer Review in all Member States of the European Union and the countries of the European Free Trade Association, in the period from April 2021 to April 2023, ELSTAT will take the necessary steps to prepare for the conduct of the Peer Review in Greece.

In addition to the above actions, a number of actions are envisaged in areas, such as the use of technology to upgrade data collection, the further use of administrative and other data sources for the production of statistics, the reduction of the burden on respondents, the training of ELSTAT staff and other ELSS agencies, and the development of statistical literacy.

1. Conduct of the 3rd round of Peer Reviews

In the context of the conduct of Peer Reviews in Greece, ELSTAT will take the following steps, in 2021:

- · Appointment of a National Coordinator
- · Defining of the exact period for the Peer Reviewers' visit to Greece, in agreement with Eurostat
- · Informing the ELSS National Authorities of the conduct of the Peer Review
- Selection of the other ELSS National Authorities to participate in the Peer Reviews, in accordance with their
 pre-defined selection criteria in the ESS and duly informing Eurostat.

2. Certification of the statistics produced by the ELSS agencies

The certification by ELSTAT of the statistics produced by the other ELSS agencies is an important work and, at the same time, a mechanism for improving the quality and reliability of ELSS statistics.

ELSTAT will continue, during 2021, to have close cooperation with the agencies and will undertake further initiatives, if necessary, with a view to completing the certification of their statistics within the three-year period 2020 – 2022. In this context, ELSTAT plans to hold technical meetings with the Statistical Heads of the agencies, in 2021, in order to provide clarifications and guidance for the fuller compilation of the quality reports and the documentation of their statistical processes.

At the same time, in 2021, ELSTAT will continue its self-assessment, as regards the implementation of the

principles of the CoP so as, together with the certification of the statistics of ELSS agencies and the overall coordination of the ELSS statistical works by ELSTAT, to enhance the comparability and consistency of ELSS statistics.

3. Implementation of the General Data Protection Regulation

ELSTAT, in the context of the implementation of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (General Data Protection Regulation – GDPR), has completed, over the past years, a number of important actions, which have resulted in its full compliance with the GDPR.

In the course of 2021, an evaluation of the implementation of the GDPR within ELSTAT will be carried out by its staff, in order to review the correctness and completeness of its implementation, the level of consolidation of the basic provisions of the General Regulation by the staff and their integration into the daily work. In this context, depending on the results of the evaluation, corrective steps will be taken and the implementing measures adjusted, where necessary.

In addition, ELSTAT will continue to implement the actions aimed at fostering culture and information/training of the staff, which have been initiated in 2018, and include training seminars and workshops on the implementation of the General Data Protection Regulation in the production of official statistics for all ELSTAT staff. In particular, in 2021, staff training and information programmes will continue, which will now address more specialised issues of the application of the GDPR in the field of production of official statistics.

4. Using technology to upgrade data collection

In 2021, ELSTAT will continue its actions to exploit the possibilities offered by modern technologies for data collection and processing, in order to optimise the relevant procedures, in particular, in terms of saving time and resources, as well as to address the specific circumstances created by the COVID-19 pandemic.

More specifically, in 2021, ELSTAT will take the following actions related to the use of new technologies:

- Use of tablets for collecting the data of the Buildings Census to be conducted in 2021. The use of an electronic questionnaire is necessary for the Country to fulfill the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2018/1091 and, above all, for the requirement of geographical location of the building.
- Use of tablets for collecting the data of the Agricultural Livestock Census, to be conducted in 2021, where self-enumeration is not possible.
- Creation of an electronic platform for collecting the data of the Population Housing Census through the electronic self-enumeration of households.
- Creation of an electronic platform for collecting the data of the Agricultural Livestock Census through the electronic self-enumeration of the holders of agricultural and livestock holdings.
- Collection of the data of the Labour Force Survey by electronic means, in order for the Country to meet the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2019/1700.
- Cartographic support for the conduct of the 2021 Buildings and Population Housing Censuses with:
 a) colour maps of the Regional Units, available at 2 different scales; b) colour maps of Municipalities, available at 1 scale; and c) black and white maps for the Settlements of less than 700 inhabitants, for which a web application was created entitled "View/print maps for the 2021 Census".
- Initiation of the update of ELSTAT's geospatial database, with the data from the 2021 Buildings and Population Housing Census.

5. Utilising administrative data sources for the production of statistics

The European and international statistical community have focused on the use of administrative data and data from other sources, such as Big Data and privately held data for the production of statistics. In line with the current trend, ELSTAT has signed memoranda of cooperation with the ELSS agencies and has developed close cooperation with administrative data sources. ELSTAT will seek to continue and further develop its co-operation with administrative data sources, formalising such cooperation by signing memoranda of cooperation, where necessary.

In this context, ELSTAT plans to develop/continue, in 2021, a series of collaboration actions with administrative sources, with a view to maximising their use to meet the needs of specific statistical surveys/works. Indicatively, the following actions can be stated:

- Development of cooperation with the General Commercial Register (GEMI), in order to provide ELSTAT with data on enterprises kept electronically in the GEMI.
- Continue cooperation with the AADE for the provision of data from the tax form "Country Report on Multinational Enterprise Groups", in the context of the production of new statistics and the change of the methodology for compiling the Statistical Business Register, as well as the provision of data from other income tax forms for updating the Statistical Business Register and compiling structural business statistics.
- Continue cooperation with AADE to provide data on the system for monitoring short-term leasing and residence tax, in the context of improving tourism statistics.
- Continue cooperation with the Single Social Security Institution (EFKA) and the Single Payment Authority (EAP), with a view to providing data for updating the Statistical Business Register.
- Develop cooperation with AADE and the Bank of Greece (BoG), in order to use their available data for the needs of the International Sourcing Survey – Global Value Chains, for the period 2018 – 2020, and their data for the needs of the Survey on International Trade in Services Statistics.
- Develop cooperation with the Customs Authorities, in order to make use of their available data in the context
 of the compilation of statistics on trade with third countries.
- Develop cooperation with AADE, in order to make use of its available data, in the context of compiling statistics for intra-EU exports for the Survey on Intra-Community Trade (INTRASTAT).
- Develop cooperation with the Ministry of Finance and the Bank of Greece, in order to make use of their available data, in the context of the compilation of residential property price indices.
- Continue cooperation with the OAED to develop a model for the monthly unemployment data both to comply with the new Regulation (EU) 1700/2019 and to ensure consistency and comparability of unemployment statistics.
- Cooperation with the Ministry of Digital Governance, in the context of the Population Housing Census and promoting the interoperability of systems for compiling population statistics, from 2024 onwards, in the light of the implementation of a new Regulation on European Statistics on Population (ESOP), covering the fields of censuses, demography and migration.
- Develop cooperation with the Ministry of Infrastructure and Transport, for the pilot processing of administrative data from the database of the Vehicle Technical Control Centers (KTEO) for the estimation of vehicle-kilometers (V-km) per vehicle category.
- Develop cooperation with the Ministry of Tourism, in order to make use of its available data, in the context
 of the compilation, on a pilot basis, of Tourism Satellite Accounts.
- Develop cooperation with the National Centre for Social Research (EKKE), the Secretariat General for Family Policy and Gender Equality (GGOPIF) and the Centre for Research on Equality Issues (KETHI), in the context of the conduct, by EKKE, of a Survey on Gender-based Violence and the production of relevant statistics.
- Continue cooperation with the Payment and Control Agency for Guidance and Guarantee Community Aid (OPEKEPE), to update the Statistical Farm Register of ELSTAT every year.
- Continue cooperation with the Ministry of Environment and Energy (YPEN), in the context of the compilation
 of statistics on solid waste and environmental statistics, in general.
- Cooperation with the National Authority for Tertiary Education (ETHEAE), with a view to harmonising national data, in the field of tertiary education.
- Continue cooperation with the Ministry of Justice, with a view to restructuring criminal, political and administrative justice statistics, in conjunction with the establishment of the Office for the Collection and Processing

of Judicial Statistics (JustStat), which falls under the responsibility of the Ministry of Justice (Law 4700/2020, Article 358).

In addition, in the context of updating the statistical registers of buildings and population to be compiled, ELSTAT will continue to develop cooperation with administrative sources, in 2021, such as IDIKA, AADE, the Citizens' Register, the Ministry for Migration and Asylum and the Hellenic Land Registry, in order to acquire the necessary data.

6. Reducing the burden on respondents

In addition to the benefits in terms of improving the quality and timeliness of the produced business statistics and the saving of human and financial resources, the provision to ELSTAT of tax data of enterprises contributes to the drastic reduction in the nuisance of enterprises and their burden for completing questionnaires.

In the Section 5 above, the planned ELSTAT's actions, for 2021, were indicatively mentioned as regards the utilisation of administrative data sources. These actions, if implemented, are expected to contribute to further reducing the burden on respondents. Since 2017, ELSTAT has established the compilation of an annual report on the response burden of respondents. The conclusions of the above reports provide useful material for evaluating the effectiveness of ELSTAT's actions, for reducing the burden on respondents. In this context, in 2021, a relevant report will be compiled, with reference year 2020.

E. ENHANCING ACCESSIBILITY OF PRODUCED STATISTICS

1. Upgrading the portal of ELSTAT

ELSTAT has adopted a strategy for the dissemination and communication of its statistics, putting users at the heart of its activities. In this context, it seeks to continuously upgrade statistical products and their dissemination and communication means, in line with evolving international standards and making the most of digital tools for the creation of innovative products, by enhancing the format and enriching the content of its portal.

Therefore, in 2021, ELSTAT will continue to: a) enrich the portal with time series of the statistics produced and with public use files, b) develop standardised scientific use files for the needs of researchers, with predefined criteria for the anonymisation of the micro-data of its relevant statistical surveys, c) display selected statistics and their production processes with infographics, with a view to presenting them in a way that is understandable to the general public and easy to share in the social media, and d) make use of social media to give visibility to its statistical work.

2. Fostering Statistical Literacy

In 2021, ELSTAT will continue its actions concerning "Fostering Statistical Literacy" in Greece. These actions aim at:

- informing about the applications of Statistics in everyday life,
- · developing and consolidating statistical literacy,
- developing statistical consciousness,
- · informing pupils/students about the production processes of official statistics,
- informing about the Principles of the CoP and, in particular, Principle 5 concerning statistical confidentiality and data protection,
- informing about the significance of the "Population Housing Census" in our lives and
- consolidating statistical literacy in Greece, by creating a long-lasting and evolving relationship between trainees and ELSTAT.

ELSTAT is planning the following actions, always taking into consideration the special conditions that have been created due to the COVID-19 pandemic, in terms of restriction of movements and gatherings:

- 1. Continue the information visits of ELSTAT officials to educational units, for which it is difficult to access the facilities of ELSTAT, due to distance or any other reason.
- 2. Continue the actions concerning the information visits/speeches of the President of ELSTAT in educational units.
- Undertake initiatives aimed at expanding the EMOS (European Master in Official Statistics) certification to other Tertiary Education Institutions of Greece, apart from the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH), which provides an EMOS-labeled master programme since the academic year 2019/2020.
- 4. Update the content of the dedicated website on "Fostering Statistical Literacy".
- 5. Update the existing training material and develop new, in the form of books, workbooks, online games, videos, etc., by education level.
- Design webinars intended for pupils of primary and secondary schools. In order to implement these seminars, appropriate educational material and software will be developed, which will be accompanied by the necessary auxiliary material (tablets / laptops).
- 7. Promote the "Census@School" educational project to teachers and pupils, aiming at integrating it into the curriculum of primary and secondary education.
- 8. Develop an online educational game (e-gaming) for computer, tablet and mobile phone, with a view to making Statistics penetrate in secondary schools, using new technologies.
- 9. Continue to provide internship opportunities for students on the premises of ELSTAT.
- 10. Organise the 4th Panhellenic Statistics Competition, with the participation of teams of pupils from secondary education schools from all over Greece.
- 11. Continue the actions for the participation of ELSTAT in the "Summer Vocational Guidance" programme, which concerns upper secondary education school students, aiming to give the students a useful resource for their academic and professional career.
- 12. Dispatch printed educational statistical material to school libraries, as well as infographics to be posted in the classrooms.
- 13. Resubmit the application for the inclusion of the "Fostering Statistical Literacy" project in the school activity programmes applied in primary and secondary education.
- 14. Establish ELSTAT's cooperation with University Schools and Departments, aiming at developing topics for the thesis of postgraduate students, selected from a list of topics pertaining to the development, production and dissemination of official statistics.
- 15. Continue the works for creating a special space for exhibiting the available cartographic material of ELSTAT deriving from the Population Censuses.
- 16. Continue the active participation in the "Statistics Explained" programme of Eurostat.

F. CONFERENCES ORGANISED BY ELSTAT

In the framework of renewing and improving its statistical products, as well as of upgrading its services provided, ELSTAT will organise, in 2021, the 12th User Conference.

G. ESTIMATED EXPENDITURE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STATISTICAL WORK PROGRAMME

The implementation of the 2021 Statistical Work Programme of ELSTAT presupposes the provision of the necessary financial resources from the State Budget and Eurostat, as well as the reinforcement of ELSTAT with the required and appropriate human resources. The Commitment on Confidence in Statistics expressly lays down commitments for the Greek Government and the Greek State to reinforce ELSTAT with the necessary human resources, in order for ELSTAT to fulfill all its obligations at national and European level and to provide users with high quality statistics.

ELSTAT has estimated the minimum human resources for fulfilling of its obligations, as National Statistical Institute (NSI), which amounts to 1,076 employees, according to Article 22 of Presidential Decree 73/2019 (Government Gazette 114 / issue A'/ dated 4.7.19) referring to the "Organisation of the Hellenic Statistical Authority (EL.STAT.)". It is noted that the new Organisation of ELSTAT, which is in force since 5 August 2019, provides, among others, for the recruitment of 147 employees in the newly-established personnel branch "Statistical Interviewers" (obligatory education level), for the collection of primary statistical survey data, which are used for the production of statistics. The recruitment of the above mentioned staff aims to drastically reduce the number of external statistical interviewers (external collaborators) currently used for the above purpose. The reduction of the number of external statistical interviewers is expected to contribute not only to reducing significantly the administrative burden in ELSTAT and the saving of resources, but also to enhancing the quality of the collected data.

The budgeted expenses for 2021 are estimated at a total of 146,054,314.00 euro. The above expenses are classified in the following categories:

- a) Labour cost (salaries of ELSTAT's staff, including basic salary, allowances (family allowance, liability position allowance, etc.), social security contributions, remuneration for overtime work, etc.).
- b) Expenses related to the staff's travel within Greece and abroad, i.e., travel, accommodation and daily allowance expenses for the employees of ELSTAT travelling:
 - in Greece, out of home or outside the office, for conducting statistical surveys in the field, and
 - abroad, for participating in meetings, seminars, etc. organised by Eurostat and other international organisations.

This category also includes expenses related to the redeployment or secondment of ELSTAT's employees to other agencies in Greece or abroad.

- c) Other operating expenses, including expenses related to ELSTAT's buildings (Central and Regional Offices), such as rents, heating, communication, water supply, security, cleaning and maintenance costs, as well as expenses related to advertising and public relations, subscriptions, expenses for the provision of consumables (paper, stationery, medical and pharmaceutical supplies, materials for the maintenance and repair of premises and equipment), fuel, etc. This category also includes expenses for the provision of capital formation goods (furniture, PCs, printers, photocopiers and other office equipment), as well as the remuneration of external survey workers, who are used by ELSTAT for the collection of data of ELSTAT's statistical surveys.
- d) Projects financed by Eurostat (for the conduct of surveys, studies and other statistical works).

The following table presents the budget estimate of ELSTAT (in euro) for 2021, as submitted by ELSTAT in the General Accounting Office (GAO), in August 2020, in comparison with the approved budget for 2020:
