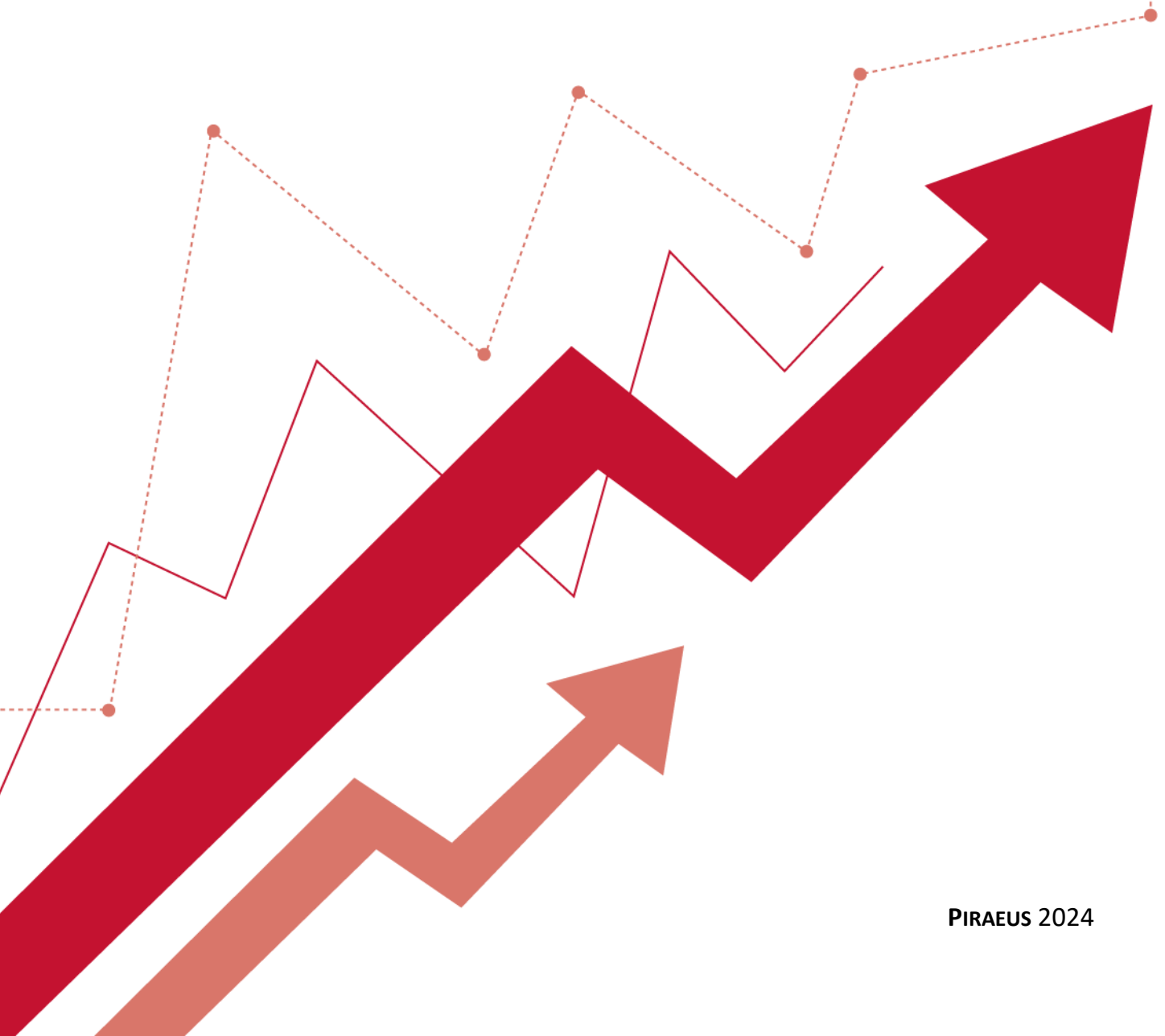

Annual Statistical Work Programme

2025



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A. INTRODUCTION

The Annual Statistical Work Programme of the Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) for the year 2025 (hereinafter 2025 AWP) includes information on the statistics to be compiled and published during 2025 (see Annex), as well as the planned changes to already produced statistics. These changes concern either the production of new statistics, mainly due to the implementation of new European Regulations, or the amendment of produced statistics, in order to fully comply with existing European Regulations and/or to respond more effectively to the needs of users of official statistics. In addition, the 2025 AWP includes information on the planned actions of ELSTAT, for 2025, that aim at further enhancing the quality of its statistics and the access of users to them. The 2025 AWP has been compiled on the basis of the Hellenic Statistical Programme (ELSP) for the three-year period 2023 – 2025.

ELSTAT has set as a primary objective in 2025 AWP the further improvement of completeness, quality and timeliness of its statistics, by unswervingly observing the statistical legal framework¹ and by adopting best standards and practices of the European and International Statistical System. In this context and in line with the prevailing trend, it aims to further exploit administrative and other data sources, as well as to make use of new technologies for the production of its statistics, with the aim of enhancing their quality, completeness and speed of production, saving resources and reducing the burden of the surveyed units (households and/or enterprises).

Among ELSTAT's objectives, for 2025, remains the coordination and cooperation with the agencies of the Hellenic Statistical System (ELSS), as well as the execution of the improvement actions planned for 2025 in the framework of the implementation of the recommendations of the Peer Review Report for the ELSS. Furthermore, in ELSTAT's objectives is the maintenance of its active role in the European Statistical System (ESS), which has been consolidated with the election, from July 2022, of the President of ELSTAT, Mr. Athanasios C. Thanopoulos, as the head of the Partnership Group (PG), the high-level group of elected Heads of the National Statistical Institutes of the ESS, especially at a crucial time after the adoption of the new legislative measure concerning the revision of the European Statistical Regulation 223/2009, which is the basic legislative act for the design, development and dissemination of European official statistics. The revision of this Regulation will shape future developments in the field of European statistics.

In addition, ELSTAT, recognising since 2016 the importance of fostering statistical education in Greece, aims, for 2025, to further develop the actions of its strategy regarding the cultivation and strengthening of statistical consciousness in the general public. Accordingly, the actions of ELSTAT to achieve the "democratisation" of statistical information and its provision to users in an understandable and friendly way are further promoted.

Finally, the year 2025 coincides with the 200th anniversary of the institution of official statistics in modern Greece, since Law No. 48 of September 10, 1825 "On conscription census" stipulated: "To conduct a conscription by census in the whole Greek territory, in proportion to one soldier per 100 inhabitants of each city, town or village", which is the institutional framework of the first Population Census, in 1828.

B. NEW AND EXPERIMENTAL STATISTICS

1. Implementing European Regulations and fulfilling European and international obligations, and national needs

The statistical obligations of our Country towards the European Commission (Statistical Office of the European Union - Eurostat) and other European and international organisations is mainly the trigger for the production of new statistics by ELSTAT, in 2025. The production of these new statistics results from the implementation of new European Regulations, ensuring compliance with existing Regulations and the needs arising from the "Agenda 2030" and the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The utilisation of existing surveys, the designing and conduct of new ones, as well as the access and use of administrative data are the basic tools.

In addition, ELSTAT, in the framework of its mission to produce up-to-date and useful statistics for citizens, businesses and policymakers, continues to produce experimental statistics, launched in 2020, whose main objective is to provide direct statistical information on selected important issues of the economic and social life of Greece.

The new statistics, as well as the experimental statistics scheduled to be produced in 2025 for the above purposes, are the following by theme:

1.1. New Statistics

- POPULATION AND SOCIAL CONDITIONS

- *Development of Statistical Registers on Buildings and Population*, based on the new Regulation on population statistics under preparation.
- *Statistics on the combination of family life and work*, in the context of conducting a supplementary (ad hoc) survey of the Labour Force Survey, of 2025 (Regulation (EU) 2019/1700). Dissemination of results in 2026.
- *Statistics on: a) the positive aspects of mental health, b) the suicidal ideation, c) the barriers to participate in specific activities of daily life, due to long-term health problems, d) the use of home health services, by people with chronic health problems or by elderly people, e) receiving informal or formal care on a regular basis (at least once a week), due to a chronic health problem or disability or age and f) the number of hours, per week, of receiving formal care*, in the context of the Health Survey (Implementing Regulation, under issue, of Regulation (EU) 2019/1700). Estimated release time of statistics: December 2026 or January 2027.
- *Statistics on: a) energy and environment, in the context of adding new ad hoc modules to the Survey on Income and Living Conditions of Households (EU-SILC), on the use of sustainable forms of energy, carbon footprint measurement, energy performance, environmental inequalities and sustainable consumption and b) health*, in the context of the three-year module of the above survey in the health sector (Implementing Regulation, under issue, of Regulation (EU) 2019/1700). Estimated release time of statistics: March 2026.
- *Utilisation of administrative data for the compilation of statistics on the prisoners of the Country*. Investigating data availability back to 2016, when the survey was discontinued, provided the ELSTAT - Ministry of Citizen Protection interoperability is completed.
- *Study on the designing and compilation of Wage Change Index*.

- SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, DIGITAL SOCIETY

- *Statistics on: a) the devices used for internet access, b) the activities through the website or web application, c) the use of artificial intelligence (AI) tools, d) the problems when using the internet and the ways to solve them, e) the reasons for not using the internet, f) the use of electronic identification, g) the number of online purchases, h) the problems encountered during online*

purchases, i) health issues (accidents, injuries, etc.) or security issues caused by the online purchase of products, j) digital skills (e-skills) and k) the protection of privacy and personal data (cookies, advertisements, tracking of online activities), in the context of conducting the Survey on the Use of Information and Communication Technologies by Households and Individuals (Implementing Regulation, under issue, of Regulation (EU) 2019/1700). Estimated release time of statistics: December 2025.

- **INTERNATIONAL TRADE**

- *Global Value Chains and International Sourcing Statistics for the period 2021-2023.* Number of enterprises and number of employees, for enterprises with more than 50 employees, of branches B to N of NACE Rev. 2, with distinction by operational function and geographical area. The mandatory collection of data, every three years, is provided for by the new legislative framework for business statistics (EBS). Dissemination of statistics in 2025.
- *International trade in services statistics – mode of supply of the service through commercial presence (case 3), of the year 2023,* based on the new legislative framework for business statistics (EBS). Dissemination of results in 2025.

1.2. Experimental Statistics

- **POPULATION AND SOCIAL CONDITIONS**

- *Continuation of the extraordinary Statistical Announcements on provisional data on deaths by week, based on primary data coming from the Registries.*
- *Change of the frequency of dissemination of birth data results from annual to quarterly* (new Regulation, under preparation, on population statistics).
- *Survey on the living conditions of LGBTI+ people and on the discrimination due to sexual orientation.* The survey is conducted in line with the guidelines and proposals that have been set, which are inspired by the principle of equality and the prohibition of discrimination, based on sexual orientation, identity, characteristics and gender expression.
- *Statistics on Unemployment Benefits Recipients (UBR).* Participation in a pilot collection of Eurostat.
- *Early estimates of social protection benefits, 9 months earlier than the production of the relevant statistics.* Participation in a pilot collection of Eurostat.
- *Statistics on people with disabilities, chronic diseases, etc., using administrative data from the Disability Certification Centres (KEPA).*

- **INDUSTRY, TRADE AND SERVICES**

- *Business Register statistics for the self-employed, with data by social characteristics.* The connection of business statistics with social statistics is an internationally key direction of development, while at the same time there is a relevant demand from the basic users. Dissemination of results in 2026.
- *Monthly Statistical Announcements on the Evolution of the Business Cycle of the Greek Economy, in the branches of Accommodation and Food Services, at regional level and in the individual branches of Retail Trade.*
- *Statistics on arrivals and overnights in short-term rental accommodations.* Registration of tourist traffic in the accommodations that operate through a digital platform, in the framework of developing experimental statistics using administrative sources and data from Eurostat, to improve the coverage of tourist traffic.

- *Tourism sustainability measurement indicators.* Feasibility investigation and development of indicators to measure the sustainability of tourism in the fields of economy, employment, society, culture, environment and digitisation. Application of the international and European methodology for the comprehensive measurement of the tourism sector.
- *Monitoring the project of study and compilation of Tourism Satellite Account, in cooperation with the competent Services.*
- **TRANSPORT**
 - *Pilot estimation of vehicle kilometers (V-km) by vehicle category, through the processing of administrative data from the database of the Vehicle Technical Inspection Centres (KTEO), based on the joint Eurostat/ITF/UNECE questionnaire.*

2. Satisfying users' needs

ELSTAT, taking into consideration the comments and suggestions of the users of its statistics, including those who draw up public policies, records their needs and includes them in its priorities. The main communication channels of ELSTAT with the users are the annual User Conferences it organises and the User Satisfaction Survey it conducts.

In this context, in 2025, ELSTAT is planning the following actions:

- Compilation of Public Use Files (PUFs)² for additional ELSTAT statistical surveys, as well as standardised Scientific Use Files (SUFs)³ of ELSTAT statistical surveys, according to predefined anonymisation criteria of the microdata of the surveys.
- Continuation and completion of the preparatory work for the creation of a safe centre (collaboration with experts, centre equipment, etc.), where authorised researchers will be able to access confidential data for scientific purposes, on which no methods of statistical disclosure control have been applied.
- Continuation of the coordination of the ELSS agencies for the development and monitoring of the 2030 individual indicators of the Sustainable Development Goals (2030 SDGs) of the United Nations, with constant cooperation with the international agencies (custodian agencies) that have under their responsibility the compilation of individual indicators.
- Further exploitation of data from administrative and other sources, as well as of new technologies, with the aim of improving the quality, reducing the production time of statistics, saving resources and reducing the burden on respondents.
- Completion of the work to upgrade ELSTAT's website, with the aim of providing users with a comprehensive experience of accessing statistics, always based on the best international practices and technologies. The new ELSTAT website will offer multiple possibilities to access statistical results, including the use of a dissemination database, as well as the provision of statistics in the form of open data.

C. OTHER CHANGES IN THE PRODUCTION AND DISSEMINATION OF STATISTICS

Compliance with European Regulations and adaptation to users' needs, in combination with constraints in terms of available resources, necessitate changes, such as improvements, revisions and discontinuations, in the production and dissemination of statistics.

It should be noted that, within 2024, a new legislative measure was adopted concerning the amendment of Regulation (EC) 223/2009 on European statistics. The revision of the basic legislative framework governing the development, production and dissemination of European statistics was deemed necessary in order for the ESS to be able to respond to new requirements and remain suitable for future ones.

In the context of the modernisation of European statistics and with the aim of improving their coherence and comparability, while reducing the burden on the surveyed units, the Commission (Eurostat) is preparing the following legislative Proposals, to be submitted to the European Parliament and to the Council:

- Proposal for a Regulation on European fisheries and aquaculture statistics.
- Proposal for a Regulation on commercial real estate statistics.

Currently, the following legislative files are in the consultation stage, in the Council and the European Parliament:

- Proposal for a Regulation on Labour Market Statistics on Businesses.
- Proposal for a Regulation on European statistics on population (ESOP).

In addition, the following changes are planned for 2025:

- **STATISTICAL NOMENCLATURE**
 - In the context of the production and dissemination of a large number of European statistics in the economic, social, environmental and agricultural sectors, the statistical classification of economic activities in the European Union NACE (Nomenclature statistique des Activités économiques dans la Communauté Européenne) is applied.
 - From January 1, 2025, Regulation (EU) 2023/137, which amends Regulation (EC) 1893/2006 establishing the current version of NACE, the NACE Rev. 2, will be gradually applicable. The revision of NACE Rev. 2 was deemed imperative, as since its publication in 2006, the economy of the EU has evolved significantly, with the expansion of existing and the development of new branches of economic activity. For this purpose, in recent years Eurostat has collaborated with its partners in the ESS.
 - The new NACE Rev. 2.1 includes several additions of codes and structural changes compared to the previous version, with the aim of expanding existing economic activities or covering completely new economic activities that were created following the development of new technologies. However, the maximum effort was made so as not to change the structure of the classification in sectors of the economy in which no drastic change occurred.
- **NATIONAL ACCOUNTS**
 - *Incorporation into the National Accounts of the results of the Household Budget Survey (HBS), of 2024, which will be conducted based on the new COICOP 2018 classification.*
 - *Studying best international practices and further utilising data from administrative sources, for the compilation and continuous improvement of the quality of the National Accounts.*
- **PRICES**
 - *Recalculation of the weights and time series of indices of the Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP), based on the new COICOP 2018 classification, in accordance with the Implementing Regulation (EU) 2016/792, applicable from January 2026.*

- SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, DIGITAL SOCIETY
 - *Discontinuation of statistics of the Survey on the Use of Information and Communication Technologies by Households and Individuals, regarding: a) the limitation of activities due to health problems (Gali Indicator), b) activities through a website or online application, c) the reasons for carrying out learning activities online, d) the actions of opening /deleting an online account and problems, e) the problems when using websites, or applications of public services or authorities, f) the detailed recording by type of physical products purchased online, g) the Internet of Things, and h) the green technologies (Green ICT).* It concerns sections or individual questions of the survey that are interrupted, either because they concern indicators that are not compiled on an annual basis or because they were included on a trial basis.
- HOUSEHOLD CONSUMPTION EXPENDITURE
 - *Application of the new COICOP 2018 classification of goods and services in the Household Budget Survey (HBS), based on a gentlemen's agreement, in the framework of the Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/1700, applicable from 2026.*
- JUSTICE
 - *Hellenic Cadastre Survey for the future replacement of the Survey on Land Registries – the Land Registries will be abolished and included in the Hellenic Cadastre, within 2024.* Collection of relevant data from the Hellenic Cadastre, which will be transmitted electronically to ELSTAT by the Hellenic Cadastre's IT Division. The survey results will be produced when the necessary data is provided from the Hellenic Cadastre.
- HEALTH
 - *Cessation of production of Health Survey statistics on the prevalence of liver cirrhosis.*
- SOCIAL PROTECTION
 - *Estimation of the Average Itemised Social Contribution Rate (AISCR), using data from administrative sources, in the context of improving the quality and accuracy of the statistics produced.*
- BUSINESS REGISTERS
 - *Application of the revised classification of economic activities NACE Rev. 2.1 in the Statistical Business Register, in the context of Regulation (EU) 2023/137 amending Regulation (EC) 1893/2006.*
- LABOUR MARKET
 - *Carrying out a study of the use of administrative data from multiple sources to compile new statistics in the Structure of Earnings Survey (SES) and the Gender Pay Gap Survey (GPG), due to the implementation of the new Regulatory framework on the Labour Market on Businesses (LMB).*
- SHORT TERM INDICES
 - *Study of the possibility of using new tax data as primary sources for the compilation of Producer Price Indices and Turnover Indices in the Industry and Construction sectors, as well as Turnover Indices in Trade and Services.* The utilisation of new data sources will further improve the validity and accuracy of the indices.

- **TOURISM**
 - *Publication of provisional data with a monthly announcement of arrivals and overnights in hotel similar establishments, short-stay accommodation establishments and tourist campsites, with a view to be harmonised with the monthly submission of provisional data to Eurostat and to faster satisfy users' needs.*
- **INTERNATIONAL TRADE OF GOODS**
 - *Change of the variables whose data ELSTAT collects from the National Customs Authorities, and adaptation of ELSTAT's information systems to receive the data, for the compilation of statistics on international trade of goods with third countries (Extra-Union trade), in application of Annex B of the Delegated Regulation (EU) 2015/2446, with the operation of the corresponding import and export information systems and the establishment of a trans-European system (CCI) to support central customs clearance.*
- **AGRICULTURE, LIVESTOCK, FISHERY**
 - *Development of cooperation with the Ministry of Rural Development and Food regarding the pilot application of administrative data collection for the production of fishery statistics, with the aim of improving the quality of the collected data, as regards their timeliness, fuller coverage and greater analysis. Adaptation to the new requirements of the Regulation under issue on the modernisation of EU fishery statistics, through the use of administrative data.*
- **SEA TRANSPORT**
 - *Use of administrative data from the information systems of the Ministry of Maritime Affairs and Insular Policy, such as the Electronic System for Booking Seats and Issuing Passenger Tickets, and the National Single Window NSW/SSNET, in the framework of producing passenger and freight traffic statistics, aiming at improving the quality of statistics (in terms of their timeliness), the saving of human and financial resources, and the reduction of the burden on respondents.*

D. IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF PRODUCED STATISTICS

ELSTAT will continue, in 2025, its actions to ensure and further improve the quality of its produced statistics and to uphold users' trust in them. These objectives will be accomplished by fully implementing the statistical legislative framework and by adopting best practices and standards of the European and International Statistical System.

Among the actions to be undertaken by ELSTAT in 2025, aimed at accomplishing the above objectives, is the continuation of its close cooperation with the ELSS agencies and the support of their statistical activities, in the framework of exercising its coordination role.

Besides the above actions, a series of actions is envisaged in areas such as: using technology to upgrade data collection, further utilising administrative and other data sources for the production of statistics, reducing the burden on respondents, training the staff of ELSTAT and of the other ELSS agencies, as well as fostering statistical literacy.

1. Carrying out improvement actions for the implementation of the recommendations made in the context of the 3rd round of Peer Reviews in the ESS

The improvement actions for the implementation of the Reviewers' recommendations for the ELSS, with the aim of its further improvement and development, were finalised in November 2023 and their

completion period extends from the 4th quarter of 2023 to the 4th quarter of 2027. ELSTAT completed the actions (3) which had a deadline for completion the 4th quarter of 2023 and has begun the implementation of the actions scheduled to be completed within 2024. For 2025, the completion of the following actions, among others, has been scheduled:

- Organisation of a seminar on the European Statistics Code of Practice (CoP), the ESS Quality Assurance Framework and specific issues of their implementation. The seminar in question, which is addressed to the statistical Heads and the staff of the ELSS agencies involved in statistical work, will be held for the first time in 2024 and thereafter will be held on an annual basis.
- Signing and start of implementation of a memorandum of cooperation between ELSTAT and each of the 3 National Authorities of the ELSS that participated in the Peer Review (Ministry of Rural Development and Food, Ministry of Environment and Energy, National Documentation Centre) on exchange and training personnel involved in statistical work of the above agencies.
- Organisation of a workshop with the participation of providers of administrative data used in the production of official statistics, with the aim of informing them about the importance of their data for the production of official statistics and their obligation, provided for in Article 11(7) of the Greek Statistical of Law 3832/2010, as in force, to inform and consult ELSTAT on any legal provision regarding the creation of new or the restructuring of existing administrative data sources and public registers or files, so as to ensure the capacity to utilise them for statistical purposes. The above workshop will take place for the first time in 2024 and thereafter will take place on an annual basis.
- Designing, in collaboration with the data providers, and starting the implementation of a mechanism/process, in order to ensure that ELSTAT is informed and consulted on any legal provisions regarding the creation of new or the restructuring of existing administrative data sources and public registers or files.
- Signing and start of implementation of a memorandum of cooperation between ELSTAT and the Ministry of Digital Governance regarding the enhancement/extension of the interoperability of administrative databases.
- Drafting of a five-year action plan for the communication and dissemination priorities of ELSTAT, aiming at modernising the dissemination channels and meeting user needs.
- Organisation of training series on specialised statistical topics, in the premises of ELSTAT and of the 3 National Authorities of the ELSS that participated in the Peer Review. The seminar in question, which is addressed to the staff of the above National Authorities involved in statistical work, will be held for the first time in 2024 and thereafter will be held on an annual basis.
- Upgrading of ELSTAT's portal by using modern technologies allowing users to have access to granular statistical data in an interactive way, while ensuring the observance of statistical confidentiality, and the creation of a special section on the portal that will provide access to an online dissemination database, equipped with tools for ad hoc user queries, as well as with new visualisation options.
- Completion of preparatory work for the creation of a safe centre in ELSTAT's premises.

2. Coordination of the actions of the ELSS agencies

ELSTAT, in the framework of its coordinating role in the ELSS, will continue, during 2025, its close cooperation with the ELSS agencies, with the aim of their full compliance with the CoP principles. In the above context, it will provide support to the National Authorities that participated in the Peer Review, to complete the improvement actions of their competence, which have been scheduled to be completed within 2025.

3. Implementation of the General Data Protection Regulation

ELSTAT, in the framework of implementing Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council, on the protection of natural persons against the processing of personal data and for the free movement of such data (General Data Protection Regulation – GDPR), has completed, during the previous years, a series of important actions, which resulted in its full compliance with the GDPR provisions.

In 2025, the work of assessing the implementation of GDPR will continue within ELSTAT, so as to further increase the level of consolidation of the GDPR provisions by ELSTAT's staff and to ensure their full and correct implementation in their daily work. In particular, in 2025 ELSTAT plans to conduct additional specialised actions of personalised assessment of the consolidation and implementation of the GDPR provisions in the daily work of each ELSTAT's employee, but also at the level of organic units. The findings of the above actions will be included in an evaluation report and used as a guide for future improvement interventions. Depending on the results of the GDPR implementation assessment, there will be corrective actions and readjustment of the implementation measures, if this is deemed necessary.

Moreover, relevant training and information actions for newly hired employees at ELSTAT will be carried out, so as to achieve the same level of awareness as of the existing staff. In addition, the actions aimed at cultivating culture and informing – training the staff, which have started since 2018 and include educational seminars and informative one-day conferences on specialised issues of GDPR implementation for the production of official statistics, addressed to the entire ELSTAT's staff, will continue, with the coverage of new relevant topics. More precisely, within 2025, targeted training and information programmes for the staff will continue, which concern more specialised issues of GDPR implementation in the area of the production of official statistics.

As ongoing actions, the following will be carried out within 2025: a) updating of the policies related to the GDPR implementation in ELSTAT, where required, while at the same time new ones will be developed, where necessary, to cover new needs and areas of action, and b) updating of the log files of the activities of ELSTAT's organic units concerning the processing of personal data, as well as the files of the detailed recording of the procedures followed by the above organic units.

4. Use of new technologies to upgrade data collection

ELSTAT will continue, in 2025, its actions to take advantage of the possibilities offered by modern data collection and processing technologies. More specifically:

- **RETAIL PRICE INDICES**
 - *Investigating the feasibility of collecting prices (pilot price collection) for the Consumer Price Index (CPI) and the Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP), for the categories of electrical goods and hotels, using the "Web Scraping" method, in the context of the modernisation of the HICP price collection process in accordance with Eurostat guidelines.*
 - *Investigating the feasibility of collecting prices for the CPI and HICP, using the "Scanner Data" method - preparatory work, in the context of the modernisation of the HICP price collection process in accordance with Eurostat guidelines.*
 - *Development of an electronic application for upgrading the environment for the calculation of CPI and HICP, based on the new COICOP 2018 classification, in the framework of Regulation (EU) 2016/792 of the European Parliament and of the Council. Launching of the application: January 2026.*
- **LABOUR MARKET**
 - *Data collection of the Labour Cost Survey through a web application, to improve the response rate of enterprises, the processing times and the quality of results.*

- **BUSINESS REGISTERS**
 - *Implementation of a new unified database and special management software for the automated and centralised updating of the Statistical Business Register from multiple data sources.* In the new database all the necessary information to feed the EuroGroups Register (EGR), for the compilation of the Annual and Quarterly Business Demography and the Monthly Announcements of Experimental Statistics will be kept.
 - *Development and pilot application of a special software,* through which the basic consistency checks of the Multinational Enterprise Groups data, which will be studied in the context of the Large Case Unit (LCU), will be carried out automatically.
- **TOURISM**
 - *Development of a web application for the collection of the data of the Survey on the Qualitative Characteristics of Resident Tourists, compatible with the use on tablets, with the capacity of functioning as a web application,* aiming at reducing the time and ensuring the security of data collection, registration and processing, as well as reducing the time of IT checks.
- **AGRICULTURE, LIVESTOCK, FISHERY**
 - *Development of a web application for collecting the data of the Annual Agricultural Survey, with the integration of automated checks,* aiming at improving the quality of the collected data and producing agriculture - livestock statistics more timely.
 - *Development of web application for collecting the data of the Annual Aquaculture Survey, with the integration of automated checks,* aiming at improving the quality of the collected data and producing aquaculture statistics more timely.
- **ROAD TRANSPORT**
 - *Development of a web application for collecting the data of the Road Freight Transport Survey, compatible with the use on tablets,* with the aim of reducing the time of data collection, registration and processing, as well the time of IT checks.
 - *Development of an electronic data collection system from the Information System of the Hellenic Police, for the Road Traffic Accidents Survey,* with the aim of reducing data collection and processing time.

5. Utilising administrative data sources for the production of statistics

The European and international statistical community have focused on the utilisation of administrative data and data from other sources, such as Big Data and privately held data, for the production of statistics. In line with the prevailing trend, ELSTAT has proceeded to the signing of memoranda of cooperation with ELSS agencies and has developed close cooperation with administrative data sources. ELSTAT will seek to continue and further develop its cooperation with administrative data sources, formalising such cooperation through the signing of memoranda of cooperation, where required.

In this context, ELSTAT plans to develop/continue, within 2025, a series of cooperation actions with administrative sources, with the aim of maximising their utilisation to meet the requirements of specific statistical surveys/tasks. Indicatively, the following actions are stated:

- Continuation of the cooperation with the General Commercial Registry (GEMI), for the provision of business data that is kept electronically in GEMI.
- Continuation of the regular cooperation with the Independent Authority for Public Revenue (IAPR) to access data of the Tax Register and Tax Forms (Income, Indirect Taxes, etc.) used to update the Statistical Business Register, compile short-term statistics and structural business statistics, as well as for the provision of data from the Tax Form "Report by Country on

Multinational Enterprise Groups", in the framework of producing statistics on enterprise groups in Greece and updating the structure of the groups in the Statistical Business Register.

- Cooperation with the Ministry of Interior for the timely transmission of birth certificates for the production of birth statistics.
- Continuation of the cooperation with the IAPR, with the aim of utilising data on electronic distance sales, from businesses to individuals in another EU member state, in the framework of compiling statistics on intra-EU trade.
- Continuation of the cooperation with the IAPR, with the aim of utilising data from the "myProperty" database, for the needs of the House Price Indices Survey.
- Continuation of the cooperation with the IAPR, for the provision of data on the income of wage-earners.
- Exchange of data from surveys conducted by the Bank of Greece (BoG), and in particular, Outward FATS, Services Trade by Enterprise Characteristics (STEC) for the production of statistics on international trade in services – way of providing the service through a commercial presence (case 3) Mode of Supply - MoS 3.
- Continuation of the regular cooperation with the Customs Authorities, for the provision and utilisation of customs data, in the context of the compiling statistics on the trade of goods with third countries.
- Continuation of the cooperation with the IAPR, for the extraction of data, in the framework of producing statistics on the activities of tourist accommodations and further updating the Statistical Register of Tourist Accommodations.
- Cooperation with the IAPR for the provision of data on short-term rental accommodations, for the needs of the Survey of Arrivals and Overnights at Short-Term Rental Accommodations.
- Investigating the possibility of using mobile telephony Big Data (MNO's) to measure tourist flows, in the context of using alternative/new data sources and improving the coverage of tourist traffic.
- Participation in the study and compilation project of the Tourism Account Satellite, in collaboration with the Ministry of Tourism.
- Continuation of cooperation with the Electronic National Social Security Entity (e-EFKA) and the Single Payment Authority (EAP), for the provision of data from the above entities for updating the Statistical Business Register.
- Continuation of cooperation with e-EFKA, for the provision of monthly data of the entity for the compilation of short-term employment and labour cost indices, as well as development of cooperation with the aim of utilising data on pensions, in the context of the Survey on Income and Living Conditions of Households (EU-SILC).
- Development of cooperation with the IAPR and the Organisation of Welfare Benefits and Social Solidarity (OPEKA), in order to utilise their available data on income and social benefits, respectively, for the needs of the Survey on Income and Living Conditions of Households (EU-SILC).
- Development of cooperation with the Ministry of Interior, in the framework of the breakdown of the cohabitation agreements by number of previous agreements.
- Development of cooperation with the Interoperability Center (KED) of the Ministry of Digital Governance, in order to use the web services that have been developed, regarding births, marriages, cohabitation agreements, divorces and deaths.
- Continuation of the cooperation with the Ministry of Rural Development and Food and the Payment and Control Agency for Guidance and Guarantee Community Aid (OPEKEPE), for the annual update of the Agricultural Statistical Register of ELSTAT.

- Development of cooperation with the Ministry of Rural Development and Food, as well as with the Directorate General of Sustainable Fisheries, with the aim of conducting, henceforth, the Survey on Sea Fishery with the use of administrative sources.
- Continuation and expansion of cooperation with public agencies (Ministry of Interior, Ministry of Labour and Social Security, Ministry of Migration and Asylum, Ministry of Digital Governance, Ministry of Education, Religious Affairs and Sports, General Secretariat for Information Systems and Digital Governance, IAPR, e-Government Center for Social Security (IDIKA), etc.), in the framework of compiling and updating the Population and Buildings Statistical Registers, as well as of producing basic population statistics, on an annual basis, after 2025.
- Investigating the use of land cover geospatial data from international databases and information systems (e.g. Corine Land Cover database of the Copernicus system), with the aim of compiling ecosystem accounts in the future.
- Continuation of the cooperation with the "ERGANI" Programme, in the framework of conducting the Labour Force Survey, and exploring the possibility of expanding this cooperation to cover the needs of the Job Vacancy Survey and of the Statistical Population Register under development.
- Continuation of the cooperation with the Hellenic Authority for Higher Education (HAHE), with the aim of harmonising the national data in the field of higher education.
- Continuation of the cooperation with the Hellenic Cadastre, for the provision of the data required for the needs of the Survey on Land Registries.
- Development of cooperation with the Ministry of Education, Religious Affairs and Sports, for the provision of data from the myschool platform, for the needs of the Survey on Private Primary and Secondary Schools.
- Development of cooperation with the Ministry of Infrastructure and Transport, for the processing of administrative data from the KTEO database, for the estimation of vehicle kilometers (V-km) by vehicle category.
- Development of cooperation with the Ministry of Maritime Affairs and Insular Policy, for the utilisation of the administrative data of its information systems, such as the Electronic System for Booking Seats and Issuing Passenger Tickets, and the National Single Window NSW/SSNET, in the framework of producing passenger and freight traffic statistics.
- Investigating the feasibility of using administrative data provided by the ERGANI and e-EFKA information systems, both to improve the quality of the statistics produced by the Labour Statistics Section and to reduce the response burden of the enterprises surveyed in the Labour Cost Survey and the Job Vacancy Survey.
- Collection of data from the Health Regions, regarding the equipment and beds of the Primary Health Care Units.
- Cooperation with ERGANI and EFKA for the delimitation of access to the new administrative data, for the needs of the Structure of Earnings Survey (SES) and the Gender Pay Gap Survey (GPG).
- Cooperation with the IAPR for the delimitation of access to the new tax data, for the compilation of the Producer and Turnover Indices in the Industry and Construction sectors, as well as the compilation of Turnover Indices in Trade and Services.
- Cooperation with the Ministry of Citizen Protection for the extraction of data from the Information System of the Reformatory Establishments of the Hellenic Police, for the needs of the Survey on the Prisoners.
- Study of the possibility of retrieving and receiving electronic files of the Ministry of Citizen Protection and of the Hellenic Police Headquarters for road traffic accidents, from the Information System of the Hellenic Police.

- Cooperation with public entities (Ministry of Labour and Social Security, Social Security Organisations, National Organisation for Health Care Services (EOPYY), Greek Public Employment Service (DYPA), General Accounting Office (GAO), IDIKA, etc.), for the provision of data for estimating the average social security contribution rate.

E. ENHANCING ACCESSIBILITY TO THE STATISTICS PRODUCED

1. Designing new IT projects of ELSTAT

In a constantly changing environment and with new technologies evolving at a rapid pace, it is necessary for ELSTAT to undertake actions and initiatives aimed at the modernisation of its applications and the adoption of new technologies.

In this context, ELSTAT's Informatics Division has planned, among other things, to proceed, during 2025, with the upgrading of its Business Intelligence (BI) System, through the redesign of its basic subsystems and structural elements, and the upgrading of the technologies supporting it. In addition, ELSTAT will proceed with the development of new thematic sections and the enrichment of the System with new data, such as, indicatively, those of the 2021 Buildings and Population - Housing Censuses.

During 2025, the continuous upgrading of applications to support the production of statistics and the means of their dissemination and presentation will continue, in accordance with evolving international standards and utilising, to the greatest extent possible, digital means for the creation of innovative products, through the improvement of the format and the enrichment of the content of ELSTAT's portal. An important action in this field is also the ongoing development of new tools for displaying and disseminating statistical data, in a way flexible and compatible with the best international practices.

Therefore, ELSTAT will continue during 2025 to: a) enrich its portal and dissemination system with new statistical results, time series of the statistics produced and public use files, b) develop standardised scientific use files, for the needs of researchers, with predefined criteria for anonymising the microdata of its relevant statistical surveys, c) illustrate its selected statistics, as well as their production processes, with infographics, aiming to present them in a way that is understandable to the general public and suitable for reproduction on social media, d) develop procedures and make available its selected statistical products in the form of open data and e) utilise the social media, for the promotion of its statistical work.

2. Fostering Statistical Literacy

ELSTAT will continue, in 2025, its strategy on "Fostering Statistical Literacy" in Greece. ELSTAT's objectives are to:

- inform about the applications of Statistics in everyday life,
- develop statistical consciousness,
- inform pupils/students about the production processes of official statistics,
- inform about the CoP principles and in particular about Principle 5 regarding the observance of statistical confidentiality and data protection.

For 2025, ELSTAT plans the following actions:

- Taking initiatives with the aim of expanding the awarding of the European Master in Official Statistics (EMOS) label and in other university institutions of the Country, apart from the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and the Athens University of Economics and Business, to which the specific label has been awarded.
- Continuation of informing, through telephone communication and electronic mail, the Directorates of Secondary Education in Greece, outside of Attica and Thessaloniki, on the actions

included in ELSTAT's strategy on "Fostering Statistical Literacy in Greece". The communication will be followed by the transmission of the relevant educational material.

- Continuation of educational presentations at ELSTAT's premises, for pupils and students, in Athens and Thessaloniki, as well as of educational visits to schools in the Prefecture of Rodopi.
- Continuation of educational presentations at the ELSTAT stand, during the Thessaloniki International Fair (TIF).
- Expansion of informative visits of ELSTAT executives to educational units (schools/universities).
- Continuation of the informative visits/speeches of the President of ELSTAT in educational institutions.
- Continuation of the promotion of the educational programme "Census at School—Census@School" to teachers and pupils.
- Continuation of providing opportunities for practical training to students, at ELSTAT's premises.
- Conduct of the 8th Panhellenic Competition in Statistics, with the participation of groups of pupils from Lower and Upper Secondary Schools of the Country.
- Renewal of the content of the workbooks "The numbers in our life".
- Renewal of the educational presentations and of the educational game accompanying the presentation.
- Continuation of cooperation with university schools, with the aim of preparing theses of postgraduate students, with thematology related to the development, production and dissemination of official statistics.
- Continuation of ELSTAT's participation in the Cross-Border Internship Programme of EMOS students. ELSTAT, and more specifically its mentor representative, has the obligation to work closely with the intern, depending on the thematic area assigned to her/him, and to provide support, encouragement and information to the intern, depending on her/his work and experience in relation with the host institution (organisation culture, informal codes and behaviours, etc.).
- Continuation of ELSTAT's participation in the "Summer Vocational Guidance" programme, addressed to upper secondary education school pupils, with the aim that the experience gained by the pupils to be a useful resource for their academic and professional career. The action is activated after a relevant request submitted by school units.

F. ORGANISATION OF CONFERENCES, INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS AND DEVELOPMENT OF STATISTICAL COLLABORATIONS

In the framework of renewing and improving the statistical products, of upgrading its services provided, as well as of cultivating cooperation bonds and of strengthening bilateral relations with the National Statistical Institutes (NSIs) of EU member states, but also of developing further collaborations, both at national and international level, in areas of common interest, ELSTAT, during 2025, plans the following actions:

- Organisation of the 14th Users Conference.
- Visit of a delegation of the Statistical Office of the Republic of Cyprus to ELSTAT's premises, aiming at continuing and strengthening the cooperation of the two NSIs, in the framework of their joint actions in the European and international statistical community, with a view to continuously ensuring the quality and reliability of official statistics, as well as to cooperating

more closely with producers and users of statistics and responding to their ever-increasing needs.

- Continuation of the organisation of visits of ELSTAT representatives to NSIs of other countries. The purpose of the meetings is the development of synergies and the exchange of know-how, experiences and good practices. For 2025, the organisation of a meeting of senior officials of the Statistical Office of Malta, the Statistical Office of the Republic of Croatia, the Statistical Service of Cyprus and ELSTAT is planned.
- Organisation, in collaboration with Eurostat and the European Statistical Advisory Committee (ESAC), of a workshop, in the framework of the actions planned by ESAC for the National Users Councils (NUCs), during the 1st semester of 2025.
- Continuation of ELSTAT's participation in the Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance (IPA) 2019 programme of Eurostat, intended to the provision, by the NSIs of the EU member states, of training to statistical employees of the IPA countries.
- In addition, as mentioned above in Section 1 of Chapter D, in the framework of carrying out the improvement actions for the implementation of the recommendations of the Peer Reviewers for the ELSS, ELSTAT is planning, within 2025, the following actions:
- Organisation of a seminar on the CoP, the ESS Quality Assurance Framework and specific issues of their implementation, which is addressed to the statistical Heads and the staff of the ELSS agencies involved in statistical work.
- Organisation of a workshop with the participation of providers of administrative data used in the production of official statistics, with the aim of informing them about the importance of their data for the production of official statistics and their obligation to inform and consult ELSTAT on any legal provision regarding the creation of new or the restructuring of existing administrative data sources and public registers or files, so as to ensure the capacity to utilise them for statistical purposes.

Finally, a series of actions is expected to take place to celebrate the 200th anniversary of the institution of official statistics in modern Greece.

G. ESTIMATION OF EXPENDITURE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STATISTICAL WORK PROGRAMME

The implementation of the 2025 AWP presupposes the allocation of the necessary resources from the State Budget and Eurostat, as well as the reinforcement of ELSTAT with the required and appropriate human resources. The Commitment on Confidence in Statistics contains explicit commitments for the Government and the Greek State to reinforce ELSTAT with the necessary resources, so that it can fulfill all its obligations, at national and European level, and provide users with high-quality statistics.

The budgeted expenses, for 2025, are estimated at a total of 40,189,002.00 euros and are classified into the following categories:

- a) Labour cost (salaries of ELSTAT's staff, including basic salary, allowances (family allowance, liability position allowance, etc.), social security contributions, remuneration for overtime work, etc.).
- b) Expenses related to staff travel within Greece and abroad, i.e., travel, accommodation and daily allowance expenses for the employees of ELSTAT travelling:
 - In Greece, out of home or outside the office, for conducting statistical surveys in the field, and

- abroad, for participating in meetings, seminars, etc. organised by Eurostat and other international organisations.
- c) Other operating expenses, including expenses related to ELSTAT's premises (Central Service and Regional Statistical Offices), such as rents, expenses for electricity, telecommunications, water supply, security and maintenance of buildings, expenses for advertising and public relations, subscriptions, expenses for the provision of consumables (paper, stationery, medical and pharmaceutical supplies, materials for the maintenance and repair of premises and equipment), fuel, etc. This category also includes expenses for the provision of capital formation goods (furniture, PCs, printers, photocopiers and other office equipment), as well as the remuneration of private collaborators, who are used by ELSTAT for the collection of data of statistical surveys it conducts.
- d) Expenses for projects financed by Eurostat (for conducting surveys, studies and other statistical tasks).
- e) Expenses for the Censuses of Agriculture - Livestock, Buildings and Population – Housing.

The following table presents the budget estimate of ELSTAT (in euros) for 2025, in comparison with the approved budget of 2024:
