

ELSTAT Annual Statistical Work Program 2016

A. INTRODUCTION

The 2016 Statistical Work Program of the Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) includes information on the statistics to be compiled and disseminated during 2016 (see Annex), as well as on the planned changes in the compiled statistics. These changes pertain to the production of new statistics on account of, for example, the implementation of new European Regulations, to the amendment of currently produced statistics in order to fully comply with existing EU Regulations or to the need to respond more effectively to the needs of national and international users. In addition, the 2016 Statistical Work Program includes information on the planned actions of ELSTAT for 2016 that aim at enhancing the quality of its statistical data, as well as the access of users to statistics.

The 2016 Statistical Work Program of ELSTAT has been compiled on the basis of the Hellenic Statistical Program (ELSP) for the three-year period 2014 – 2016.

During the first years of the period 2010-2015, the major objective of ELSTAT was to establish the reliability of its statistical data, on the basis of producing statistics that observe the basic quality standards for European statistics. After having achieved this objective, during the recent years the new main objective of ELSTAT was to secure and further improve the quality of its statistics by unswervingly observing the national and European statistical legal framework in force and by adopting best practices and principles of the European and international statistical system. This is also the major objective of ELSTAT for 2016.

In addition, in 2016 a major objective of ELSTAT will continue to be the support of the improvement of the quality of statistics that are produced by the other agencies of the Hellenic Statistical System (ELSS), where appropriate, by coordinating the statistical activities of the other ELSS agencies and by assessing their statistics in order to certify them as "official statistics". Moreover, a crucial factor for the accomplishment of the above improvement is the provision by the State to the ELSS agencies of the human and financial resources that are necessary for the production of statistics and ensuring their access to administrative data sources.

Furthermore, an important objective of ELSTAT for 2016 is to further utilize administrative data sources and use new technologies, with the aim of improving the quality and timeliness of its statistical data by saving, at the same time, human and financial resources and by reducing administrative burden on respondents.

Among the objectives of ELSTAT for 2016 is also to maintain its active role in the European Statistical System (ESS), through close cooperation with the other members of the ESS in the framework of working meetings (Task Forces/Working Groups and Sector/Directors' Groups) organized by Eurostat on various statistical topics, and through active participation in, and material contribution to, European decision-making and coordination bodies for statistical matters.

The implementation of the Commitment on Confidence in Statistics, which was signed by the Greek Government and the European Commission in 2012, is crucial for the achievement of ELSTAT's objectives.

B. NEW STATISTICS

1. Implementing EU Regulations and fulfilling European and international obligations

The production of new statistics planned for 2016 by ELSTAT is driven, to a large extent, by the need to fulfil ELSTAT's obligations towards the Statistical Office of the European Union (Eurostat) and other European and international organizations. These obligations involve, inter alia, implementing new European Regulations, ensuring compliance with existing Regulations, filling in questionnaires, updating databases, etc. The new statistics that are planned to be produced in 2016 for such purposes are presented below by theme:

LABOUR MARKET

- Statistics on work organisation and working time arrangements, in the framework of the conduct in 2015 of a supplementary ad hoc survey in the Labour Force Survey.

INCOME AND LIVING CONDITIONS OF HOUSEHOLDS

Statistics on social and cultural participation, in the framework of new ad hoc modules added in the 2015 Survey on Income and Living Conditions (EU-SILC). Statistics pertaining to social and cultural participation (social integration/getting together with friends and relatives, confidence/solidarity to friends and relatives, participation to social activities) (Regulation to be adopted implementing Regulation 1177/2003).

EDUCATION

- Statistics on Institutes of Vocational Training (Regulation 912/2013 implementing Regulation 452/2008).
- Statistics on education expenditure (Regulation 912/2013 implementing Regulation 452/2008).

ENERGY CONSUMPTION

 Statistics on energy consumption in households, in the framework of new ad hoc modules added in the 2015 Household Budget Survey (HBS). Statistics pertaining to heating and cooking systems, water supply systems, energy saving interventions and the use of public transport (Regulation implementing Regulation 431/2014).

• INFORMATION SOCIETY

- Statistics on the use of information and communication technologies, in the framework of a new thematic unit to be added to the 2016 Survey on Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) in households and by individuals. A new thematic unit pertaining to statistics on security of personal data provided through the internet, devices for connecting to the internet from home, electronic purchases of financial services, advertisements on the social media and e-purchases (Regulation to be issued implementing Regulation 808/2004).

TRANSPORT

Statistics on the road network of Greece, with reference year 2015. Statistics pertaining
to the total length of the road network of Greece, broken down by road category. These
statistics are compiled in the framework of the Joint UNECE/ITF/Eurostat Questionnaire.

- Statistics on road transport by buses and coaches, with reference year 2015. Statistics pertaining to the number of itineraries, the available seat-kilometres, etc. of buses and coaches in Greece. These statistics are compiled in the framework of the Joint UNECE/ITF/Eurostat Questionnaire.
- Passenger mobility statistics, with reference year 2015. Statistics pertaining to the transportation of population (means of transport, purpose of the transportation, kind of fuel of passenger vehicles, average distance travelled, passenger-kilometres, etc.). The compilation of these statistics is driven by the need to provide relevant data to international organizations.
- Statistics on road traffic for the compilation of vehicle-kilometres (VKM), with reference year 2015. Statistics pertaining to the road traffic in the national road network expressed in vehicle-kilometres (for all transport means, by category of road network, type and age of the vehicle, fuel, etc.) These statistics are compiled in the context of the need to update the relevant European database and to include these statistics in a Regulation after 2018.
- Statistics on transport through natural gas pipelines. Statistics pertaining to the natural gas pipelines network (length and capacity of the national network of natural gas pipelines, employment and financial data of the companies, level of investment and infrastructure maintenance cost, transport work in tonnes and tonne-kilometres, etc.) These statistics are compiled in the framework of the Joint UNECE/ITF/Eurostat Questionnaire.

ENVIRONMENT

- Water statistics, with reference year 2015, in the framework of a gentlemen's agreement.
- Environmental protection expenditure accounts, with reference year 2014, in the framework of the preparation works for the full implementation of Regulation 538/2014 on European Environmental Accounts.
- *Environmental goods and services sector accounts*, with reference year 2014, in the above framework.
- Statistics on energy consumption in the services sector, with reference year 2013.

• HEALTH

Statistics on accidents at work, with reference year 2014, in the framework of the conduct
of the survey on Monitoring Accidents at Work. New statistics pertaining to the causes
and conditions of accidents at work, number of days' absence from work and data on work
accidents for all insured persons (Regulation 349/2011 implementing Regulation
1338/2008).

2. Satisfying users' needs

ELSTAT, taking into consideration the comments and contributions made by the participants in its five annual User Conferences, as well as the results from the User Satisfaction Survey it conducts, has identified and recorded the needs of users. Satisfying such needs is among ELSTAT's priorities for the three-year period 2014-2016.

In this context, in 2016 ELSTAT is planning to:

• conduct an Adult Education Survey, in order to estimate the participation of adults in education and the impact of education on their employment status, as well as an ad hoc survey

for estimating participation of young people to the labour market and transition from education to employment,

- produce statistics on education expenditure,
- produce additional statistics on energy consumption,
- compile statistics on nurses, by gender, on the basis of the licenses issued for practising the nursing profession,
- produce additional statistics on accidents at work,
- address the discrepancies observed between similar statistics produced by different agencies
 and cooperate with several producers of statistics, within ELSTAT but also among the ELSS
 agencies -with ELSTAT as coordinator- with the aim of ensuring comparability of statistics.
 This objective will be accomplished in the framework of the certification, to be continued
 by ELSTAT in 2016, of the statistics produced by the ELSS agencies and also through the
 periodic assessments of the main statistical output of ELSTAT, which already takes place
 and will be continued in 2016,
- develop an action plan with the aim of improving accessibility to microdata of statistical surveys.

C. OTHER CHANGES IN THE COMPILATION AND DISSEMINATION OF STATISTICS

Compliance with EU Regulations and adaptation to users' needs, in combination with constraints in terms of the available human and financial resources, necessitate changes: improvements, revisions and discontinuations in the production and dissemination of statistics. The following changes are planned for 2016:

INCOME

 Implementation of the revised classification of individual consumption by purpose (COICOP HBS 2013) in the 2015 Household Budget Survey, in the framework of harmonizing the hitherto applied classification with the classification applied in the European Statistical System.

POPULATION

Revision of regional data on Estimated Population for the period 1990-2014, on account
of the change in the Annex, as regards Greece, of the European Regulation on the establishment of a common classification of territorial units for statistics (NUTS), which applies
from the 1st January 2015 onwards.

D. IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF PRODUCED STATISTICS

In 2016, ELSTAT will continue to carry out actions aiming at ensuring and further improving the quality of produced statistics and upholding users' confidence in them. These objectives will be accomplished by fully implementing the Greek and EU legal and statutory framework on statistics and by adopting the best practices and standards of the European and international statistical system. A crucial factor for the accomplishment of the objectives is, also, the implementation of the Commitment on Confidence in Statistics, which was signed by the Greek Government and the European Commission in 2012.

Among the specific actions to be undertaken by ELSTAT in 2016, aimed at accomplishing the aforementioned objectives, is the completion of all the remaining actions under ELSTAT's competency included in the multidimensional Joint Overall Statistical Greek Action Plan (JOSGAP) – both the actions that had been included in the JOSGAP in 2010 when it was first put into force, and the actions that were added in the course of time.

Among the important actions of ELSTAT targeted towards this direction is the better utilization of administrative data sources and new technologies, on which ELSTAT will continue to put special emphasis in 2016.

1. Joint Overall Statistical Greek Action Plan (JOSGAP)

All the actions –under the competency of ELSTAT– of Pillars A and C of the Joint Overall Statistical Greek Action Plan (JOSGAP), which aim at enhancing the institutional environment of the ELSS and the quality of the Greek government finance statistics, respectively, are to be completed within 2015. These actions that will be completed by the end of 2015 pertain, as regards Pillar A, to the elaboration and approval of the new Organization of ELSTAT. As regards Pillar C, the above actions pertain to the classification of the Legal Entities under Private Law supervised by the Local Government in the Register of the General Government Entities and to the posting on ELSTAT's website of the quality reports for all the conducted statistical surveys/works. In this context, ELSTAT will focus on completing the remaining actions under pillar B of the JOSGAP within 2016.

In 2016, ELSTAT will continue and intensify its efforts towards completing, by the end of the year, the remaining actions of pillar B of JOSGAP, which aim at improving the processes and capacity for the production of statistics in Greece through a program of technical assistance provided by Eurostat to ELSTAT.

The remaining actions of pillar A are under the competency of the Government. These actions refer to the continuous implementation of the Commitment on Confidence in Statistics and pertain to the support of ELSTAT's operation over time.

2. Certification of the statistics produced by the ELSS agencies

Pursuant to article 11, paragraph 6 ("Competencies of ELSTAT") of the Statistical Law 3832/2010 as amended and in force, ELSTAT certifies as "official statistics" the statistics produced by the other ELSS agencies. The certification as "official" by ELSTAT of the statistics produced by the other ELSS agencies is an important factor and a tool for enhancing the quality and reliability of ELSS statistics.

During 2013 and 2014, ELSTAT conducted two pilot certification exercises of statistics produced by national Authorities of the ELSS, which develop, produce and disseminate European statistics and it has planned to complete a first round of certifications of statistics of the national Authorities (i.e., the ELSS agencies producing European statistics) by the end of 2015. The process of the certification of statistics will be continued in 2016 with the statistics of the other 5 ELSS agencies.

3. Using technology to upgrade data collection

In 2016, ELSTAT, as envisaged in the Hellenic Statistical Program (ELSP) for 2014-2016, will carry on the actions for taking full advantage of the possibilities offered by the new technologies for data collection, with the aim of optimizing the relevant procedures, especially with regard to saving time and resources.

More specifically, in 2016, ELSTAT will undertake the following actions concerning the use of new technologies:

- Electronic questionnaires and web applications for data collection. The following actions are indicatively mentioned, which have already been planned:
 - Development of a web application concerning data collection of the Survey of Production and Sales of Industrial Products (PRODCOM). This web application will contribute to collecting more easily the data from enterprises and to processing the data in a faster and sounder manner.
 - Extending the use of portable personal computers for the collection of data of the Labour Force Survey, with the aim of accelerating the production of the survey results and improving the quality of the collected data.
 - Use of electronic questionnaires, in parallel with the use of printed questionnaires, for collecting the data of the 2015 Survey on Income and Living Conditions of Households (EUSILC), in the framework of the implementation of an Action Plan for enhancing the survey.
 - Development of a web application concerning data collection for the: a) Job Vacancy Survey, b) survey on the compilation of short-term labour indices, c) survey on the compilation of labour cost indices. This web application will contribute to collecting more easily the data from enterprises and to processing the data in a faster and sounder manner.
 - Designing and development of an application for the collection, by electronic means, of the primary data of the survey on domestic and international traffic of goods in the main ports of Greece (Directive 2009/42/EC), aiming at the acceleration and simplification of the whole procedure for collecting primary data.
 - Development of a web application for the collection of data of the Survey on Road Traffic
 Accidents, in the framework of the cooperation of ELSTAT with the Division of Road
 Traffic Police of the Hellenic Police aiming at utilizing, for the needs of the Survey on
 Road Traffic Accidents, the data which will be collected through the Integrated Information
 System (Integrated information system for the collection and management of data on road
 traffic accidents and imposition of sanctions on road traffic issues) of the Hellenic Police.
 - Development of a web application for the collection of the necessary data of all the judicial authorities of Athens, Piraeus, Thessaloniki and Chalkida. ELSTAT will continue to cooperate with the Ministry of Justice, Transparency and Human Rights aiming at the initiation, in 2016, of the automated collection of the relevant statistical data on justice, in the framework of the project "Integrated System for the Management of Judicial Cases of Civil and Penal Justice".

 Development of a web application for the collection of the necessary correctional justice data of Greece. ELSTAT will continue to cooperate with the Ministry of Justice, Transparency and Human Rights, in the framework of the project "Integrated Information System for Detention Facilities", aiming at the initiation, in 2016, of the automated collection of correctional justice data through the above project.

4. Utilizing administrative data sources for the production of statistics

In an effort to improve the quality of produced statistics, by saving, at the same time, human and financial resources and reducing the burden on respondents (households and enterprises), ELSTAT has already focused, since 2011, on further utilizing the data from the administrative data sources of Greece.

The obligation to grant ELSTAT access to all administrative data sources and to primary data, –including confidential data– is clearly stipulated in the Greek Statistical Law, as in force (Article 2, paragraph 3 and Article 8, paragraph 2), in the Regulation on the Statistical Obligations of the agencies of the Hellenic Statistical System (Article 8, paragraph 4) and in the Commitment on Confidence in Statistics. The issues pertaining to the access of ELSTAT to administrative data sources of other agencies are laid down in memoranda of cooperation signed between the relevant agencies and ELSTAT. ELSTAT follows international standards and best practices for the observance of statistical confidentiality, so as to ensure the safekeeping and protection of confidential data that it receives from administrative sources, in the framework of producing its statistics.

In the above framework, during the 2nd quarter 2014, the Greek tax law was amended so as to expressly allow ELSTAT to have access to tax data. At the same time, in April 2014 an updated memorandum of cooperation was signed by ELSTAT, the General Secretariat for Public Revenue (GSPR), the General Secretariat for Information Systems (GSIS) and the Social Insurance Institute (IKA) –the previous memorandum had been signed in November 2011 between ELSTAT, GSIS and IKA but had not been implemented by the agencies of the Ministry of Finance- which laid down the terms and conditions for the transmission of data to ELSTAT. ELSTAT promptly carried out the preparatory work for the receipt of data, by elaborating (a) an Implementation Plan, as provided for in the Annex of the Memorandum, after having received the comments of the agencies involved, and (b) a Regulation on the use of administrative data for the production of statistics and a Security Policy. At the same time, ELSTAT proceeded, with the assistance of an expert, to the preparation of all the steps for the production of structural business statistics from tax data. Subsequently, ELSTAT submitted a request to the Ministry of Finance (GSIS and GSPR) for getting information on the technical characteristics of the data (size, volume, etc.), in order to create a special data base for the secure receipt, storage and processing of the data. Despite the repeated efforts of ELSTAT since August 2014, the Ministry of Finance did not respond to the above request, calling instead explicitly, into question the right of ELSTAT to have access to tax data under the tax legislation in force, despite the amendment of the tax law in April 2014 aiming specifically at ensuring access to these data.

The above updated memorandum of cooperation and the relevant amendments in tax legislation, if implemented, will constitute significant steps towards the modernization and improvement

of the statistical output in Greece. The full implementation of this memorandum will result in the discontinuation of surveys conducted on enterprises, or in the conduct of smaller-scale surveys. This would enhance on one hand the quality and timeliness of structural business statistics and on the other hand would significantly reduce the burden on enterprises on account of responding to questionnaires. In addition, it is expected that there will be savings in terms of financial resources from reducing the cost for the production of statistical results.

ELSTAT is also planning to develop/continue, in 2016, the cooperation with administrative data sources, aiming at maximizing their utilization for covering the needs of specific statistical surveys/works. Indicatively, among the above activities are the following:

- Cooperation with the Ministry of Labour, Social Security and Social Solidarity for the collection of data from the information system of the Ministry "ERGANI", aiming at covering the needs of the Job Vacancy Survey.
- Cooperation with the Social Insurance Institute (IKA) and the Hellenic Single Payment Authority (EAP) with the aim of collecting data on salaries in the private and public sector for the needs of the Labour Cost Indices.
- Cooperation with the Ministry of Reconstruction of Production, Environment and Energy, in the framework of exploring the possibility to extract environmental data from the Integrated Web Information System of the National Network for Environmental Information.
- Cooperation with the General Secretariat for Infrastructure of the Ministry of Economy, Infrastructure, Shipping and Tourism with the aim of extracting from the database of the Ministry the data that are necessary for ELSTAT in order to:
 - a) create a vehicles register, which will contribute to the compilation of statistics on the fleet of vehicles and of vehicle statistics, as well as to the availability of an updated sampling frame for the conduct of surveys in the road transport sector,
 - b) update the National Roads Register (national/rural network) of Greece. The above cooperation of ELSTAT with the General Secretariat for Infrastructure, aiming at updating the Road Network of Greece, will contribute both to the possibility to compile relevant statistics and to a more complete description of incidents and a sounder signalling of "black spots", i.e., of the high-frequency accident locations of the Survey on Road Accidents.
- Cooperation with the Division of Development, Maintenance and Operation of Applications of the Ministry of Economy, Infrastructure, Shipping and Tourism with the aim of utilizing data from the database of the Vehicles Technical Control Centers for the production, by ELSTAT, of road traffic statistics and the compilation of vehicle-kilometres.
- Cooperation with the Hellenic Gas Transmission System Operator S.A. (DESFA), in the context of the production, by ELSTAT, of statistics on transport via natural gas pipelines.
- Cooperation with the Hellenic Labour Inspectorate of the Ministry of Labour, Social Security and Social Solidarity, in the framework of the production of statistics on accidents at work.
- Cooperation with the Hellenic Telecommunications and Post Commission (EETT) and the Hellenic Civil Aviation Authority in the framework of the compilation, by ELSTAT, of sub-indices of the national Consumer Price Index (CPI) concerning telecommunications and transport, respectively.

5. Reducing the burden of respondents

As already mentioned above, in 2016 ELSTAT will continue to explore the possibilities of utilizing new administrative data sources for the production of its statistics. The continuous utilization of administrative data sources by ELSTAT and the signing of memoranda of cooperation with producers of statistical data will contribute to reducing the burden of respondents.

Besides the aforementioned memorandum of cooperation between ELSTAT, the GSPR, the GSIS and IKA, which is expected to contribute –if implemented– to a significant reduction in the burden of enterprises, Greece is participating in the EU pilot project concerning the implementation of a new system of collecting data for international trade transactions (Single Market Statistics – SIMSTAT), which is expected to be completed in 2016.

SIMSTAT is a package used all over the EU aiming at reducing the reporting burden of the enterprises which arises from their statistical obligations. The program proposes the implementation of a single flow system for intra-EU trade statistics, which aims at the exchange of microdata among Member States. More specifically, it is proposed that only intra-EU export data for all countries are to be collected and such data will be transmitted to/exchanged among the relevant countries, thus abolishing, totally or partially, the collection of intra-EU import data. The implementation of SIMSTAT on a permanent basis, if the specific method is selected, is envisaged for 2018 and is expected to contribute to a significant reduction in the burden of enterprises.

Two key-points of the pilot project are the following:

- a) Exploring new sources for total or partial substitution of data on intra-EU import data.
- b) Pilot testing of the system for microdata exchange, aiming at elaborating a feasibility study for the implementation of the project.

At the same time, in 2014 Eurostat launched the "Re-design of Intrastat" project pertaining to the study of other alternative methods for reducing the burden on enterprises in the framework on intra-EU trade, in which Greece participates.

This project aims at elaborating an operational feasibility study by assessing a wide range of methods, combining quantitative and qualitative criteria for the selection of the best method for compiling intra-EU trade statistics; this method will contribute, on one hand, to the reduction of the burden in enterprises and, on the other hand, to the production of high quality statistical information. The project is expected to be completed in 2016.

Moreover, in the context of its continuous efforts aimed at reducing the burden of respondents, ELSTAT has already initiated the addition in questionnaires of its surveys of a question concerning the time needed by the respondent to complete the questionnaire. The collected answers will be used by ELSTAT for the compilation, in 2016, of reports on the assessment of the burden of respondents.

6. Three-year project for the training of ELSTAT staff

ELSTAT's goal is to continuously update the knowledge and improve the skills of its staff and of the staff of the other ELSS agencies, through which the improvement of the quality of the provided statistical services and statistical output can be accomplished.

In this context, ELSTAT has elaborated a rolling training program for its staff, which encompasses all the training series that were identified as necessary for the training of ELSTAT staff, on the basis of the results of a survey on the training needs of the personnel that had been conducted in ELSTAT. A part of the aforementioned training series is covered by the Training Institute (INEP) of the National Centre for Public Administration and Local Government (EKDDA). The remaining training series, which are more specialized on issues of statistical production, are carried out in ELSTAT's premises by trainers who are experienced in a national statistical institute-working environment. Employees from other ELSS agencies, who are involved in statistical tasks, are also invited to participate, where appropriate, in these training courses. Moreover, in 2015, a first batch of training courses on Business English started being provided to ELSTAT staff. This training is provided in ELSTAT's premises by trainers of the British Council, due to the specialized nature of the course.

In 2016, ELSTAT will continue to implement the training program for its staff, by conducting 11 training series specialized on statistical topics. These training series, for 2016, cover the following topics: statistical survey methodology and sampling techniques, seasonal adjustment, statistical disclosure control methods, quality management in statistical authorities, principles of the European Statistics Code of Practice and UN Fundamental Principles of Official Statistics, demography statistics, environmental statistics, national accounts, compilation of indices, designing of questionnaires, checking and processing of data. Besides the above training series, ELSTAT will continue its cooperation with INEP and the British Council.

E. ENHANCING ACCESSIBILITY OF PRODUCED STATISTICS

1. Upgrading the portal of ELSTAT

During 2016, ELSTAT will continue to improve the various aspects of the layout and content of its portal, as well as enhance the other dissemination modes for its statistics, with a view to fulfilling user needs both at national and international level, by following the developing international standards.

An important factor that will significantly contribute to the accomplishment of this target is the project for upgrading the existing ICT infrastructure and the corresponding services provided by ELSTAT, which will significantly upgrade the portal of ELSTAT by incorporating new tools and technologies. This project is expected to be completed in 2015.

In the context of enhancing accessibility of statistical information, ELSTAT will continue in 2016 to digitize its historical cartographic archive.

2. Fostering statistical education

ELSTAT, taking advantage of the experience gained from the implementation of the project on "Fostering Statistical Education", through the provision of guided tours to groups of pupils and students on its premises, during the period 2014 – 2015, will continue this action in 2016 and develop a specialized statistical webpage addressed to people aged 6-18 years old, in an effort to bring pupils closer to statistical science.

F. CONFERENCES ORGANIZED BY ELSTAT

1. Organization of the 2016 User Conference

ELSTAT, acknowledging the usefulness of the results of the User Conferences in updating and improving its statistical product but also in upgrading the services provided, has established the organization of user conferences on a yearly basis. In this context, a 7th User Conference will be organized in 2016.

2. Organization of one-day conferences for targeting specific categories of users

In 2016 ELSTAT is planning to organize two one-day conferences for targeting specific categories of users.

G. ESTIMATED EXPENDITURE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STATISTICAL WORK PROGRAM

The implementation of the 2016 Statistical Work Program of ELSTAT presupposes the provision of the necessary financial resources from the State Budget and Eurostat, as well as the reinforcement of ELSTAT with the required and appropriate human resources. As stipulated in the Hellenic Statistical Program for 2014-2016 (paragraph 4, Chapter C), the implementation of the above program presupposes the reinforcement of ELSTAT with the required and appropriate human resources. ELSTAT has calculated the minimum human resources for fulfilling its obligations as the National Statistical Authority and which amount to approximately 930 employees. The Commitment on Confidence in Statistics expressly lays down commitments for the Greek Government and the Greek State to reinforce ELSTAT with the necessary human resources, in order for ELSTAT to provide users with high quality statistics, in accordance with all its obligations at national and European level.

In the framework of the Medium-Term Fiscal Adjustment Program of Greece for 2016-2019, ELSTAT has estimated the minimum human resources that are required for fulfilling its obligations for the above period. The needs for hiring personnel in 2016 were estimated at 35 new employees, under the condition that: (a) any losses in personnel will be limited only to the obligatory redundancies and (b) within 2015 the hiring of 169 new employees, as requested by ELSTAT, will be completed. If, in 2015, there is a delay in the planned hiring of 169 employees or there are more losses, than expected, in the personnel, then the number of employees to be hired in 2016 should increase, accordingly.

ELSTAT has undertaken a budgeting exercise for the expenditures that are required for the implementation of its statistical works for 2016, in the framework of the Medium-Term Fiscal Adjustment Program of Greece for 2016 – 2019.

The budgeted expenses for 2016 are estimated at a total of forty-one million two hundred five thousand six hundred forty-five euro (\leq 41,205,645). The aforementioned expenses are classified in the following categories:

- a) Labour cost (wages and salaries of ELSTAT permanent staff, including basic salary, allowances, social security contributions, additional and incidental benefits for the permanent staff, etc.).
- b) Expenses related to the staff's travel within Greece and abroad: travel and subsistence expenses for the permanent staff of ELSTAT travelling for the purpose of conducting statistical surveys in the field or participating in meetings, seminars, etc. abroad, as well as expenses related to the redeployment or detachment of ELSTAT employees to other agencies in Greece or abroad.
- c) Other operating expenses, including expenses related to ELSTAT's buildings (Central and Regional Offices) such as rents, heating, communication, water supply, security, cleaning and maintenance costs, as well as expenses related to advertising and public relations, subscriptions, expenses for the provision of consumables (paper, stationery, medical and pharmaceutical supplies including materials for the maintenance and repair of premises and equipment), fuel, etc., as well as expenses for the conduct of statistical surveys, including the remuneration of external survey workers participating in data collection, and expenses for the provision of capital formation goods, such as furniture, PCs, printers, photocopiers and other office equipment.
- d) Projects financed by Eurostat, including expenses in the context of the conduct of statistical works financed by Eurostat.
- e) Investments made in the framework of the Public Investment Program.

The following table presents the Budget estimate of ELSTAT (in euro) for 2016, as submitted by ELSTAT in the framework of the Medium-Term Fiscal Adjustment Program of Greece for 2016-2019, in comparison with the estimated expenses for 2015:

The above estimated needs in human and financial resources are the minimum ones for the conduct of the statistical activities included in the 2015 Statistical Work Program. Non-availability of the necessary resources will jeopardize the implementation of the Statistical Work Program.
