




SURVEY ON MUSEUMS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES ATTENDANCE APRIL 2024

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces the results of the *Survey on Museums and Archaeological Sites Attendance* for April 2024. More specifically:

- During April 2024 compared with the corresponding month of 2023, museums recorded a 42.3% increase in the number of visitors, of 50.6% in the number of free admission visitors and of 34.7% in their receipts (Table 1).
- As regards archaeological sites, in April 2024 compared with the corresponding month of 2023, an increase of 25.7% was recorded in the number of visitors, of 36.8% in the number of free admission visitors and of 19.5% in the corresponding receipts (Table 1).
- During the four-month period from January to April 2024, compared to the corresponding period of 2023, an increase of 24.9% was recorded in the number of visitors of museums, of 13.9% in the number of free admission visitors and of 27.2% in the relevant receipts (Table 2).
- As regards archaeological sites, during the four- month period from January to April 2024, compared to the corresponding period of 2023, an increase of 31.6% was recorded in the number of visitors, of 34.7% in the number of free admission visitors and of 29.1% in the relevant receipts (Table 2).





Graph 4: Percentage distribution of visitors by Archaeological site, April 2024



EXPLANATORY NOTES

Survey on Museums and Archaeological Sites Attendance The Survey on Museums and Archaeological Sites Attendance has been producing results since 1970. The survey collects data from the Hellenic Organization of Cultural Resources Development (HOCRED), supervised by the Ministry of Culture and Sports, on the number of visitors and the receipts from the tickets sold in the Museums and Archaeological sites of the country. The corresponding data for the Acropolis Museum is available from December 2009 onwards.

Legal Framework

The survey is conducted since 1970 on a regular basis and it produces results on a monthly and yearly basis, in compliance with the Joint Ministerial Decision 15189/B379/73.

Reference Period

1/4/2024 - 30/4/2024

Methodology and Definitions The survey is conducted on a monthly basis from data mainly collected from the Hellenic Organization of Cultural Resources Development (HOCRED), supervised by the Ministry of Culture and Sports, on the number of visitors and the receipts from the tickets sold in the Museums and Archaeological sites of the Country. ELSTAT tabulates and presents the data for the whole of the Country, by month and by year.

Number of flat rate tickets:

From April 1999 onwards, in some museums and the nearby archaeological sites, in addition to the ordinary ticket, a new "flat rate ticket" was established, which is valid for both the museum and the nearby archaeological site. The total number of these flat rate tickets for **April 2024** was **112,977**
