

ELSTAT Annual Statistical Work Program 2013

A. INTRODUCTION

The 2013 statistical work program of the Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) includes information on the statistics to be compiled and disseminated during 2013 (see Annex), as well as on the planned changes in the compiled statistics. These changes pertain to the production of new statistics on account of, for example, the implementation of new European Regulations, to the amendment of currently produced statistics in order to fully comply with existing EU Regulations and to the need to respond more effectively to the needs of national and international users. In addition, the 2013 statistical work program includes information on the planned actions of ELSTAT that aim at enhancing the quality of its statistical data, as well as the access of users to statistics.

The 2013 statistical work program of ELSTAT has been compiled on the basis of the Hellenic Statistical Program (ELSP) for the three-year period 2011 – 2013.

In 2013, ELSTAT will continue to implement actions aiming at improving the quality and reliability of its statistics by unswervingly observing the national and European statistical legal framework in force⁽¹⁾ and by coordinating the statistical activities of the other agencies of the Hellenic Statistical System (ELSS).

One of the main objectives of ELSTAT for 2013 is also the undertaking of a more active role in the European Statistical System (ESS), through closer cooperation with the other members of the ESS in the framework of workshops (Task Forces/Working Groups and Sector/Directors' Groups) organized by Eurostat on various statistical topics, and through active participation in, and material contribution to, European initiatives and coordination centers for statistical matters (e.g., the Partnership Group of the European Statistical System). In the light of the Greek Presidency of the Council of the European Union in the 1st semester of 2014, ELSTAT is envisaged to participate in meetings to be held in 2013 for the coordination and preparation of the statistical issues, which the Council will address during the Greek Presidency (1st semester of 2014).

B. NEW STATISTICS

1. Implementing EU Regulations and fulfilling European and international obligations

The production of new statistics for 2013 planned by ELSTAT is driven, to a large extent, by the need to fulfil ELSTAT's obligations towards the Statistical Office of the European Union (Eurostat) and other European and international organizations. These obligations involve, inter alia, implementing new European Regulations, ensuring compliance with existing Regulations, filling in questionnaires, updating databases, etc. The new statistics that are planned to be produced in 2013 for such purposes are presented below by theme:

• EMPLOYMENT, WAGES AND LABOUR COST

- Short-term indices on employment, working hours and earnings for the branches of retail trade, repairs and services (Regulation 1158/2005, as amended by Regulation 329/2009).

• JUSTICE

- Statistics on the security of citizens/victimization, with reference year 2013 (Regulation to be voted on).

• INCOME AND LIVING CONDITIONS

- Statistics on living conditions of households, in the framework of new ad hoc modules in the EU-SILC survey for 2012. It concerns statistics on the financial resources and the housing conditions of households, as well as on life expectancy (Regulation 1157/2010).

EDUCATION

- Economic data for all education levels (Regulation 452/2008).
- Statistics for post-secondary non-tertiary education (level 4 of the international classification ISCED) (Regulation 452/2008).

INFORMATION SOCIETY

- Statistics on ubiquitous internet access via laptops, mobile phones and other portable devices, in the framework of the addition of an ad hoc module to the ICT survey for 2012 (Regulation 937/2011 implementing Regulation 808/2004).

TRANSPORT

- Statistics on the road network of Greece, on the basis of a feasibility study concerning the exploration of data sources and the availability of relevant data. In the framework of the necessity to update the relevant European database, ELSTAT will compile statistics on the road network of Greece, on the basis of the results of the aforementioned study. These statistics are expected to be available at the end of 2013 or in the beginning of 2014.
- Statistics on road passenger transports by buses and coaches and on transports via pipelines of natural gas, on the basis of a feasibility study and a pilot survey to be conducted in 2013. These statistics are compiled by ELSTAT in the framework of the necessity to update the relevant European database.
- Passenger mobility statistics, on the basis of a feasibility study and a pilot survey.
- Road traffic statistics for the compilation of vehicle-kilometers (VKM), on the basis of a feasibility study that will explore the possibility of collecting relevant data.

POPULATION

Population statistics, on the basis of the results of the 2011 Population – Housing Census.
 Gradual release of the relevant results. Detailed data on the demographic, financial and

social characteristics of the population will be available in 2013, after the completion of the processing of the individual questionnaires, which includes codification and the full spectrum of quality checks (Regulations 763/2008, 1201/2009, 519/2010 and 1151/2010).

• HEALTH

- Expenditures and receipts of the agencies providing health care services (Regulation 1338/2008 and its implementing Regulations to be voted on). Release for the first time of data on total health expenditure for the years 2009 and 2010. These data will be the result of the implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding signed between ELSTAT, the Ministry of Health and Social Solidarity and the University of Athens pertaining to the development of a System of Health Accounts (SHA) at national level (see below).

2. Satisfying users' needs

Taking into account the requests made by users during the 1st and 2nd Users Conferences—held in 2010 and 2011, respectively—ELSTAT included certain statistical activities in its Annual Work Programs for the following years, including 2013. Such statistical activities include the conduct of a Time Use Survey and the development of a System of Health Accounts (SHA) at national level.

The Time Use Survey is conducted in cooperation with the General Secretariat for Gender Equality, in the framework of the Program "Public Administration Reform" of the National Strategic Reference Framework for 2007 – 2013. The survey is funded by the European Social Fund (ESF). The preparatory works started in September 2011. According to the timetable of survey works, data collection will be completed in September 2013. Data entry is planned to begin in June 2013 and the results of the survey are expected to be available to the public in December 2014.

In September 2011, actions envisaged in the Memorandum of Understanding signed in 2010 between ELSTAT, the Ministry of Health and Social Solidarity and the University of Athens, aiming at the materialization of a System of Health Accounts (SHA) at national level, started being implemented. The first two deliverables of the project were delivered in 2011 according to the aforementioned memorandum. The remaining deliverables are expected to be made available by the end of 2012. On the basis of these deliverables, the dissemination of the data on health expenditure for the years 2009 and 2010 is planned for 2013.

In order to satisfy users' needs (including those who formulate public policy), ELSTAT also intends to promote in 2013 the compilation of additional statistics in the areas of tourism, environment, health, energy consumption, by households, and the use of renewable energy sources.

In the context of restructuring tourism statistics, a Working Group, comprising representatives of ELSTAT, the Ministry of Tourism and the Bank of Greece, will be set up in 2012, in order to explore users' current needs and to propose new statistical surveys/works, where appropriate. The Working Group, which will begin its work in the 2nd semester of 2012 and will continue in 2013, will also explore the possibility of using administrative or other data sources to reduce

the burden and cost of statistical surveys. The possibility of redesigning the survey on arrivals by charter flights, as well as the survey on yachts, will also be investigated. Under appropriate conditions, the aforementioned surveys can be carried out in the 2nd semester of 2013. Furthermore, a special survey on rooms for rent is being planned, with a view to conducting it in the 2nd semester of 2012. The 2012 survey could be considered a pilot survey, since it will be conducted for the first time. From 2013 onwards, the survey is planned to be conducted on a regular basis.

Aiming at upgrading environmental statistics and accounts in order to satisfy users' needs and to fully comply with relevant EU Regulations, ELSTAT will undertake to enhance the cooperation with the Ministry of Environment, Energy and Climate Change and with the Ministry of Finance. At the same time, a Working Group will be set up to explore and coordinate the development of additional environmental statistics and accounts, as well as to enhance their quality. In this context, the development of a new project is envisaged, which will be funded by the European Social Fund (ESF).

On the basis of the Health Survey results, statistics on physical activity and nutrition will be published in 2013.

In 2013, ELSTAT intends to publish the results of the Survey on Household Energy Consumption, which concern final household energy consumption and the penetration rate of energy efficient technologies and renewable energy sources in households.

On the basis of the comments made at the 2nd Users Conference and taking into consideration the constraints on its budget, ELSTAT planned the following actions in 2012:

- i) Explore the possibility of increasing the size of the samples used for the conduct of sample surveys, aiming at the production of reliable results at levels below Country level.
- ii) Consider the issue of the spatial dimension of statistical data and the corresponding presentation of its data (including electronic maps and atlases).
- iii) Explore the possibility of compiling longer time series by applying a harmonized methodology, taking into consideration the priorities set in the works of National Accounts and the availability of primary data.
- iv) Consider the issue of developing a navigation mechanism for its website, in the context of the ongoing works for upgrading the website.

On the basis of the results of actions (i) and (ii) above, ELSTAT will take the appropriate steps in 2013. ELSTAT is also planning to proceed, in 2013, with the compilation, where applicable, of consistent time series for national accounts data for the period starting in 1995 or 2000, in the framework of transmission of the new European System of Accounts (ESA 2010) data. The development of a navigation mechanism for the website of ELSTAT is among the actions included in the project aiming at upgrading the existing infrastructure and the services provided by ELSTAT in the ICT sector (see Box 2 below).

C. OTHER CHANGES IN THE COMPILATION AND DISSEMINATION OF STATISTICS

Compliance with EU Regulations and adaptation to user needs, in combination with constraints in terms of available human and financial resources, necessitate changes: improvements, revisions and discontinuations in the production and dissemination of statistics. The following changes are planned for 2013:

• LABOUR MARKET

- Changes in the data collection of the Labour Force Survey.

Aiming at accelerating the data collection of the survey, survey workers will collect the data by using portable personal computers when visiting households for the first interview. Furthermore, the organization of the ELSTAT call center will be completed, thus enabling the conduct of follow-up interviews via telephone.

INDUSTRY

- Revision of the Industrial Production Index and of the Turnover Index in Industry, with 2010 as new base year, and simultaneous adjustment of the previous time series of these indices to the new base year, in the framework of the requirements of Regulation (EC) 1165/1998.

NATIONAL ACCOUNTS

- Implementation of the new European System of Accounts, ESA 2010.

In 2013, ELSTAT will continue its preparations for the implementation of the new European System of Accounts (ESA 2010), which has to be completed with the submission of the new data in September 2014. In the context of the transmission of the ESA 2010 data, inter alia, the following statistical works are planned, with important phases of these works envisaged to be completed in 2013:

- calculation of fixed capital and gross fixed capital formation, by branch of economic activity and by capital good;
- compilation of balance sheets for non-financial assets;
- reduction of the time needed for the production of the results of quarterly and regional national accounts;
- compilation of consistent time series of national accounts from 1995 or 2000 to the present, where applicable.

• TRADE

- Revision of the Turnover Index in Retail Trade, the Index of the Number of Persons Employed in Retail Trade, the Turnover Index in Motor Trade and the Turnover Index in Wholesale Trade, with 2010 as new base year.

PRICES

- Revision of the Producer Price Index in Industry, the Import Price Index in Industry, the Agricultural Price Indices, the Construction Cost Indices for new Residential Buildings and the Services Producer Price Indices, with 2010 as new base year. The revision of the aforementioned price indices is provided for in Regulations 1165/1998 and 1158/2005, with the exception of the revision of the Agricultural Price Indices, which arises from a gentlemen's agreement among EU Member States.
- Revision of the Owner Occupied Housing Index, on the basis of a study concerning its compilation methodology. Specifically, in 2013, ELSTAT intends to start again the conduct of the survey for the compilation of the Owner Occupied Housing Index, on the basis of a study concerning its compilation methodology. This study will be assigned to experts in 2012 and is expected to be completed by the end of that year. The production of the index data is slated for the 2nd semester of 2013.

SERVICES

- Revision of the Turnover Indices in the Services Sector, with 2010 as new base year, in compliance with Regulation (EC) 1165/1998.

D. RESULTS OF THE BUILDINGS AND POPULATION – HOUSING CENSUSES

Besides data on the country's de jure (registered) population at the level of Municipal Unit (dē-motikē enotēta) and data on the country's resident population at the level of settlement (oekismos), ELSTAT is also aiming at publishing in 2012, at settlement level, certain demographic characteristics of the resident population, namely age, sex and nationality.

In 2013, ELSTAT will continue the processing of the remaining variables of the 2011 Population – Housing Census questionnaires, in order to disseminate data on the remaining demographic characteristics of the country's resident population that were recorded during the Census. Such characteristics include the marital status, the place of birth, translocations vis-à-vis the former place of residence, the employment status, the profession, the branch of economic activity and other economic characteristics, the education level, etc. All these characteristics will be disseminated at settlement level. In addition, the fertility tables will also be made available in 2013.

Regulation 519/2010 establishes the set of statistical data and metadata to be transmitted to Eurostat, using the new transmission system of "hypercubes" (multidimensional cross tabulation of breakdowns). ELSTAT will prepare these 64 hypercubes in 2013. The database with the 64 hypercubes will be transmitted to Eurostat at the latest by 2014.

E. IMPROVING THE QUALITY OF PRODUCED STATISTICS

ELSTAT will continue to put special emphasis on enhancing the reliability, timeliness and, more generally, the quality of produced statistics, on the basis of the principles of the European Sta-

tistics Code of Practice. In this framework, in 2013, ELSTAT will continue to implement the multidimensional Joint Overall Statistical Greek Action Plan (JOSGAP), which was agreed with Eurostat, with the aim of harmonizing the Hellenic Statistical System with the European one.

1. Joint Overall Statistical Greek Action Plan

The Joint Overall Statistical Greek Action Plan (JOSGAP) encompasses actions allocated into three pillars—A, B and C—with each action having its own deadline for completion. Since 2010, when the JOSGAP started being implemented, a significant number of these actions have either been completed or are at the stage of finalization.

As regards actions within pillar A, which aim at enhancing the institutional framework of the ELSS, the first round of certification of statistics produced by the other ELSS agencies—which is slated to start in 2012—will be completed in 2013 (see Box 1).

Box 1. Certification of statistics produced by ELSS agencies

In compliance with the statistical law in force, ELSTAT certifies as "official statistics" the statistics produced by the other ELSS agencies. The certification procedure is described in the Regulation on the Operation and Administration of ELSTAT, which is to be adopted in 2012. ELSTAT evaluates the statistics in order to certify them as "official statistics" on the basis of the annual reports and the quality reports of the ELSS agencies. These reports are elaborated according to guidelines stipulated in the Regulation on Statistical Obligations of the ELSS agencies, as well as on the basis of ELSTAT's observations on quality, coherence, timeliness and punctuality of produced statistics.

ELSTAT cooperates with the other ELSS agencies on all matters concerning the certification process. It invites the agencies involved to introductory meetings and maintains contact with them throughout the certification process, seeking explanations and clarifications and offering guidance and assistance. The certification process is concluded by a Certification Report compiled by the ELSTAT certification team. The draft Report is presented to and discussed with the agency concerned before the decision of ELSTAT for certification. The final Report is posted on the ELSTAT website. The Council of the ELSS is informed about the progress of the certification of official statistics and the certification reports.

In 2013, ELSTAT will continue its efforts for the completion of the actions of pillar B of JOSGAP, which aim at improving the processes and capacity for the production of statistics in Greece through a program of short and medium term technical assistance from Eurostat to ELSTAT. Among these actions are included three projects, which were developed with the assistance of experts in late 2011 and early 2012 (see Box 2). They comprise the project for enhancing the completeness and timeliness of the statistical business register, which is to be completed in September 2013; the three-year project (2012 – 2014) for the training of ELSTAT staff; and the project for upgrading the existing ICT infrastructure and the corresponding services provided, which is expected to be completed in April 2015.

Box 2. Implementation of projects in the framework of the Joint Overall Statistical Greek Action Plan

Project for enhancing completeness and timeliness of the statistical business register

The project plan was compiled in December 2011 and the application for funding from the European Social Fund was submitted in 2012.

The statistical business register, besides being a major information source for the users of business statistics, is also the sampling framework, on the basis of which ELSTAT selects the samples for the conduct of sample surveys in enterprises. The aim of this project is to improve the data quality of the register, including its timeliness. The expected results from the implementation of the project are the following:

- · Wider coverage of the register
- · Improved classification and recording of the number and characteristics of the enterprises
- Reduction in the time needed for checking the raw data that are transmitted from the administrative sources for the register's update, by developing and applying automated checks
- Improvement of the data quality of the register, by incorporating data deriving from the Structural Business Surveys (SBS)
- · Availability of a better sampling framework
- · Compilation of business historical data
- Improvement of the current technological infrastructure of the register, by developing mechanisms enabling users to produce tailor-made tables from the database of the register.

Three-year project for the training of ELSTAT staff

The project plan was compiled in the beginning of 2012 and the application for funding will be submitted as soon as the relevant call for proposals is issued.

The enhancement of the quality of statistics of Greece and the harmonization of the Hellenic Statistical System with the European Statistical System, presuppose the updating of knowledge and the improvement of skills of ELSTAT employees (in accordance with current best practices, technologies and the institutional and professional ethics framework in force for the production of statistics) in order for them to better perform their duties. This is precisely the goal of the project for the training of ELSTAT staff for the period 2012 – 2014. The project also encompasses the development of methods and tools aiming at the continuation of the management of the training of staff after the completion of the project (developing methods and tools for identifying training needs, managing, monitoring and assessing the training programs, etc.).

Project for upgrading the existing ICT infrastructure and the corresponding services provided by ELSTAT

In 2012, the project proposal on upgrading the existing ICT infrastructure and the corresponding services provided by ELSTAT was completed and the relevant application for funding from the European Social Fund (ESF) was submitted. The project consists of eight complementary sub-projects:

- 1) Redesign and upgrade of the Integrated Information System
- 2) Upgrade of the portal services for the dissemination of statistics
- 3) Evaluation and implementation of security policies
- 4) Contingency planning
- 5) IT service management
- 6) Central management of e-mails
- 7) Central printing system
- 8) Human Resources Management System

The majority of the above mentioned sub-projects (1, 3, 5, 7 and 8) are expected to start being implemented in the 2nd semester of 2012. The remaining sub-projects will start in 2013. Sub-projects 3,4,5,6 and 8 are expected to be completed within 2013. Efforts will be made to complete sub-project 7 within 2012, while sub-project 1 will be completed in 2014 and the completion of sub-project 2 is envisaged for April 2015.

At the same time, in 2013 significant progress is expected to be made in other projects concerning the improvement of statistics on several areas. These projects are to be elaborated and to start being implemented in the 2nd semester of 2012 and in 2013 after the submission of the application for funding from the European Social Fund. ELSTAT will be in the process of exploring the possibility of elaborating additional projects, such as for improving Structural Business Statistics (SBS), by using administrative data sources (see Box 3); for enhancing the availability and quality of environmental statistics; and for improving the quality and timeliness of the agricultural register.

Box 3. Improving Structural Business Statistics by using administrative data sources

In 2012, ELSTAT, recognizing the growing burden on enterprises from filling in survey questionnaires, started to explore the possibility of creating a Single Entry Point in cooperation with other competent agencies. Enterprises would submit electronically, once, all the necessary data required in the framework of their obligations towards several agencies (ELSTAT, government ministries, social security funds, associations, etc.). ELSTAT has already informed the aforementioned agencies on its proposal concerning the creation of a Single Entry Point and will take the necessary steps, on the basis of the interest expressed by the above stakeholders. In case this project cannot materialize, ELSTAT intends to start collecting a large part of the data on enterprises from administrative sources and, in particular, from the General Secretariat for Information Systems (Ministry of Finance) and from IKA (Social Insurance Institute), with which ELSTAT has already signed a Memorandum of Cooperation.

Finally, the remaining actions⁽²⁾ in pillar C of JOSGAP, which focus on improving the quality of the Government Finance Statistics of Greece, are expected to be completed in 2013. All the actions in pillar C, which are under the competency of ELSTAT will be completed in 2012.

2. Hellenic Statistical Program

According to the Statistical Law 3832/2010, as amended by article 323 of Law 4072/2012, by the end of March 2013 ELSTAT has to approve the Hellenic Statistical Program (ELSP) for the period 2014 – 2016, after having obtained the opinion of the Council of the Hellenic Statistical System (SYELSS). The ELSP will set out the major fields and objectives of the actions scheduled by ELSS agencies for that three-year period and will form the basis for the compilation of the annual statistical work programs of the agencies for the years 2014, 2015 and 2016.

In order to compile the ELSP, ELSTAT will start in late 2012 collecting information from the other ELSS agencies, as regards their goals and priorities for the three-year period 2014 – 2016. The collected information will constitute a special Chapter of the ELSP.

3. Using technology to upgrade data collection

In 2013, ELSAT will proceed to the digitization of the census – administrative boundaries of Local Government Organizations, as these were derived from the 2011 Population – Housing Census. ELSTAT will also update the digitized register of Greece's settlements (oekismoi), using the census blocks and the road network, as these were derived from the aforementioned Census.

Aiming at accelerating the production of statistics, ELSTAT intends to explore and proceed, accordingly with a number of actions in 2013, which are described below:

- a) electronic collection of data from administrative sources for the annual survey on accidents at work, which is conducted in the framework of European Statistics on Accidents at Work, depending on the results of a relevant exploration by ELSTAT to be conducted in 2012;
- b) expanding the electronic data collection for the annual survey on in-patient hospital care to all hospitals in Greece;
- c) redesigning the Household Budget Survey questionnaires, thus making them processable by Optical Character Readers (OCR), with the aim of drastically reducing the time needed for data entry into the electronic database and thus the number of necessary person-days, as well as minimizing errors during data entry;
- d) expanding the on-line application used for the collection of data for the compilation of the following: Turnover Index in Industry, New Orders Index in Industry, Industrial Production Index, Turnover Index and Index of Persons Employed in the Sector of Trade and the Sector of Other Services, Production Index and Index of Persons Employed in the Construction Sector;
- e) developing a web application for the data collection of the Survey on the Production and Management of Waste;
- f) redesigning the questionnaires of the PRODCOM Survey, thus making them processable by Optical Character Readers (OCR).

4. Reducing the burden of administrative data collection

Aiming at reducing the burden of administrative data collection, ELSTAT, as already noted above (Box 3), has started to explore the possibility of creating a Single Entry Point where enterprises would submit electronically, once, all the necessary data required in the framework of their obligations towards various agencies. At the same time, in 2012, a working group will be set up within ELSTAT, consisting of employees from all the competent Divisions, which will address the issue of questions that are repeated across business survey questionnaires, aiming at avoiding repetitions and thus streamlining or even abolishing questionnaires.

F. IMPROVING ACCESSIBILITY OF PRODUCED STATISTICS

1. Upgrading the portal of ELSTAT

The works for redesigning ELSTAT's portal and enriching its content are included in the first two sub-projects that are part of the project for upgrading the existing ICT infrastructure of ELSTAT and the corresponding services provided (see Box 2). The goals of theses sub-projects are:

- upgrading the Integrated Information System of ELSTAT, with emphasis on the sub-systems supporting the statistical processes, thus enabling them to cover users' growing needs and requirements for timely and reliable statistical information and provision of improved services.
- redesigning and upgrading specific parts of the portal to ensure compatibility with the new Integrated Information System, as well as enriching the features of the portal (improved interface with the Integrated Information System, new presentation tools, ensuring inter-operability via web services and re-use of data, support of multiple file formats, etc.)

The sub-project for upgrading the Integrated Information System of ELSTAT is planned to start in July 2012 and to be completed in September 2013. The sub-project for upgrading the portal services for the dissemination of statistical data is envisaged to start in September 2013 and to be completed in April 2015.

ELSTAT, responding to users' requests, intends to start in 2012, and continue in 2013, to enrich its website with hyperlinks to data sources, which can be followed by researchers in order to find the data they need.

2. Dissemination of the 2011 Population – Housing Census results

ELSTAT has already made considerable progress in exploring the possibilities of developing web applications for the dissemination of Census results in 2013, with the aim of better and faster serving users.

3. Fostering statistical education

Aiming at promoting statistical education in Greece, ELSTAT has planned for 2012 to host and provide guided tours to groups of pupils and students in the Library and in other Sections of ELSTAT. This will continue in 2013.

Moreover, the project for upgrading the existing ICT infrastructure and the corresponding services provided also includes the creation of a specialized webpage which will be addressed to children aged 6 – 18 years. This webpage will offer animations, quizzes and games pertaining to statistics, in an effort to get children interested in statistical science. The competent Divisions of ELSTAT (i.e., Informatics Division and Division of Statistical Information and Publications) have already begun cooperating for this action. Furthermore, in 2012, ELSTAT will cooperate with the Ministry of Education, Lifelong Learning and Religious Affairs on the content of the

webpage and on the most appropriate way—in terms of educational impact—to present it. The works for the creation of the webpage will be completed in 2013. A special workshop aiming at informing teachers regarding the aforementioned webpage is going to be organized by the Division of Statistical Information and Publications of ELSTAT.

G. CONFERENCES ORGANIZED BY ELSTAT

1. Organization of the 2013 Users Conference

Given the usefulness of the Users Conferences in improving ELSTAT's statistical products and services, ELSTAT has established the organization of these conferences as an institution. In this context, a 4th Users Conference will be organized in 2013.

2. Organization of a European Conference

To achieve the goal of upgrading its role within the European Statistical System, ELSTAT intends to organize in 2013 a European Conference on current statistical matters, with the participation of European statisticians.

H. ESTIMATED EXPENDITURE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STATISTICAL WORK PROGRAM

The total cost for the implementation of the aforementioned statistical program is estimated by ELSTAT at forty-three million eighty-five thousand seven hundred and fifty-two euros (43,085,752). The estimated expenses are classified in the following categories:

- a) Labour cost (wages and salaries of ELSTAT permanent staff, including basic salary, allowances, social security contributions, additional and incidental benefits for the permanent staff, private insurance of the staff, etc.).
- b) Expenses related to the staff's travel within Greece and abroad: travel and subsistence expenses for the permanent staff of ELSTAT traveling for the purpose of conducting statistical surveys in the field or participating in meetings, seminars, etc. abroad, as well as expenses related to the transfer or detachment of ELSTAT employees to other agencies in Greece or abroad.
- c) Other operating expenses, including expenses related to ELSTAT's buildings (Central and Regional Offices) such as rents, heating, communication, water supply, security, cleaning and maintenance costs, as well as expenses related to advertising and public relations, temporary staff remuneration, etc.
- d) Expenses for the provision of goods, capital formation and subscriptions, including expenses for the provision of consumables (materials for the maintenance and repair of premises and equipment, paper, stationery, medical and pharmaceutical supplies), fuel, furniture, PCs, printers, photocopiers and other office equipment.

- e) Expenses for the processing of data of the Buildings and Population Housing Censuses.
- f) Projects financed by Eurostat, including expenses in the context of the conduct of statistical works financed by Eurostat.

The allocation of ELSTAT's expenses estimated for 2013 (in euro), as well as the corresponding budgeted expenses for 2010, 2011 and 2012, by type of expenditure, are presented in the following table:

It should be noted that the estimated labor cost for 2013 includes gross wages and salaries for approximately 100 new employees, that ELSTAT is expected to recruit in 2012 – 2013. These employees are going to offset the net loss in human resources (140 employees) that ELSTAT suffered in 2010 – 2011, which came about due to the retirement of employees and the constraints in recruiting new personnel. The substantial increase in the estimated expenses for the provision of goods and for capital formation in 2013 is due to the purchase of equipment for the implementation of the projects that ELSTAT has undertaken.

The above estimated needs in human and financial resources are the minimum ones for the conduct of the statistical activities included in the 2013 statistical program and they were calculated by taking into consideration the constraints of the fiscal adjustment program of Greece. Non-availability of the necessary resources may jeopardize the implementation of the statistical work program.
