SURVEY ON SPECIAL EDUCATION SCHOOLS END OF SCHOOL YEAR 2022/2023

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces statistics on Special Education Schools, end of school year 2022/2023. The survey includes formal education school units under the competency of the Ministry of Education, Religious Affairs and Sports. The survey covers the school units of Pre-Primary and Primary Education (Special Kindergartens and Special Primary schools) and Secondary Education (Special Lower and Upper Secondary Education schools, Special Vocational Lower and Upper Secondary Education schools, The survey also covers the Special Kindergartens of the Hellenic Society for the Protection and Rehabilitation of the Disabled Children (ELEPAP).

According to the survey data, the following are observed:

- a) The number of school units of Pre-Primary and Primary Education in the school year 2022/2023 compared with 2021/2022 increased from 302 to 304 (0.6%) while the number of school units of Secondary Education remained unchanged at 220 units (Table 1).
- b) **Teaching staff** in the school year 2022/2023 compared with 2021/2022 decreased by 2.5% in Pre-Primary and Primary Education and increased by 9.5% in Secondary Education (Table 2).
- c) The number of **pupils enrolled** in the school year 2022/2023 compared with 2021/2022 increased by 6.6% in Pre-Primary and Primary Education and by 0.5% in Secondary Education. Out of the total number of pupils enrolled, male pupils accounted for 67.8% and females for 32.2% (Tables 2 and 3).
- d) The most prevalent **special education need** among pupils enrolled in was autism, accounting for 38.1%, followed by intellectual disability with 30.7% (Table 3).
- e) The **ratio of teaching staff to pupils** was 1 teacher per 2.37 pupils in the school year 2022/2023 compared with 1 teacher per 2.39 pupils in 2021/2022 (Table 2).
- f) The **Region of Attiki** accounted for 34.1% of the total number of pupils enrolled in the Special Education School Units of Greece, followed by the **Region of Kentriki Makedonia** with 16.1% (Table 2).




Chart 1. Number of School Units by Type, school year 2022/2023



Statistical The statistical units are the school units of Special Education.


