FOLLOW UP OF DATA ON PHARMACIES, PHARMACISTS AND WHOLESALE DRUGSTORES, 2017

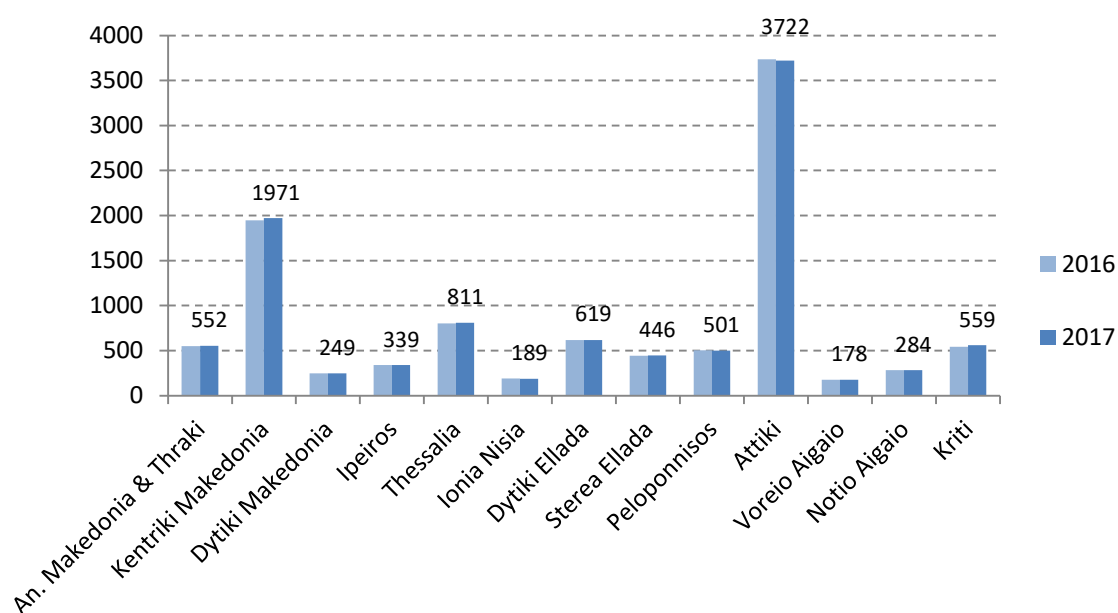
The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces the data of the Survey on Pharmacies, Pharmacists and Wholesale Drugstores for the year 2017.

During 2017 10,420 pharmacies operated in Greece, and out of this number, 3,722 pharmacies (35.7%) were located in the Region of Attiki. In comparison with 2016, the total number of pharmacies in Greece recorded, presented an increase of 0.3% (34 pharmacies). The biggest increase in absolute values was recorded in Kentriki Makedonia (1.2%) and in Kriti (2.8%), while the biggest decrease in absolute values was observed in Attiki (0.4%) (Table 1, Graph 1).

Based on the number of pharmacies per Region the ratio of pharmacies per 10,000 inhabitants was calculated, thus for 2017, 9.7 pharmacies corresponded to 10,000 inhabitants. In addition, the Region with the biggest density of pharmacies in relation to its population was Thessalia (11.2), followed by Kentriki Makedonia (10.5), while the lowest density was recorded in Sterea Ellada (8.0) (Table 2).

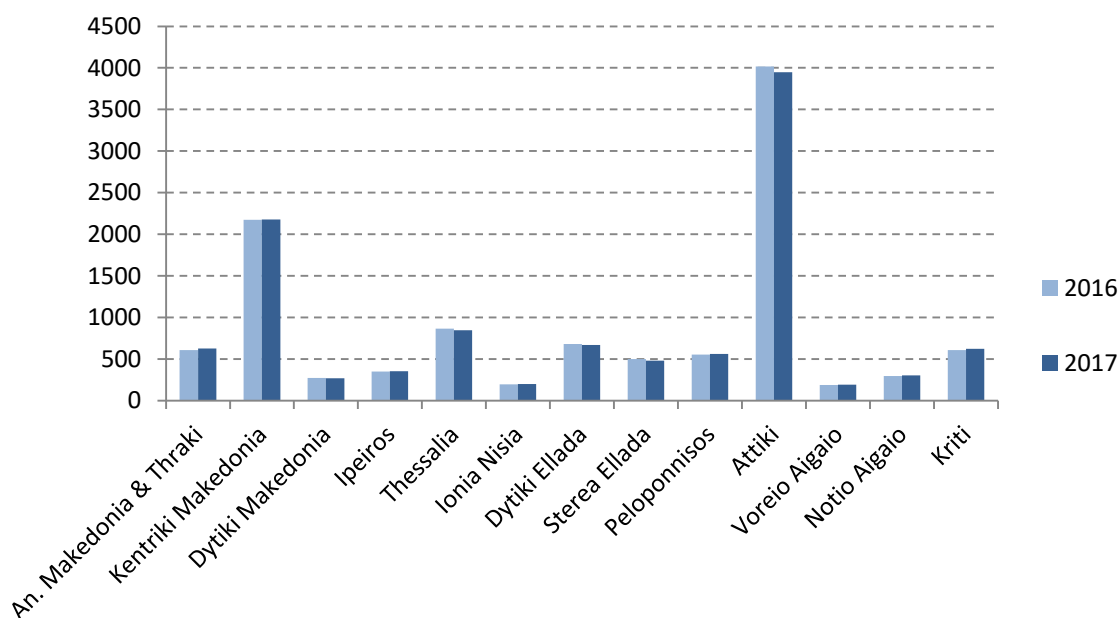

ELSTAT collected data on the number of pharmacists (employed in pharmacies) for the year 2017 from the Panhellenic Association of Pharmacists, according to which, 11,251 pharmacists were employed in pharmacies all over Greece for the aforementioned year (Table 3, Graph 2).

Finally, as far as the number of wholesale drugstores is concerned, this reached 128 for 2017 recording an increase of 6.7% when compared with 2016 (120). There are no available data disaggregated by Region.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Survey on pharmacies, pharmacists and wholesale drugstores:

The survey on pharmacies, pharmacists and wholesale drugstores is conducted yearly and results are presented on a national and regional level covering the country's needs on statistical information.

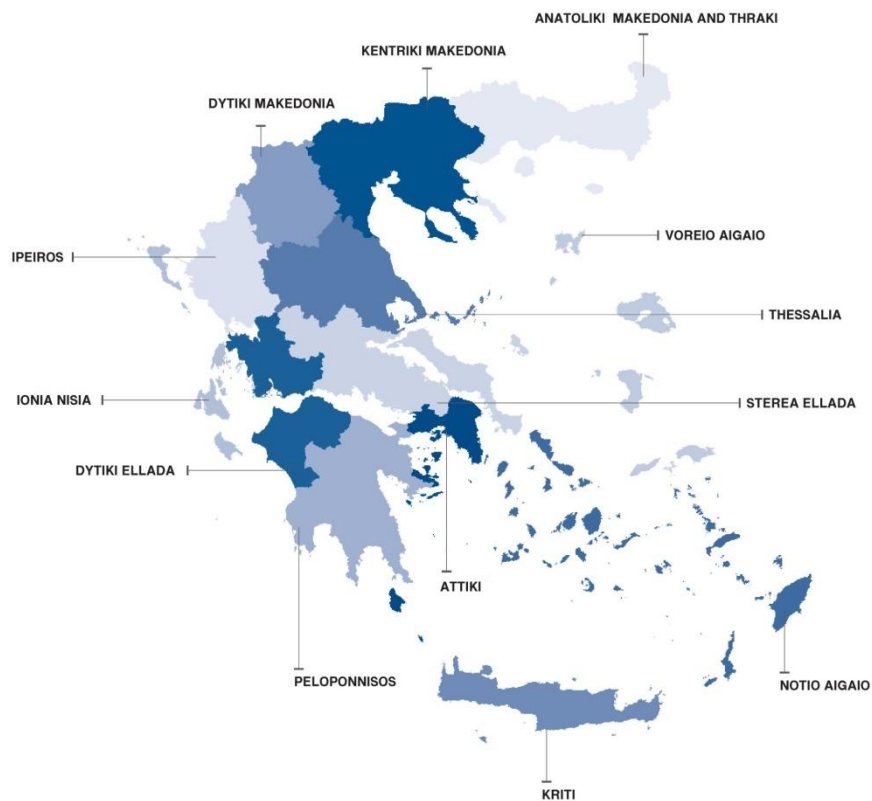
Reference period:

The 31st of December of every year when the survey is conducted.

Geographical classification:

The geographical classification is based on Nomenclature of Territorial Units for Statistics.

Methodology:

The survey is based on data collected by the Panhellenic Association of Pharmacists, the local Pharmaceutical Associations and the Panhellenic Association of Wholesale Drugstores.
