



MONTHLY DATA ON BIRTHS: January - December 2025

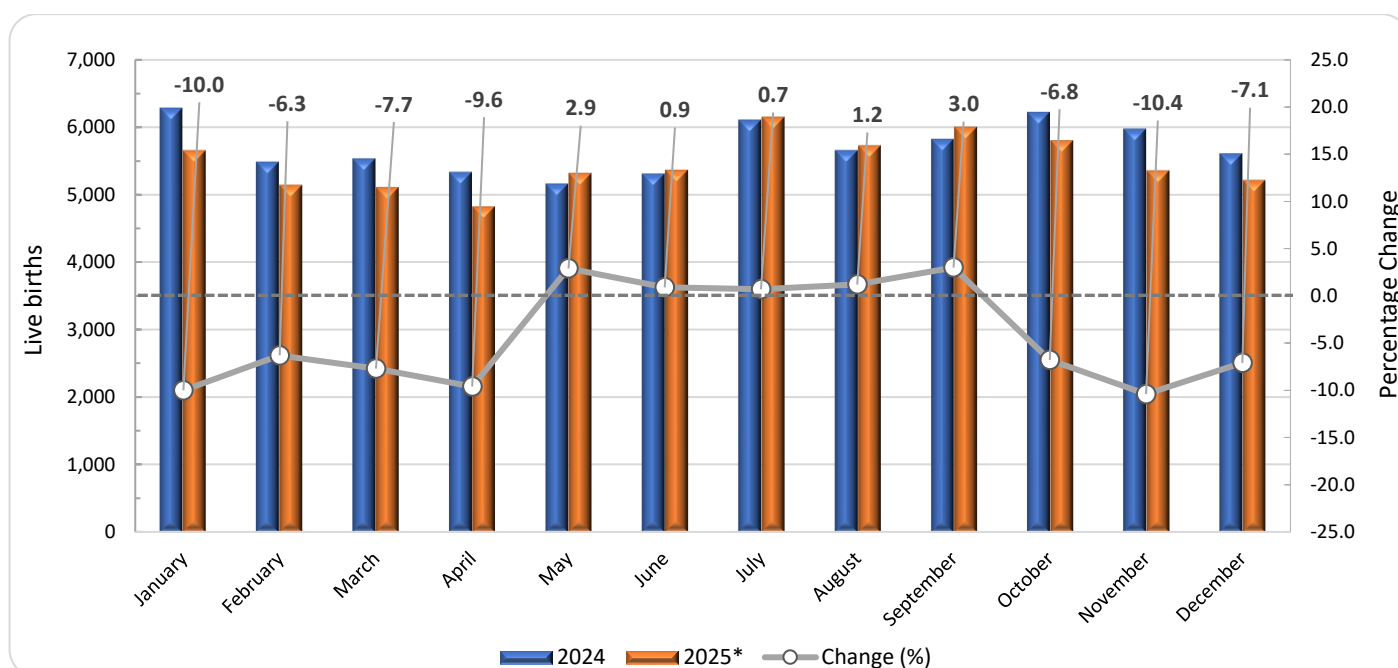
The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces provisional statistical data depicting the monthly evolution of births for the period January - December 2025. Data refer to live births that occurred within the Greek territory during the above-mentioned period.

This publication is part of the statistics under development¹ produced by the Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT), in the context of the adaptation process to the requirements of the new Regulation (EU) 2025/2458 of the European Parliament and of the Council on European statistics on population and housing. Similar publications are planned to be released by ELSTAT on a quarterly basis until the implementation date of the above-mentioned Regulation, set for 1st January 2028, when the publication framework will be reviewed.

The data included in this publication are compiled within the framework of the Vital Statistics Survey and are derived from data transmitted by the Civil Registry Offices of Municipal Authorities according to births that have been declared and registered up to the date of data transmission. Births reported after the statutory registration deadline are incorporated at a later stage, and the registration is recorded at the date of occurrence.

According to these data, live births in Greece in 2025 amounted to 65,594 (33,620 boys and 31,974 girls), in comparison with 68,467 (35,216 boys and 33,251 girls) in 2024, recording a decrease of 2,873 births (-4.2%). Stillbirths in 2025 amounted to 420, recording a decrease of 7.5% compared to the previous year, when 454 stillbirths were recorded (Tables 1 and 3).

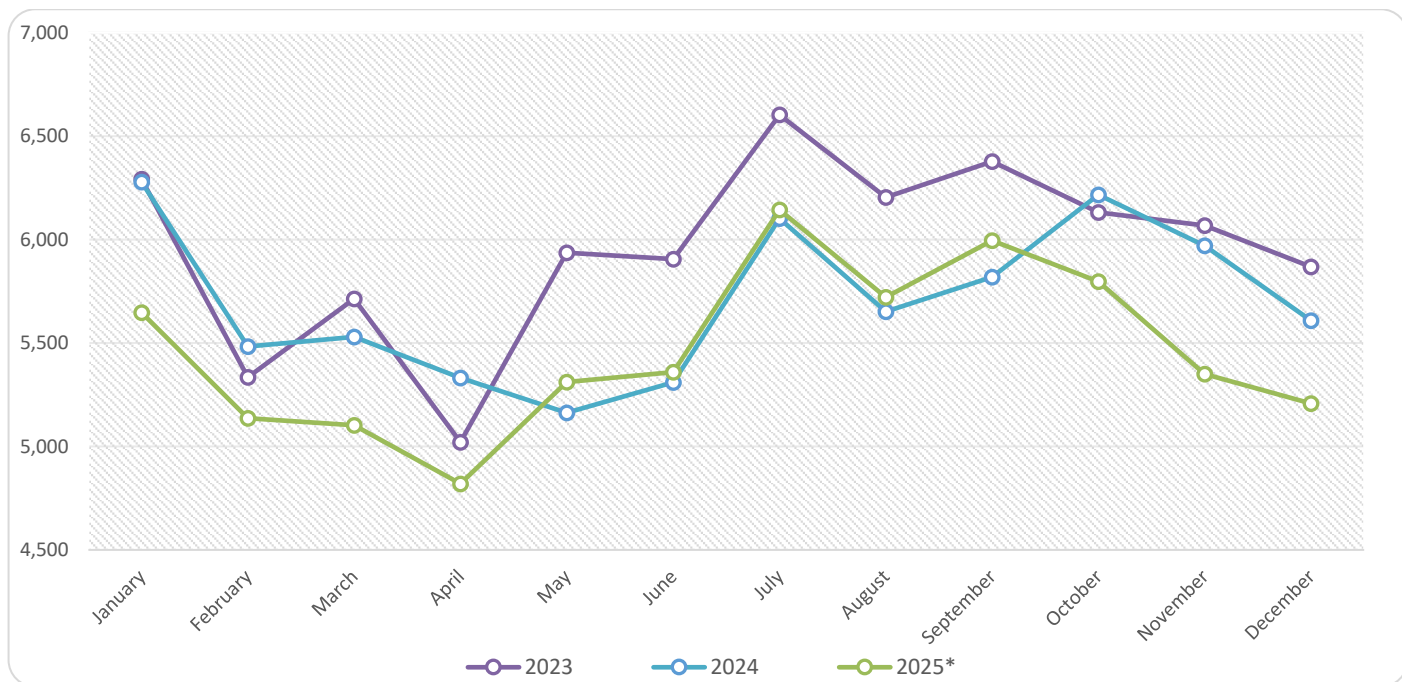

According to the above data, in 2025 compared to 2024, the most significant decreases in the number of births are recorded in November and January by 10.4% and 10.0%, respectively, whereas the most notable increases are observed in September and May by 3.0% and 2.9%, respectively.

It should be noted that data are updated after integration of more recent data or upon revision of already transmitted data by the Registry Offices.

Graph 2. Monthly live births for the years 2023, 2024, 2025



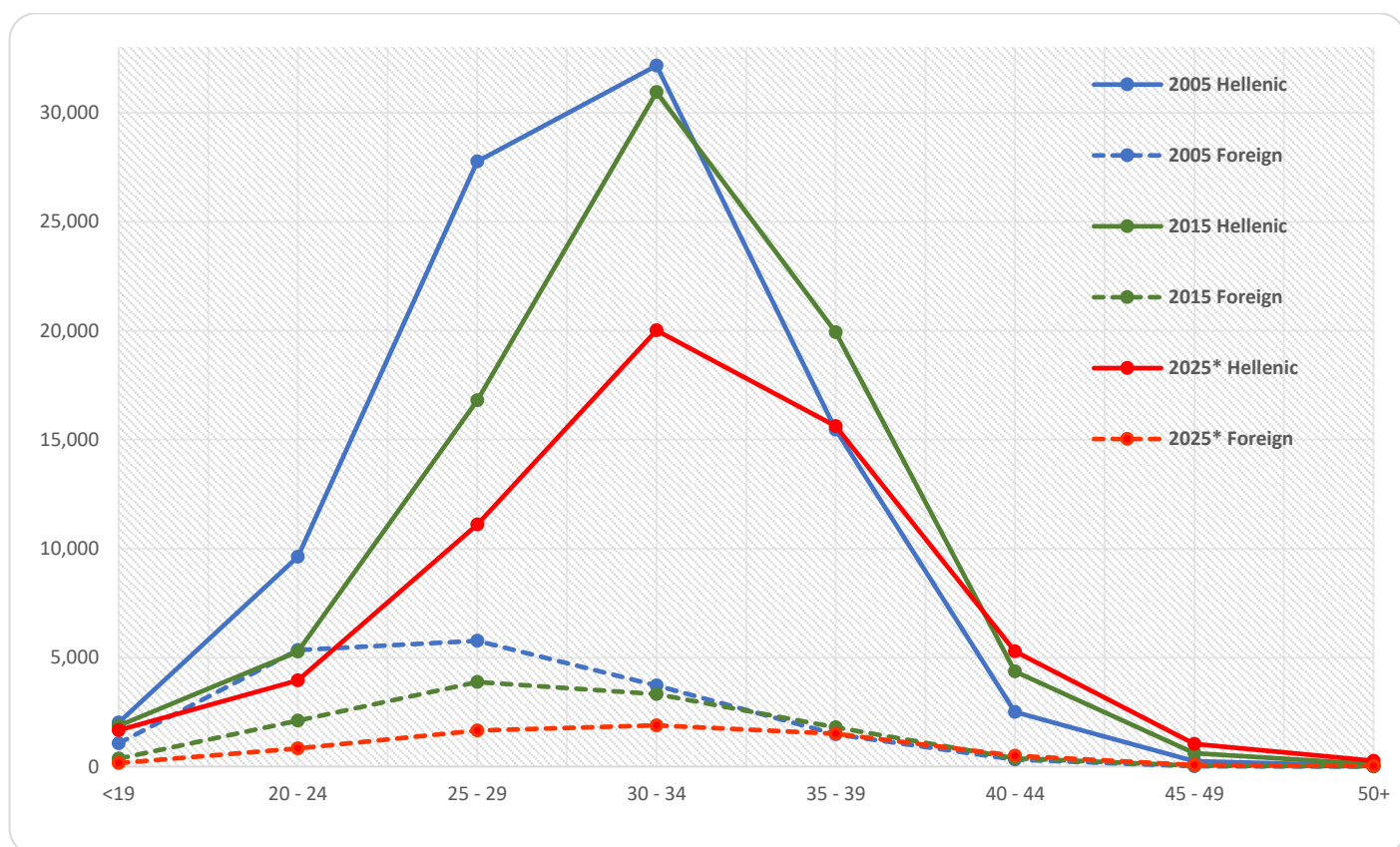

Based on the analysis of the total number of live births by age group of the mother, in 2025 compared to 2015, the biggest decreases, in absolute numbers, are recorded in the age groups 30 to 34 (12,356 births), 25 to 29 (7,922 births) and 35 to 39 (4,597 births), whereas the most notable increases are observed in the age groups 40 to 44 (1,031 births) and 45 to 49 (445 births). Similarly, according to the comparative analysis of the total number of live births by age group of the mother, in 2025 compared to 2005, the biggest decreases, in absolute numbers, are recorded in the age groups 25 to 29 (20,775 births), 30 to 34 (13,983 births) and 20 to 24 (10,177 births), while the biggest increases are observed in the age groups 40 to 44 (2,955 births) and 45 to 49 (852 births) (Table 2, Graph 3).

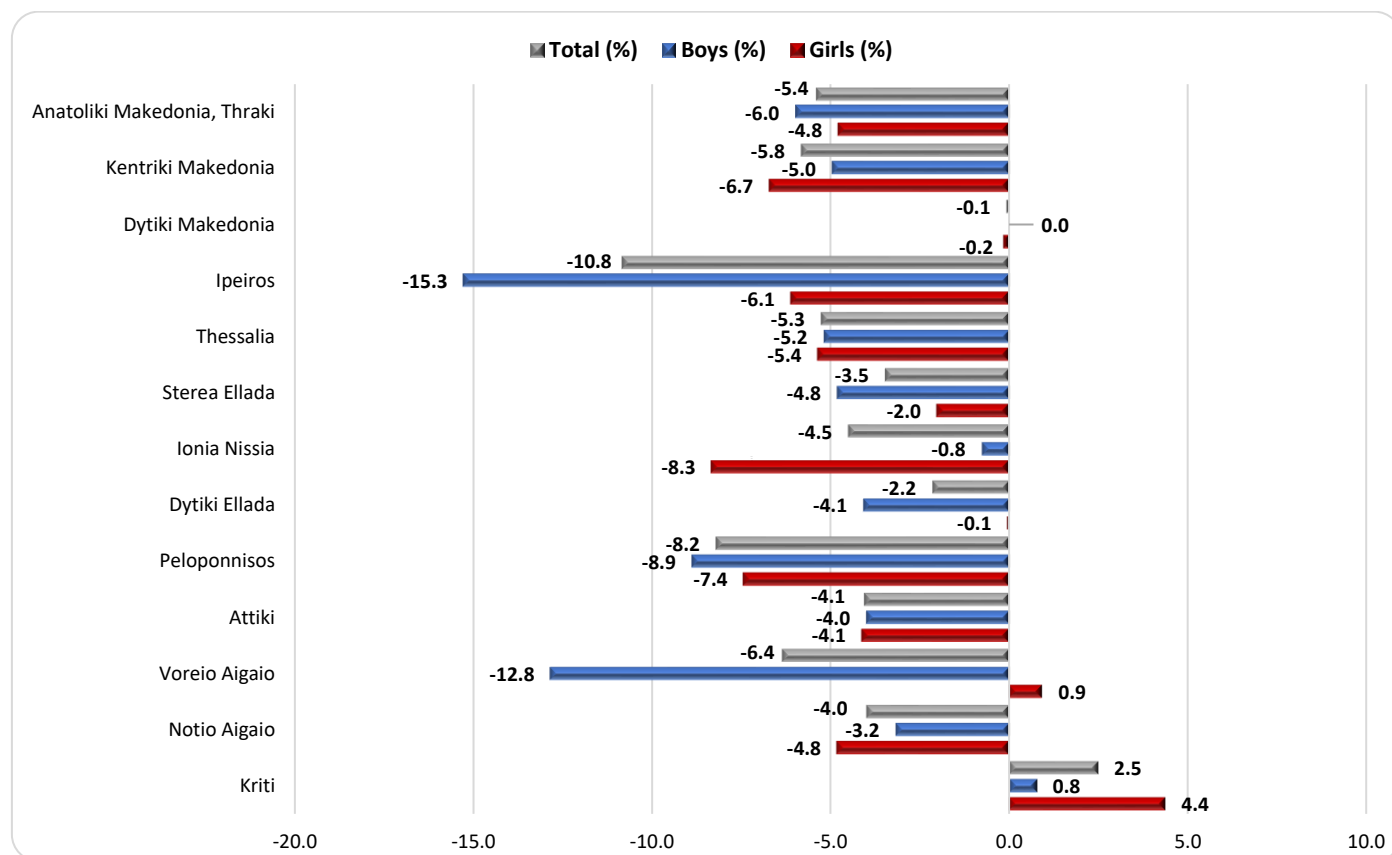
According to the data in Table 2, the ratio of live births to mothers of Hellenic citizenship to live births to foreign mothers was 8.9 to 1 in 2025, compared to 6.7 to 1 in 2015 and 5.1 to 1 in 2005 (Table 2).

As regards the breakdown of the total number of live births by NUTS 2 Region of the mother's usual residence, in 2025 compared to 2024, a decrease is observed in twelve (12) out of the thirteen (13) Regions of the Country. The most significant decreases, in absolute numbers, are recorded in the Regions of Attiki, Kentriki Makedonia and Peloponnisos by 1,007, 656 and 273 births respectively, whereas an increase is observed only in the Region of Kriti by 129 births (Table 4, Graph 4).

Data on live births regarding birth order and type of childbirth (single/multiple) are presented in the following table.

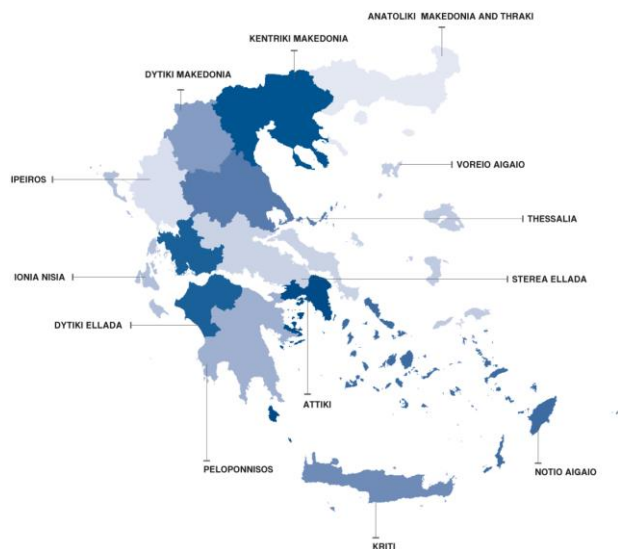

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Statistics under development	Statistics under development are newly developed and innovative statistics that are published to involve users of statistical data and stakeholders in the assessment of their suitability and quality at an early stage and contribute to their adaptation to information needs.
Data on monthly births (Vital Statistics Survey)	In the context of the Vital Statistics Survey, data presented in this publication refer to the monthly evolution of births and are drawn from civil registry acts issued by the Municipal Authorities. ELSTAT proceeds with the processing of birth data in order to depict the evolution of births in the country, even on the basis of provisional data, and to record, in a timely manner, changes in fertility levels in relation to key demographic variables (e.g. age, citizenship, place of usual residence of the mother, sex of the newborn etc.).
Reference periods	Data for 2025 are provisional, whereas for all other years are final.
Legal Framework	Law 344/76 concerning the “Registration of vital events” which lays down the obligations of the Civil Register Offices to collect and then transmit the data, as well as by Law 3832/2010 on the “Hellenic Statistical System (EL.S.S.), Establishment of the Hellenic Statistical Authority (EL.STAT.) as an independent authority”, both as amended and in force.
Coverage	The Vital Statistics survey is an exhaustive survey and covers all births that occur in the Greek territory. More specifically, all live births to mothers who are usual residents of Greece are recorded, as well as births to mothers residing abroad who were in Greece for various reasons during the reference period and gave birth.
Definitions	“Live birth” is defined as the birth of a child who breathes or shows any other evidence of life, irrespective of the duration of pregnancy.
Methodology	Provisional data on births undergo the necessary quality checks, they are processed and presented in the form of tables.
Geographical classification	Geographical classification is based on the Nomenclature of Territorial Units for Statistics (NUTS). Data are disseminated at Country and Region (NUTS 2) level.
