

MATERIAL COSTS INDEX IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS: July 2025, y-o-y increase 2.9%

The Overall Material Costs Index in the Construction (CSTM) of New Residential Buildings with base year 2021=100.0 in July 2025 recorded an increase of 2.9% in comparison with July 2024. The corresponding index in July 2024 had recorded an increase of 5.4% compared with July 2023 (Table 1).

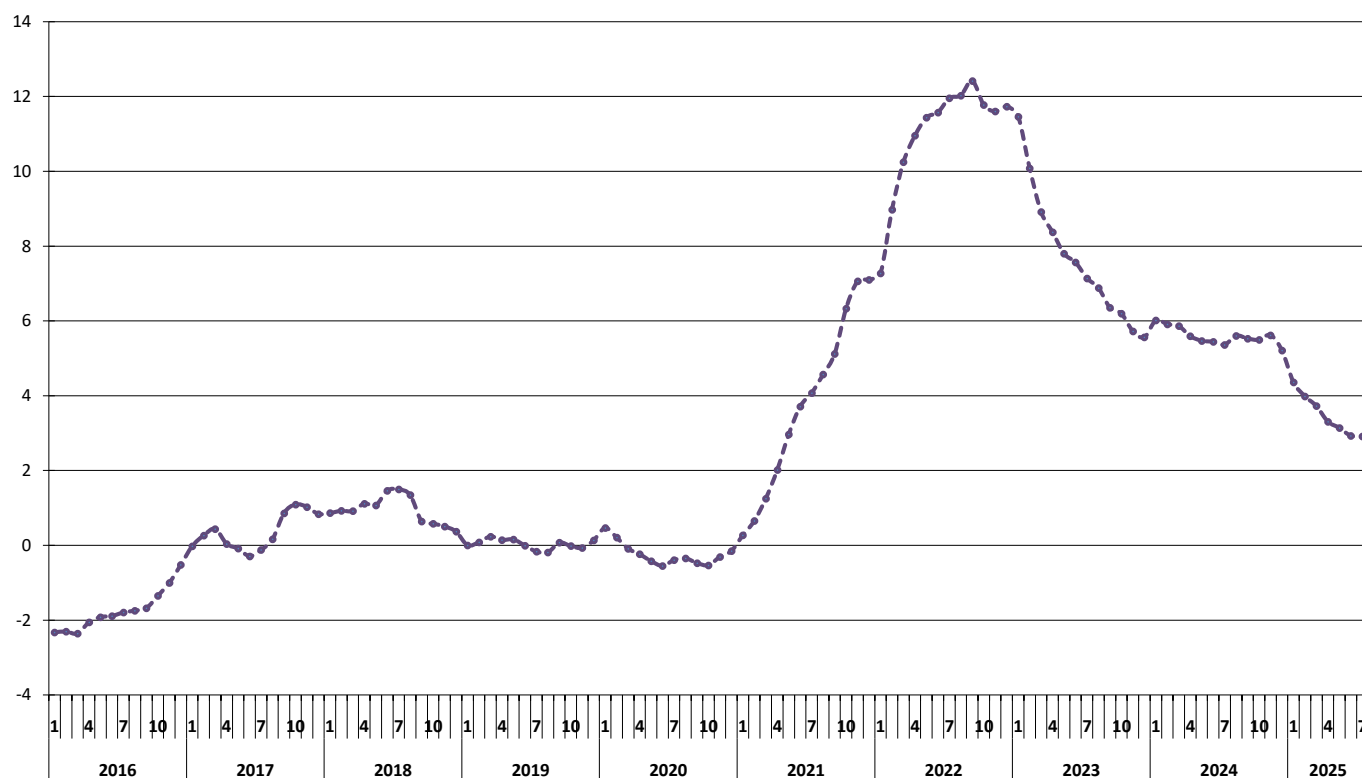
The Overall Index in July 2025, compared with the corresponding index in June 2025, recorded an increase of 0.3%. The index between July 2024 and June 2024 had also recorded an increase of 0.3% (Table 2).

The average Index for the twelve-month period from August 2024 to July 2025, compared with the corresponding index for the twelve-month period from August 2023 to July 2024, recorded an increase of 4.3%. The comparison of the average Material Costs Index in the corresponding previous twelve-month periods had shown an increase of 5.9% (Table 3).

Annual rates of change: July 2025 compared with July 2024

The Overall Material Costs Index in the Construction of New Residential Buildings in July 2025, compared with the corresponding index in July 2024 recorded an increase of 2.9% (Table 1). The main changes in the individual costs indices of the material categories are as follows :

Monthly rates of change: July 2025 compared with June 2025

The Overall Material Costs Index in the Construction of New Residential Buildings in July 2025 recorded an increase of 0.3% in comparison with the corresponding index in June 2025 (Table 2). The main changes in the individual costs indices of the material categories are as follows:

METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

Generally The compilation of the Material Costs Index in the Construction of New Residential Buildings started in 1971. The index with base year 2021 is compiled since April 2024, when it replaced the previous index with base year 2015.

Purpose of the index – definitions The purpose of the index is to measure the monthly rates of change in the prices of building materials paid by the constructors and consumed in the construction of new residential buildings. The Material Costs Index is a monthly index and consists a sub-index of the Overall Costs Index in Construction of New Residential Buildings. For the compilation of the index the prices of the materials supplied, which are actually paid by the construction enterprises at the site, are collected and do not include VAT and other deductible taxes.

Legal framework The Material Costs Index in the Construction of New Residential Buildings is compiled to cover national information needs (for the provision of more detailed statistical information to users and the calculation of the quarterly Price Index for Cost in Construction of New Residential Buildings in the framework of the implementation of Regulation (EU) 2019/2152 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/1197.

Reference period Month.

Base year 2021=100.0.

Revision The Material Costs Index in the Construction of New Residential Buildings is a fixed base index. The last revision of the index, with base year 2021, was made in the context of the implementation of Regulation (EC) 2019/2152 of the European Parliament and of the Council.

Statistical classification A national classification is followed, which includes 85 categories of materials, aggregated in 15 groups.

Geographical coverage The geographical coverage of the index includes the country as a whole however prices are collected only in the biggest urban centers of the country (Greater Athens, Thessaloniki, Patra, Herakleio, Larisa and Volos).

Coverage of economic activities The Material Costs Index in Construction of New Residential Buildings is a monthly index and consists a sub-index of the quarterly Price Index for Cost in Construction of New Residential Buildings. It is an input index and covers the transactions for the acquisition of building materials of the new residential buildings construction sector from the units / enterprises that provide these materials.

Statistical survey A total number of 1,490 observations (prices) collected from 260 commercial or industrial enterprises supplying building materials are used for the compilation of the index. For electricity, prices are collected from the Public Power Corporation, while for water data are provided by water supply companies.

Publication of data The index with the base year 2021=100.0 is released since April 2024, with March 2024 as the first reference month. Times series data with base year 2021=100.0 are available from January 2000 onwards.
