SURVEY ON MUSEUMS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES ATTENDANCE MARCH 2024


The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces the results of the *Survey on Museums and Archaeological Sites Attendance* for March 2024. More specifically:

• During March 2024 compared with the corresponding month of 2023, museums recorded a 16.5% increase in the number of visitors and an 21.6% decrease in the number of free admission visitors, as well as a 31.7% increase in their receipts (Table 1).

• As regards archaeological sites, in March 2024 compared with the corresponding month of 2023, an increase of 41.3% was recorded in the number of visitors, of 17.6% in the number of free admission visitors and of 71.4% in the corresponding receipts (Table 1).

• During the three-month period from January to March 2024, compared to the corresponding period of 2023, an increase of 14.0% was recorded in the number of visitors of Museums, a 3.7% decrease in the number of free admission visitors and an increase 17.9% in the relevant receipts (Table 2).

• As regards archaeological sites, during the three - month period from January to March 2024, compared to the corresponding period of 2023, an increase of 38.0% was recorded in the number of visitors, while an increase of 33.0% was observed in the number of free admission visitors and of 47.3% in the relevant receipts (Table 2).





Graph 3: Percentage distribution of visitors by Museum, March 2024







EXPLANATORY NOTES

Survey on Museums and Archaeological Sites Attendance	The Survey on Museums and Archaeological Sites Attendance has been producing results since 1970. The survey collects data from the Hellenic Organization of Cultural Resources Development (HOCRED), supervised by the Ministry of Culture and Sports, on the number of visitors and the receipts from the tickets sold in the Museums and Archaeological sites of the country. The corresponding data for the Acropolis Museum is available from December 2009 onwards.
Legal Framework	The survey is conducted since 1970 on a regular basis and it produces results on a monthly and yearly basis, in compliance with the Joint Ministerial Decision 15189/B379/73.
Reference Period	1/3/2024 - 31/3/2024
Methodology and Definitions	The survey is conducted on a monthly basis from data mainly collected from the Hellenic Organization of Cultural Resources Development (HOCRED), supervised by the Ministry of Culture and Sports, on the number of visitors and the receipts from the tickets sold in the Museums and Archaeological sites of the Country. ELSTAT tabulates and presents the data for the whole of the Country, by month and by year.
	Number of flat rate tickets:
	From April 1999 onwards, in some museums and the nearby archaeological sites, in addition to the ordinary ticket, a new "flat rate ticket" was established, which is valid for both the museum and the nearby archaeological site. The total number of these flat rate tickets for March 2024 was 32,050
