


## DATA ON WEEKLY DEATHS: Period 1st to 40th week, 2024

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces the provisional statistical data depicting the weekly evolution of death counts for the period from the first ( $1^{st}$ ) to the fortieth ( $40^{th}$ ) week of 2024 (1/1/2024 - 6/10/2024). Data refer to the deaths that occurred in the Greek territory during that period due to various causes including deaths attributed to Covid-19.

The data included in this publication are compiled within the framework of the Vital Statistics Survey, are drawn from civil registry acts as submitted by Municipal Authorities and refer to vital events declared and registered until the date of data transmission. Overdue registrations of deaths are integrated at a later stage on the date of occurrence.

According to these data, the number of deaths in Greece during the first forty (40) weeks of 2024 (1/1/2024 – 6/10/2024) amounted to 97,197 (48,834 men and 48,363 women), whereas during the corresponding period of 2023 (2/1/2023 – 8/10/2023) had amounted to 98,768 (49,955 men and 48,813 women) recording a decrease of 1,571 deaths (-1.6%). A decrease of 3,071 deaths (-3.1%) is recorded compared to the average of the first forty (40) week cumulative deaths for the six-year period 2018 – 2023 (100,268 deaths). The corresponding annual rates of change for the period 2018 - 2023 amount to -9.9% in 2023 compared to 2022 (109,595), 1.9% in 2022 compared to 2021 (107,511), 10.4% in 2021 compared to 2020 (97,365), 0.5% in 2020 compared to 2019 (96,883) and 5.9% in 2019 compared to 2018 (91,487) (Tables 1, 2, 3 and 4).



According to the above data, for the first forty (40) weeks of 2024 compared to the corresponding weeks of 2023, the most notable decreases are observed for the  $7^{th}$  (12/2/2024 - 18/2/2024), the  $9^{th}$  (26/2/2024 - 3/3/2024) and the  $8^{th}$  week (19/2/2024 - 25/2/2024) by 18.2%, 13.6% and 13.0% respectively, whereas the most notable increases are observed for the  $24^{th}$  (10/6/2024 - 16/6/2024), the  $32^{nd}$  (5/8/2024 - 11/8/2024) and the  $33^{rd}$  week (12/8/2024 - 18/8/2024) by 15.6%, 12.7% and 12.1% respectively.


It should be noted that data are updated after integration of more recent data or upon revision of already transmitted data by the Registry Offices. Consequently, data may differ from those already announced in previous publications.





Graph 5. Deaths by age group and sex, 1st - 40th week, 2023 and 2024





As regards the breakdown of the total number of deaths by age group of the deceased for the first forty (40) weeks of 2024 compared to the corresponding period of the year 2023, a decrease of deaths is observed in fourteen (14) age groups and an increase in five (5) with the highest decreases, in absolute figures, being observed for the age groups 80 to 84 (846 deaths), 85 to 89 (670 deaths) and 75 to 79 (164 deaths) compared to the corresponding period of 2023, whereas the most notable increases are observed for the age groups over 90 (227 deaths), 65 to 69 (118 deaths) and 55 to 59 (99 deaths) (Table 4).

As regards the breakdown of the total number of deaths by Region of usual residence of the deceased for the first forty (40) weeks of 2024 compared to the corresponding period of the year 2023, a decrease of deaths is observed in eight (8) out of thirteen (13) Regions of the Country. The most notable decreases, in absolute figures, are observed in the Regions of Attiki, Thessalia and Peloponnisos by 746, 321 and 209 deaths respectively, whereas the most notable increases are observed in the Regions of Anatoliki Makedonia and Thraki, Voreio Aigaio and Ionia Nisia by 130, 74 and 62 deaths respectively (Graph 6, Table 5).

## **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

Vital For the Vital statistics Survey, data are drawn from civil registry acts edited by the Municipal Statistics- Authorities. Data presented in this publication refer to the weekly evolution of death counts according to the international standard of weeks ISO8601. This is a data processing for the purpose of depicting, even using provisional data, the evolution of deaths in the Country and timely recording of mortality levels in relation to basic demographic variables.

Legal Law 344/76 concerning the "Registration of vital events" which lays down the obligations of
Framework the Civil Register Offices to collect and then transmit the data, as well as by Law 3832/2010 on the "Greek Statistical System", both as amended.

**Coverage** The Vital Statistics survey is an exhaustive survey and covers all deaths of usual resident population that occur in the Greek territory.


**Definitions** All deaths of usual residents taking place in the Greek territory are recorded, regardless of the cause of death. Deaths of usual resident population of other countries are also recorded but not counted. The deaths of migrant-refugees in the Greek territory during their attempt to approach European countries are not included.

Causes of death are defined according to the International Statistical Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems (ICD-10) and basic categories are Diseases of the Circulatory System, Diseases of the Respiratory System, Neoplasms, Infectious and Parasitic Diseases, Violent deaths and other causes, Covid-19 included.

**Methodology** Data on deaths and vital statistics undergo the necessary quality checks, are processed, and presented in the form of tables.

**Geographical** Geographical classification is based on the Nomenclature of Territorial Units for Statistics classification (NUTS). Data are disseminated at Country and Region (NUTS2) level.
