



**TERTIARY EDUCATION (UNIVERSITIES AND TECHNOLOGICAL INSTITUTIONS)
END OF ACADEMIC YEAR 2023/2024**

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces data on Tertiary Education (Universities and Technological Institutions) for the end of academic year 2022/2023. Based on the survey data on Tertiary Education:

- The number of **enrolled undergraduate students** in all tertiary education institutions in the academic year 2023/2024 increased by 1.3% in comparison to 2022/2023 (Table 1).
- **Teaching staff** in all tertiary education institutions in the academic year 2023/2024 decreased by 4.3% in comparison to 2022/2023 (Table 2).
- The number of **graduates from undergraduate programmes** in the academic year 2023/2024 increased by 0.1% in comparison to 2022/2023 (Table 3).
- **Enrolled postgraduate students** in the academic year 2023/2024 increased by 0.8% in comparison to 2022/2023 (Table 4).
- **Postgraduate students that graduated** in the academic year 2023/2024 decreased by 5.9% in comparison to 2022/2023 (Table 5).
- **Enrolled doctorate students** in the academic year 2023/2024 increased by 3.5% in comparison to 2022/2023 (Table 6).
- **Doctoral students that graduated** in the academic year 2023/2024 increased by 4.8% in comparison to 2022/2023 (Table 7).

Graph 1. Enrolled undergraduate students by educational institution, end of academic years 2022/2023 and 2023/2024

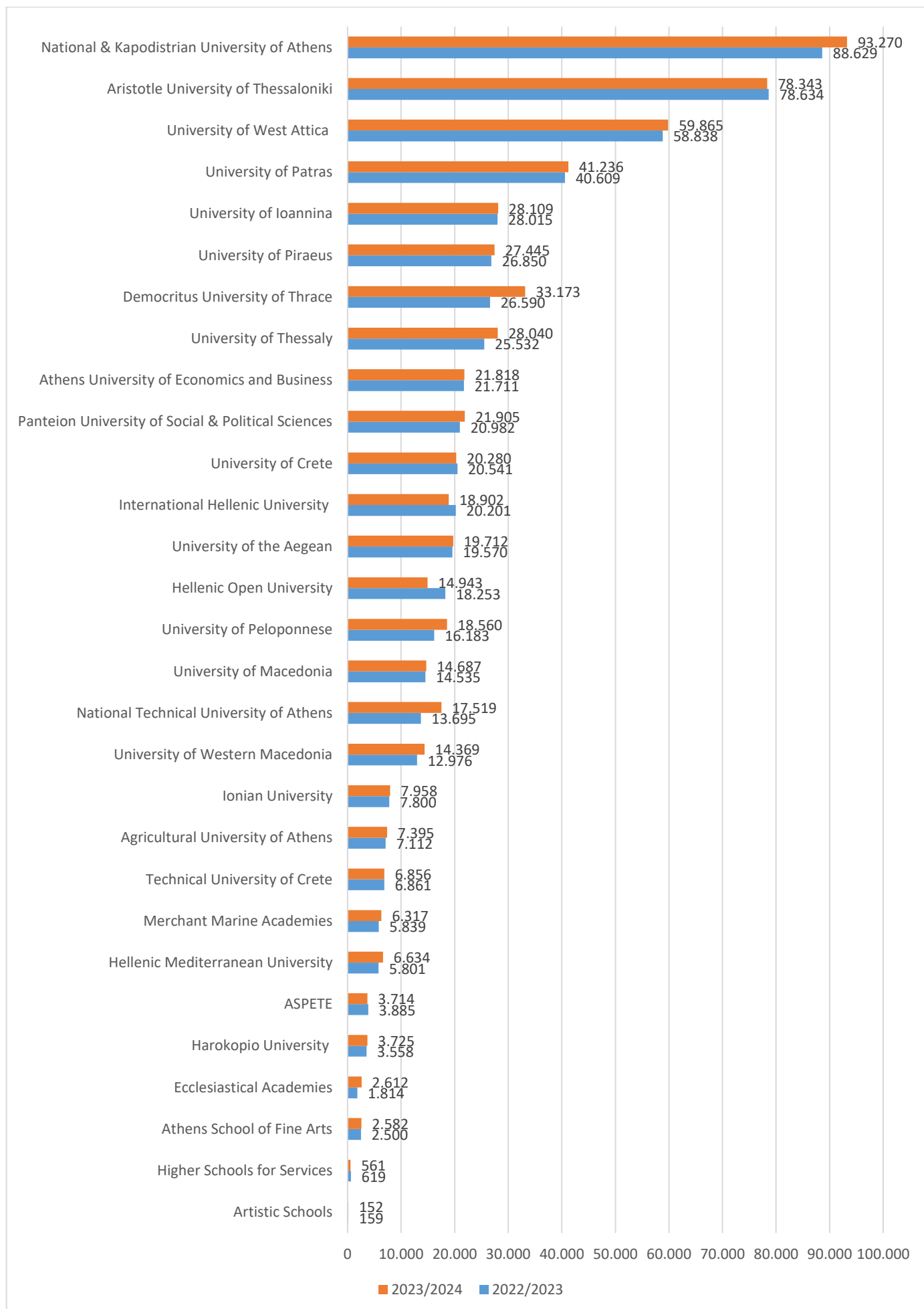

Graph 2. Enrolled postgraduate students by educational institution, end of academic years 2022/2023 and 2023/2024

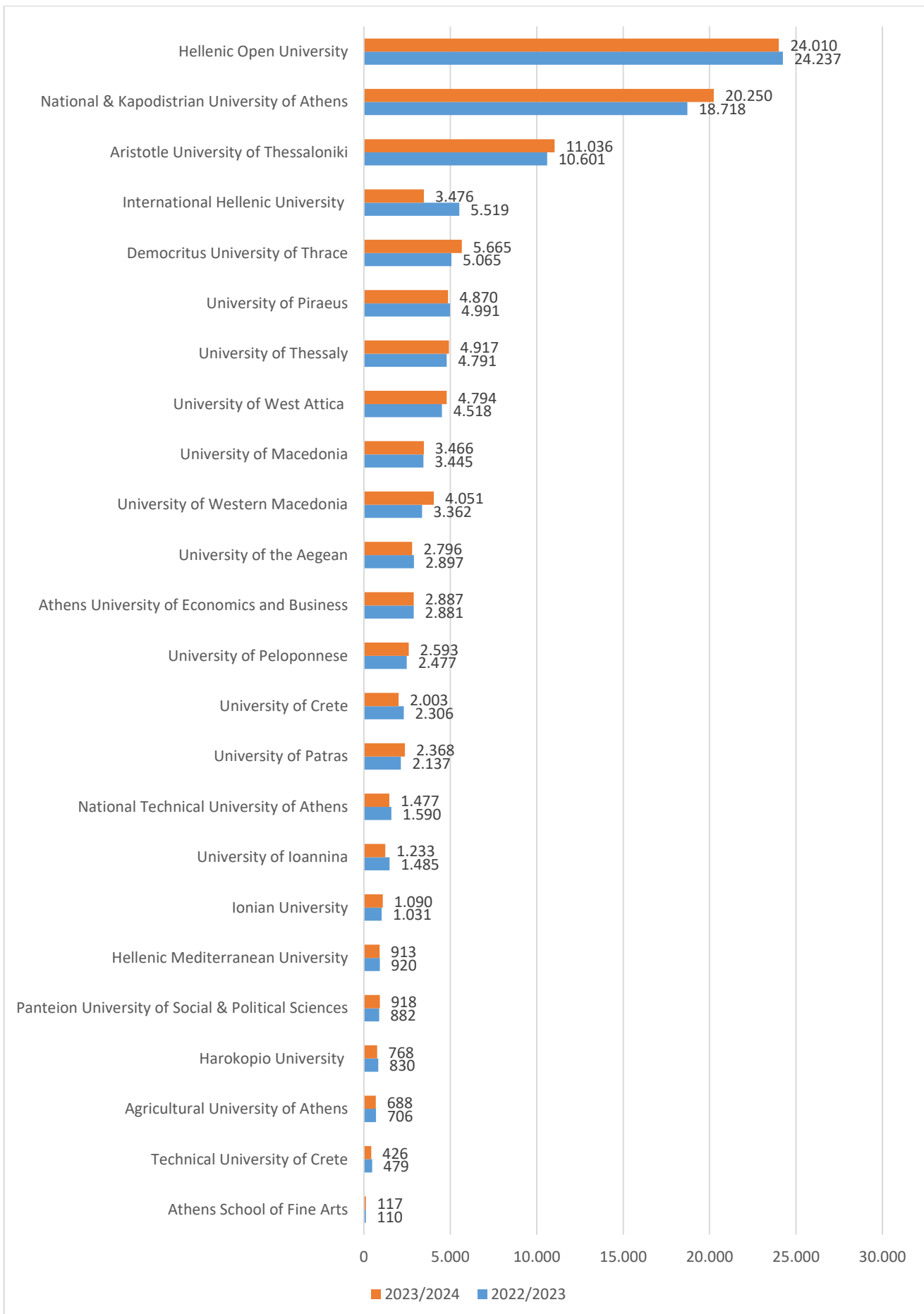

Survey on Tertiary Education (Universities and Technological Institutions)	<p>Tertiary Education consists of two domains:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) University Sector including Universities, Polytechnic Schools, the Athens School of Fine Arts and ii) the Technological Sector including the Technological Educational Institutes (TEI), the School of Pedagogical and Technological Education (ASPETE), the Academies of Merchant Shipping, Ecclesiastical Academies, Schools of Service and Artistic Schools). <p>According to Laws 4559/2018, 4589/2019 and 4610/2019 Technological Educational Institutions (TEI) were abolished and integrated into respective Departments of Universities. However, undergraduate students that entered TEI in the academic year 2018/2019 or in previous academic years had the right to graduate as Technological Education graduates attending classes from the TEI curriculum which was in place when they entered Tertiary Education. For this reason, in the academic years 2022/2023 and 2023/2024, despite the abolition of TEI, enrolled and graduate students of TEI still appear in the tables.</p> <p>The current survey is conducted annually by all Member States of the European Union. The aim is to collect data on enrolled undergraduate, postgraduate and doctorate students, undergraduate and postgraduate students that graduated, as well as the number of the teaching staff.</p>
