GUIDELINES
FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE QUESTIONNAIRE
(Professional propelled fishing vessels with horsepower over 20hp)

1. For every vessel it should be completed one questionnaire per month. This is also valid for months that the vessel doesn't work.

2. Custom authorities of the departure port should record the completed questionnaire. In case that the vessel is far from the departure port, the landing port could record the questionnaire.

3. Upon the delivery of the questionnaire, together the handbook of statistical awareness should be certified

Quest 1. Enter the name of the customs authority

Quest.2 Enter the number of the fishing vessels registry

Quest.3. Enter the name of the vessel in capital

Quest.4. Enter the shipping registry number and the shipping registry port accordingly

Quest.5. Enter the net tonnage in tonnes For vessels under 5 tonnes put a dash (-)

Quest.6. Enter the horsepower in (HP)

Quest.7. Enter the number of persons employed for the refereed month.

- a) Enter the fully employed persons, that is who are employed exclusively on fishery
- b) Enter the partly employed, that is who are engaged on other jobs as well.

Quest. 8: Enter the kind of the fishing tools, used at the specific month (for example: trawler, purse seines, lines, common nets etc.). If it is more than one kind of fishing tools, enter the most usual

Quest. 9: Enter the fishing area of the vessel at the specific month (for example: Thermaikos gulf, Chios island, Sporades islands, gulf of Laconia, coasts of Lefkada and Kefalonia etc.). If during the said month the vessel fished more than one area, enter the area in which the greatest quantity of fish was caught.

Quest. 10: In the first part of the question, the fish are distinguished into three basic categories: «First», «Second» and «Third». Next to each category, enter the quantity of the catch, in kilos, at column (b), the selling price per kilo, at column (c) and any relative comment at column (d).

In the second part of the question the fish are put down by principal species, in alphabetic order. Next to species, enter the quantities of fish landed during the specific month, (at column b).

Quest. 11: Enter the number of the days that the fishing vessel worked. If it did not work at all or if it worked less than 10 days, enter the particular reason (for example refit of the vessel, bad weather, sickness of the vessel owner etc)

Finally, the questionnaire has to be signed by the fisher and the customs – officer.
