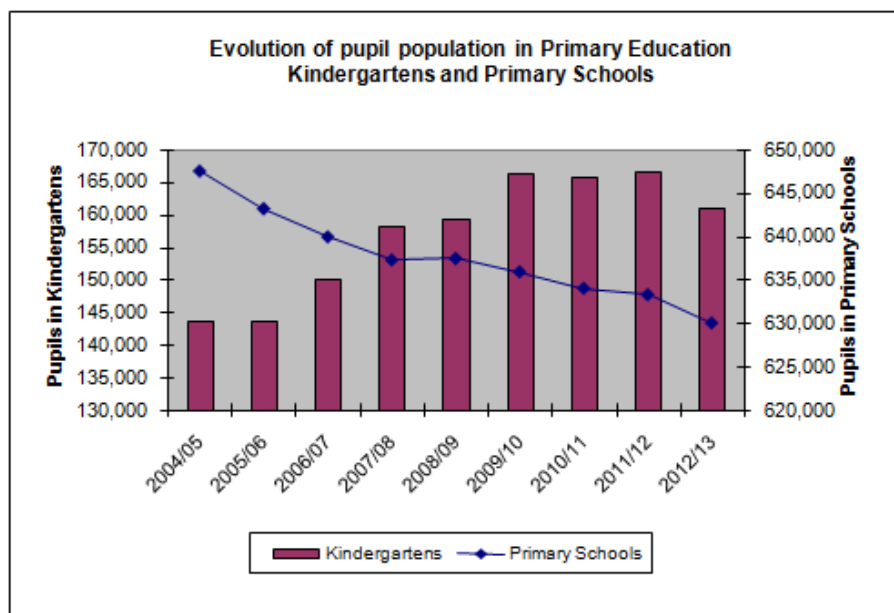
PRIMARY EDUCATION STATISTICS

Pupils, school units and teaching staff: end of school year 2013/2014

ELSTAT announces data on Primary Education statistics as follows:

- The number of pupils enrolled in the school year 2013/2014 compared with the corresponding number in the school year 2012/2013 recorded a 3.4% decrease as regards kindergartens and a 0.8% decrease as regards primary schools (Tables A1 and B1);
- School units decreased by 3.2% in kindergartens and by 1.4% in primary schools (Tables A2 and B2);
- The teaching staff decreased by 2.5% in kindergartens, and by 0.3% in primary schools (Tables A2 and B2);
- The ratio of pupils to the teaching staff is 11.9 to 1 in kindergartens and 9.6 to 1 in primary schools (Tables A1, A2 and B1, B2);
- The Region of Attiki accounts for the largest share of pupils enrolled in Primary Education with 28.2% for kindergartens and 34.3% for primary schools (Tables A1 and B1).

Reference period	The data of the survey refer to the end of school year 2013/2014. For comparability reasons the data of the end of the previous school year 2012/2013 are also provided.
Methodology and coverage	The survey is an annual census survey and is conducted by the use of special questionnaires, namely the forms $\Sigma E-1$ for the kindergartens and $\Sigma E-2$ for the primary schools. The survey is conducted by the Hellenic Statistical Authority on all the educational units of Greece,
