
## PRESS RELEASE EDUCATIONAL VISITS IN ELSTAT (Action for Fostering Statistical Literacy)

In the framework of its strategy for "Fostering statistical literacy" in Greece, the Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) continued, during the school/academic year 2019/2020, to organise on the premises of the Central Office (46 Peiraios & Eponiton St. - Piraeus) educational visits for pupils and students. During the same school/academic year, this action was also implemented by the Regional Statistical Office of Thessaloniki (218, Delfon St. – Thessaloniki), while an ELSTAT official from the Regional Statistical Office of Rethymno visited and presented the relevant programme in a school unit in Irakleio.

During these visits, the pupils/students are given the opportunity to comprehend the statistical science, enhance their understanding about the usefulness of statistical data in everyday life and become aware of the importance of Official Statistics for the Country.

In the beginning of March 2020, the educational programme of ELSTAT was suspended following the suspension of all educational units' operation, in the framework of the national measures taken in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Nevertheless, the number of pupils/students who attended the programme during the period from October 2019 until the beginning of March 2020 was remarkable, as 3,431 pupils/students from 66 school units and university schools and departments attended the educational programme.



The purpose of the visits is to acquaint pupils/students with the world of statistics and to inform them on the processes for the development, production and dissemination of official statistics, following European and international statistical standards in all areas, and unswervingly observing the rules laid down in the Greek and Union legislation. Moreover, the important role and use of official statistics in politics, economy and everyday life is highlighted. In addition, the pupils/students learn how to find easily the information they are looking for and they have the opportunity to navigate ELSTAT and Eurostat websites.
