The 20th of October has been designated by the United Nations General Assembly in 2010 as World Statistics Day to be celebrated every five years, with the aim of establishing a day dedicated exclusively to the statistical science and highlighting the value of official statistics.



The theme of this year's celebration, "Connecting the world with data we can trust", is highlighting the importance of quality statistics, especially in times of extraordinary circumstances and crises. The choice of the topic reflects, at the same time, the emphasis on promoting innovation at every stage of the development, production and dissemination of statistics and focusing on the concept of statistical information as a public good produced by the national statistical systems.
