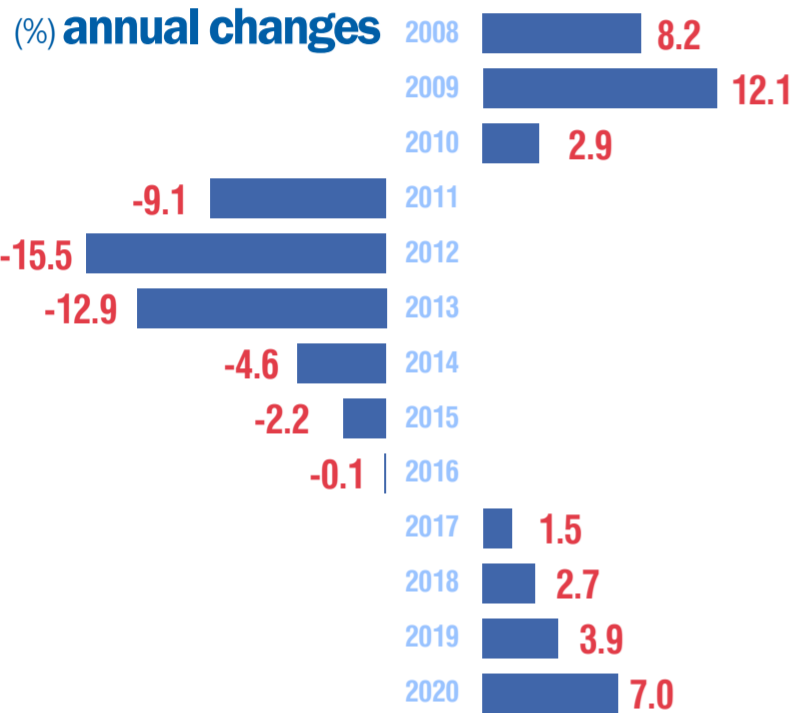


RISK OF POVERTY OR SOCIAL EXCLUSION, 2020

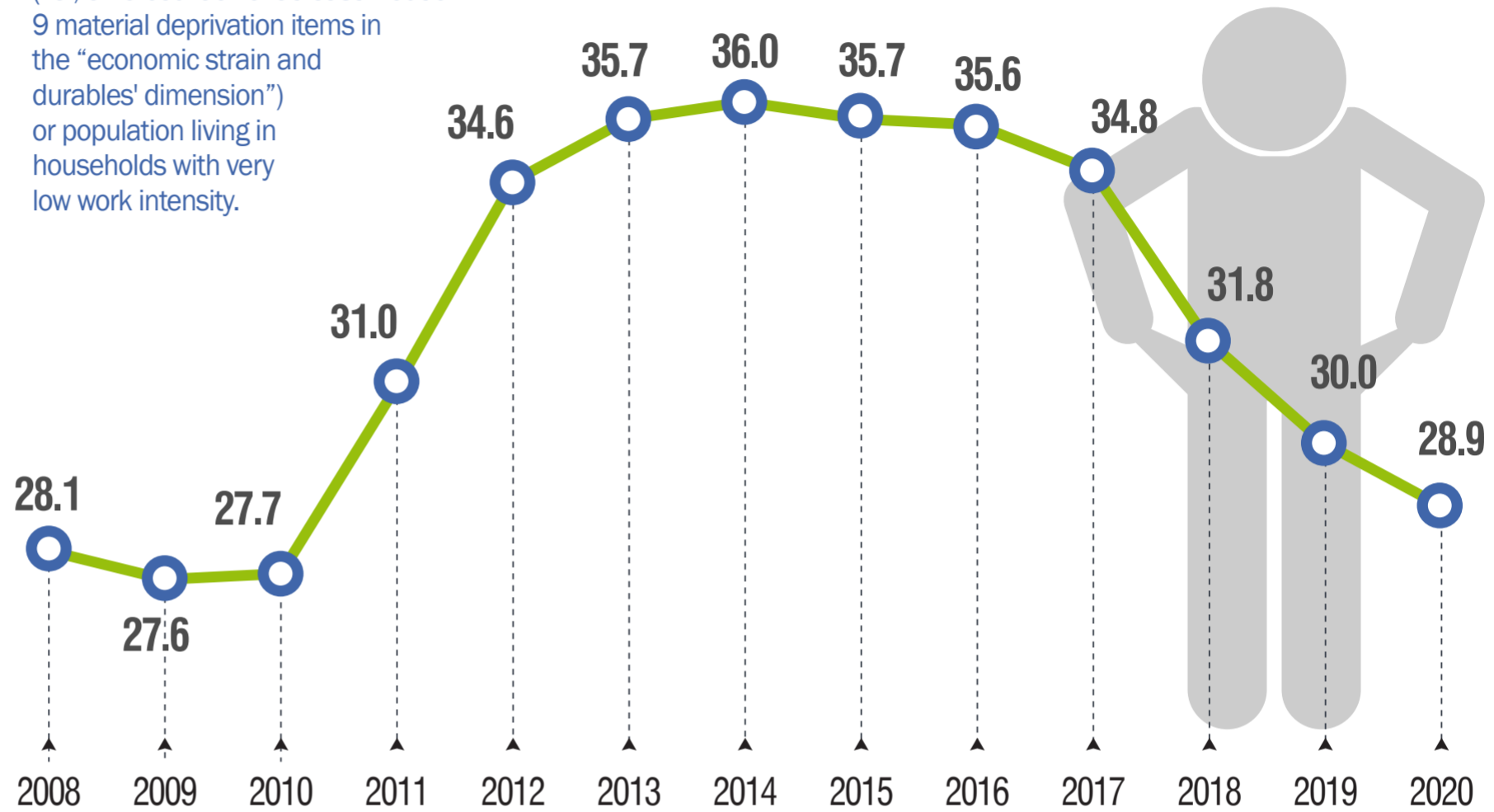

POPULATION AT-RISK-OF-POVERTY OR SOCIAL EXCLUSION (%)

Population at-risk-of poverty or social exclusion: population at-risk-of-poverty or in material deprivation (i.e., enforced lack of at least 4 out of 9 material deprivation items in the "economic strain and durables' dimension") or population living in households with very low work intensity.

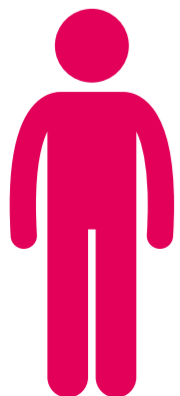
