ANNOUNCEMENT

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) has published on its website the updated statistical Register of General Government Entities with **December 2012 as the reference date**.

The compilation and regular updating of a Register of General Government Entities constitutes an obligation of all Member States of the European Union for the proper delineation of the institutional sector of General Government, as this is identified by the European System of Accounts – ESA95 (EU Regulation 2223/96) on the basis of specific criteria.

The statistical Register of General Government Entities is constructed and used by ELSTAT exclusively for statistical purposes, namely to conduct the annual and quarterly surveys of General Government Entities, which are necessary for the compilation of the Excessive Deficit Procedure (EDP) tables and more broadly for the compilation of quarterly and annual government finance statistics by ELSTAT. The proper maintenance of the Register, through its continuous updating, is an important statistical task with a view to the proper and accurate delimitation of General Government according to the rules of ESA95, which in turn ensures the reliability of the government finance statistics of the country.

It should be noted that the responsibility for the proper maintenance of the statistical Register of General Government Entities lies with ELSTAT. It should also be noted that this Register is not a register of all the entities that are supervised and controlled by the government, nor is it the register of all organizations funded by the public sector through the regular Government Budget or the Public Investment Program.

ELSTAT continues with the regular updating of the Register with the inclusion of new entities, which are classified into General Government according to the ESA95 criteria as well as with the deletion of entities that either are abolished or cease to fulfil the criteria for remaining in the General Government sector.

The present updated Register is slightly modified vis-à-vis that of the previous release (31/12/2012). On the basis of the regular work to keep the Register up to date and consistent with the evolving perimeter of General Government, between October 2012 and December 2012: a new entity was included in the Social Security Funds (SSF) sub-sector (S.1314), another was deleted from the SSF sub-sector as it was merged with an existing entity, and an entity formerly classified in the Extra Budgetary Funds sub-sector (S.1311.2) was reclassified to the Public Hospitals sub-sector (S.1314).

The maintenance of the Register of General Government Entities is an ongoing task. In this context, ELSTAT continues to examine on a regular basis the classification of entities supervised by the General Government taking into account the changes made under the administrative reform and new or updated economic data of these entities, according to the rules of ESA95. ELSTAT is also in constant cooperation with the Ministry of Interior in order to gather the necessary data and complete the classification exercise for all supervised entities of Local Government.
