MUSEUMS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES ATTENDANCE SURVEY **DECEMBER 2014**

ELSTAT announces the results of the Survey on Museums and Archaeological Sites.


During December 2014, museums experienced a 19,3% increase in visitor numbers and a 30,2% increase in their receipts, in comparison with the corresponding month of 2013.

The number of visitors at archaeological sites, in December 2014, recorded an increase of 33,8% and the respective receipts recorded an increase of 35%, in comparison with the corresponding month of 2013 (Table 1).

During the twelve-months of 2014, there was a 22,5% increase in the number of visitors of museums and a 27,9% increase in the respective receipts, in comparison with the corresponding period of 2013.

The number of visitors at archaeological sites, during the twelve-months of 2014 recorded an increase of 21,9% and the corresponding receipts rose by 13,5%, in comparison with the corresponding period of 2013 (Table 2).





EXPLANATORY NOTES

Museums and **Archaeological Sites Survey**

The Survey on Museums and Archaeological Sites Attendance has been producing results since 1970, based on data collected by the Archaeological Receipts Fund (ARF) of the Ministry of Culture. The ARF collects data on the number of visitors and the receipts from the tickets sold in the museums and archaeological sites of the country.

The corresponding data for the Acropolis Museum are available from December 2009 onwards.

Legal Framework Since 1970, the present survey is a continuous one and has been producing results on a monthly and yearly basis in compliance with the Joint Ministerial Decision 15189/B379/73. ELSTAT is tabulating data concerning the museums and the archaeological sites all over Greece.

Reference Period 1/12/2014 to 31/12/2014

Information on tickets

From January 2002 onwards, the number of museums' visitors includes both the visitors who have bought a ticket and the visitors with free admission. From 16-06-1996 onwards, the museums and the archaeological sites all over Greece have a paid admission for all the visitors, Greeks and foreigners, all over the year, except the following dates, which are free admission days:

- 1. National Holidays (25th of March and 28th of October)
- 2. The first Sunday every month during the five month period from 1 November to 31 March
- 3. The 6th of March (in memory of Melina Merkouri)
- 4. The 18th of April (International Monuments Day)
- 5. The 18th of May (International Museums Day)
- 6. The 5th of June (International Environment Day)
- 7. The last weekend of September annually (European Heritage Days)

Free admissions

Free admission for:

- 1. Young persons from EU-countries under 18 years of age, with current identification card to confirm their age
- 2. Students of Universities and of Higher and Technical Education Institutions or equivalent institutions of EU- countries, as well as of Tour Guide Training Institutes, with current student identification card or International Student Identity Card (ISIC)
- 3. Employees of the Hellenic Ministry of Culture with current working identification card
- 4. ICOM and ICOMOS cardholders
- 5. Tour Guides with their current working identification card from the Ministry of Development
- 6. Teachers accompanying pupils and students on primary, secondary and tertiary education institution tours
- 7. Journalists with current journalists' identification card
- 8. Members of Associations and Societies of Friends of Museums and Archaeological Sites
- 9. Official quests of the Greek Government, after relevant approval
- 10. Escorts of blind persons and persons with disabilities
- 11. Free admission cardholders
- 12. Holders of the Culture Card

tickets

Number of flat rate From April 1999 onwards, in addition to the ordinary tickets, a new "flat rate ticket" is established, which is valid for both some museums and the nearby archaeological site. The total number of these flat rate tickets for **December** 2014 is 27.433.
