

Consumption of Petroleum products

The survey of petroleum products is an annual survey, which is based on administrative sources and records (Ministry of Development, Department of Energy & Natural Resources).

Data on consumption of petroleum products were aggregated since 1982 from the Ministry of Development (General Secretariat of Commerce) and published in a form of articles from the National Statistical Service of Greece.

The data of consumption result from the enterprises of trade and the enterprises of filtration and are attended from the Ministry of Development.

In the published indexes are included - from the year 2000 until today - the yearly consumption of petroleum per product and geographical breakdown.

The units of measure are Metric Tones.
