

Data included in this table resulted from the Annual Survey on Production and Sales of Manufacturing Products (PRODCOM).

PRODCOM is the title of the EU production statistics for Mining and Quarrying, Manufacturing and Electricity, Gas and Water Supply, i.e. Sections C, D and E of the Statistical Classification of Economic Activities in the European Community (NACE Rev. 1). The title comes from the French “PRODuction COMmunautaire” (Community production).

The basis of the survey is Council Regulation (EEC) No 3924/91 on the establishment of a Community survey of industrial production (PRODCOM Regulation). In accordance with Article 2(2) of the above-mentioned Regulation, production is to be recorded according to the product headings of the PRODCOM list, which is mainly based on the Union’s External Trade Nomenclature (Combined Nomenclature – CN).

The National Statistical Service of Greece conducts the PRODCOM Survey since 1993.

All manufacturing units with an average employment 10+ persons are surveyed for:

- a) the quantity of production,
- b) the quantity of sales,
- c) the value of sales.

Printed questionnaires are used for the conduct of the survey and the collection method is post or interview.

The data of the survey is available in both paper and electronic form, published nationally and transmitted to Eurostat to be incorporated in EUROPROMS Database.
