4. Statistical presentation

4.1 Data description

The Section of Manufacture, Research and Technology Statistics collects data from the enterprises of the steel industry, pertaining to the:

- 1. Balance sheet of steel and cast iron scrap
- 2. Consumption of Fuel and Energy
- 3. Balance sheet for electric energy
- 4. Expenditure and Investment in the Iron and Steel Industry
- 5. Maximum capacity of the Iron and Steel Industry The data refer to Greece total.

4.4 Statistical concepts and definitions

The basic variables of the survey are:

- Opening and closing stocks
- Products manufactured in the plant
- Receipts of scrap from domestic sources, EU countries and third countries
- Total consumption (blast furnaces and electric iron making furnaces)
- Waste Scrap
- Consumption of solid and liquid fuels, gas by blast furnaces, furnaces and converters and of natural gas
- Gas deliveries

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- Resources from gross output
- Electricity consumption in blast furnaces, in electric furnaces of cast iron, in electric melting shops and _ continuous casting, in rolling mills and finally in power stations
- Fuel deliveries outside the plant
- Investment in coke, cast iron, ferro-alloys and crude steel
- Products obtained by hot rolling (flat and long products)
- Products obtained by cold rolling
- Products covered
- Investment expenditure on acquisition of material goods (coke, iron, ferro-alloys) or plants (melting steel works, rolling mills)
- Actual output of the plant, during the reference year
- Maximum potential capacity, of the plant during the reference year

The statistical unit is the factory manufacturing cast iron and steel products or products classified in the sector 24.5 of Nace Rev.2.

4.6 Statistical population

The survey covers all the steel industries manufacturing cast iron and steel products or products classified in the sector 24.5 of Nace Rev.2.

4.7 Reference area

Greece total.

4.8 Time coverage

The survey is conducted on yearly basis and it was first conducted in 2002. From 2003 onwards the survey results are published on the internet.

5. Unit of measure

The variable "Balance sheet of steel and cast iron scrap" is measured in tonnes; "Consumption of Fuel and Energy» is measured in tonnes and Gigaioules: "Balance sheet for electric energy" is measured in megawatts (MWh); "Expenditure and Investment" is measured in thousand euros and "Maximum capacity" is measured in thousand tonnes.

6. Reference period

The reference period of the survey is one calendar year.

8. Confidentiality

8.1 Confidentiality policy

The issues concerning the observance of statistical confidentiality by the Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) are arranged by articles 7, 8 and 9 of the Law 3832/2010 as in force, by Articles 8, 10 and 11(2) of the Regulation on Statistical Obligations of the agencies of the Hellenic Statistical System and by Articles 10 and 15 of the Regulation on the Operation and Administration of ELSTAT.

More precisely:

ELSTAT disseminates the statistics in compliance with the statistical principles of the European Statistics Code of Practice and in particular with the principle of statistical confidentiality.

8.2 Confidentiality – data treatment

ELSTAT protects and does not disseminate data it has obtained or it has access to, which enable the direct or indirect identification of the statistical units that have provided them by the disclosure of individual information directly received for statistical purposes or indirectly supplied from administrative or other sources. ELSTAT takes all appropriate preventive measures so as to render impossible the identification of individual statistical units by technical or other means that might reasonably be used by a third party. Statistical data that could potentially enable the identification of the statistical unit are disseminated by ELSTAT if and only if:

a) these data have been treated, as it is specifically set out in the Regulation on Statistical Obligations of the agencies of the Hellenic Statistical System (ELSS), in such a way that their dissemination does not prejudice statistical confidentiality or

b) the statistical unit has given its consent, without any reservations, for the disclosure of data.

- The confidential data that are transmitted by ELSS agencies to ELSTAT are used exclusively for statistical purposes and the only persons who have the right to have access to these data are the personnel engaged in this task and appointed by an act of the President of ELSTAT.
- ELSTAT may grant researchers conducting statistical analyses for scientific purposes access to data that enable the indirect identification of the statistical units concerned. The access is granted provided the following conditions are satisfied:

a) an appropriate request together with a detailed research proposal in conformity with current scientific standards have been submitted;

b) the research proposal indicates in sufficient detail the set of data to be accessed, the methods of analyzing them, and the time needed for the research;

c) a contract specifying the conditions for access, the obligations of the researchers, the measures for respecting the confidentiality of statistical data and the sanctions in case of breach of these obligations has been signed by the individual researcher, by his/her institution, or by the

organization commissioning the research, as the case may be, and by ELSTAT.

- Issues referring to the observance of statistical confidentiality are examined by the Statistical Confidentiality Committee (SCC) operating in ELSTAT. The responsibilities of this Committee are to make recommendations to the President of ELSTAT on:
 - the level of detail at which statistical data can be disseminated, so as the identification, either directly or indirectly, of the surveyed statistical unit is not possible;
 - the anonymization criteria for the microdata provided to users;
 - the granting to researchers access to confidential data for scientific purposes.
- The staff of ELSTAT, under any employment status, as well as the temporary survey workers who are employed for the collection of statistical data in statistical surveys conducted by ELSTAT, who acquire access by any means to confidential data, are bound by the principle of confidentiality and must use these data exclusively for the statistical purposes of ELSTAT. After the termination of their term of office, they are not allowed to use these data for any purpose.
- Violation of data confidentiality and/or statistical confidentiality by any civil servant or employee of ELSTAT constitutes the disciplinary offence of violation of duty and may be punished with the penalty of final dismissal.
- ELSTAT, by its decision, may impose a penalty amounting from ten thousand (10,000) up to two hundred thousand (200,000) euros to anyone who violates the confidentiality of data and/or statistical confidentiality. The penalty is always imposed after the hearing of the defense of the person liable for the breach, depending on the gravity and the repercussions of the violation. Any relapse constitutes an aggravating factor for the assessment of the administrative sanction.
