User oriented quality report Annual Survey of Production and Sales of Manufactured Products (PRODCOM)

Generally

The annual Survey of Production and Sales of Industrial Products (PRODCOM) is an annual survey, which is carried out since 1993, pursuant to <u>Council Regulation (EEC) No. 3924/91, of 19 December 1991</u>, on the establishment of a Community survey on industrial production.

The title comes from the French "PRODuction COMmunautaire" (Community Production).

Purpose of the survey – main variables

The main purpose of PRODCOM statistics is the collection and dissemination of statistics on production of industrial products, which takes place in Greece, as well as on the sold production which may take place out of Greece.

The statistical outputs for each industrial product are:

- The physical volume of total production manufactured (in units of measurement as defined in the PRODCOM list) for the reference year,
- The physical volume of production sold (in units of measurement as defined in the PRODCOM list) for the reference year, regardless the time of production,
- The value of production sold (in euros) for the reference year.

Within the PRODCOM framework the following are also recorded:

- Contract processing, per PRODCOM heading (only quantity of production and contractor's payment),
- Industrial services (treatment, repairs and maintenance and assembly work).

Legal basis

The PRODCOM survey is carried out pursuant to <u>Council Regulation (EEC) No. 3924/91, of 19 December 1991</u>, on the establishment of a Community survey on industrial production and to <u>Commission Regulation (EC) No</u> <u>912/2004, of 29 April 2004</u> on the implementation of the Council Regulation.

Statistical classification

The classification of industrial products is based on each year's PRODCOM list. The basic building blocks of the PRODCOM list are the <u>Statistical Classification of Economic Activities in the European Community</u> (NACE Rev. 2), as well as the <u>European Classification of Products by Activity (CPA)</u>. More specifically, the 8-digit PRODCOM headings correspond to NACE Rev.2 at 4-digit level and to CPA 2009 at 6-digit level.

The classification of the 2014 PRODCOM survey was based on the PRODCOM list for 2014 (<u>Commission</u> <u>Regulation (EU) 842/2014, of 4 July 2014</u>) and of the 2013 PRODCOM survey on the PRODCOM list for 2013 (<u>Commission Regulation (EU) No 936/2013, of 12 September 2013</u>)

Coverage of economic activities

The survey covers the divisions <u>07-33</u> of the Statistical Classification of Economic Activities in the European Community (NACE Rev. 2) under sections B (Mining and Quarrying) and C (Manufacturing).

Statistical population (reference population)

The surveyed population are all the active enterprises in sections B (mining) and C (manufacturing) of NACE Rev.2, with an average annual employment of 10 persons and more. However, in some cases, depending on the representativeness of the product and of the turnover, enterprises that employ less than 10 persons are surveyed as well.

The frame used for determining the surveyed units is based on the **Business Register of ELSTAT**, which is updated through the results of surveys conducted by ELSTAT.

Geographical coverage

The whole of the country

Reference period

Calendar year

Unit of measure

The quantity of production and the quantity of sales is recorded in units (kg, g, m², etc.), according to the Prodcom headings on the PRODCOM list of each year. The value of sales is reported in euros.

Publication of data

Prodcom data are available on ELSTAT'S website since 1993.
