

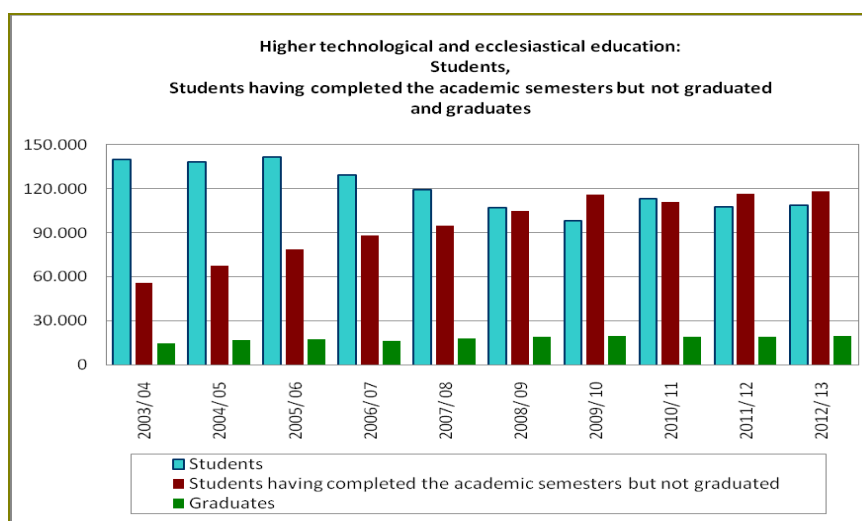

TERTIARY EDUCATION STATISTICS (TECHNICAL SECTOR, ECCLESIASTICAL EDUCATION), MERCHANT MARINE ACADEMIES (AEN) AND HIGHER VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS

Students, institutes and teaching staff: end of academic year 2012/13

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces statistical data on Tertiary Education (Technical Sector and Higher Ecclesiastical Education), Merchant Marine Academies and Higher Vocational Schools (Higher Schools for Services and Artistic Schools) which refer to the end of the academic year 2012/13 and depict the evolution of the main aggregates as follows:

- During the academic year 2012/13, in comparison with the academic year 2011/12, the number of students in Higher Technical Education increased by 1,3% (from 106.104 to 107.519) and so did the number of students in Higher Vocational Education, which increased by 13,5% (Tables 1 and 1a);
- The number of students who have completed the academic semesters but not graduated, amounted to 117.938, recording a 1,4% increase in comparison with 2011/12, (Table 2);
- Teaching staff in Higher Technical and Ecclesiastical Education recorded a decrease of 14,4% in comparison with academic year 2011/12, while the teaching staff in Higher Vocational Education increased by 4,8%. Out of the 15 Higher Technological Institutes (TEI) of Greece, the teaching staff decreased in 14 of them, while it increased only in one of them (Tables 3 και 3a);
- Graduates of Higher Technical Education recorded a decrease of 2,8% in comparison with the academic year 2011/12, with the only exception of graduates in Higher Technological Institutes, where graduates increased, and more specifically by: 16,6% in the TEI of Mesolongi, 8,3% in the TEI of Kriti and by 8,0% in the TEI of Ionian Islands; As regards Higher Ecclesiastical Education and Higher Vocational Education, graduates increased by 9,4% and 8,3%, respectively (Tables 4 και 4a).
- No change was recorded in the number of educational institutes in comparison with the previous academic year and similarly there was no change in the number of faculties – schools and departments (Table 5).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Survey on Tertiary Education: Technical sector, Ecclesiastical Education and Higher Vocational Education	Tertiary Education consists of two main parallel sectors: a) Universities, including: • all the Universities, • Polytechnic Schools and • the Athens School of Fine Arts and b) Technical Sector which encompasses: • the Technological Educational Institutes (TEI) and • the Higher School of Pedagogic and Technical Education (ASPATE). Tertiary Ecclesiastical Education includes the Higher Ecclesiastical Academies. Tertiary Vocational Education includes the Merchant Marine Academies (AEN), as well as the Higher Schools for Services and the Artistic Schools.

Reference period	The data of the survey refer to the end of academic year 2012/2013, yet for comparability reasons the data of the end of the previous academic year 2011/2012 are also stated.
Methodology and coverage	The survey is an annual census survey and is conducted through special questionnaires, namely the forms ΣΕ-10. The survey is conducted by the Hellenic Statistical Authority on all the units of tertiary and higher education of Greece.
