Unemployment rate at 11.3 in January 2010


LABOUR FORCE SURVEY: January 2010¹

Unemployment rate in January 2010 was 11.3% compared to 9,4% in January 2009 and 10.2% in December 2009. The number of employed amounted to 4,445,743 persons while the number of unemployed amounted to 567,132 and the number of inactive to 4,276,258. The corresponding figures for January 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009 $\kappa\alpha$ 2010 are presented in Table 1.

The number of employed decreased by 39,272 persons compared to January 2009 (a 0.9% rate of decrease) and by 11,914 persons compared to December 2009 (a 0.3% rate of decrease).

Unemployed increased by 101,440 persons (a 21.8% rate of increase) compared to January 2009 and by 62,022 persons compared to December 2009 (a 12.3% rate of increase).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Labour Force Survey

Labour Force Survey produces early estimates since 1981 (second quarter of the year). Since 1998 is a continuous quarterly survey. The main statistical objectives of Labour Force Survey is to divide the population of working age (15 years and above) into three mutually exclusive and exhaustive groups - persons in employment, unemployed persons and inactive persons. In addition, Labour Force Survey collects information on demographic characteristics, on main job characteristics, on the existence and characteristics of second job, on educational attainment, on participation in education, on previous working experience and on search of job.

Legislation

Current survey is completely harmonized with European legislation. The principal legal act is the <u>Council Regulation (EC) No. 577/98</u> that stipulates the provisions on design, survey characteristics and decision-making processes. Survey framework was modified in successive Commission regulations. (<u>Regulation (EC) No 1372/2007</u>, Regulation (EC) No 2257/2003, Regulation (EC) No 1991/2002).

Reference Period

December 2009

Coverage

For the monthly estimates, a sub-sample of the quarterly Labour Force survey's sample was used.

Definitions

Employed are persons aged 15 years or older, who during the reference week had worked, even for just one hour, for pay or profit or they have worked in the family business, or they were not at work but had a job or business from which they were temporarily absent.

Unemployed are persons aged 15-74 who were without work during the reference week (they were not classified as employed), were currently available for work and were either actively seeking work in the past four weeks or had already found a job to start within the next three months.

Inactive are those persons who neither classified as employed nor as unemployed.

Economically active population (labour force) are persons that either employed or unemployed

Unempoyment Rate: Is the ratio of unemployed divided by total labour force.

Methodology

Labour Force Survey's estimates are produced by a suitable unbiased estimator which takes in to account a) the probability of selection of every sampled household, b) response rate in every primary sampling unit, c) the estimated population for January 2010, allocated by NUTS II areas, sex and age group).
