A 2,9% rise in the strength of the Greek merchant fleet.

Greek merchant fleet of 100 GRT and over, during August 2009

In August 2009 the strength of the Greek merchant fleet registered a 2,9 % rise in comparison with the equivalent strength of August 2006, while the same comparison between the years 2006 and 2003 showed reduce of 3,6% (see fig. 1).

The overall tonnage of the Greek merchant fleet during August 2009 registered a 21 % rise in comparison with the equivalent strength of August 2006, while the same comparison between the years 2006 and 2003 showed a rise of 2,3% (see fig. 1).

The equivalent changes of the different type of vessels can also be viewed in figure 1.

Development of tonnage of the Greek merchant fleet by categories: 2000 - 2008 & August 2009



EXPLANATORY NOTES

Research of Greek Commercial Fleet Force

The research is held each month from 1964 up to today with no essential changes as for her way of conduct. Aim of the research is the complete recording of statistical elements with regard to the number and the basic characteristics of Greek merchant fleet, so as to show the complete picture of the diachronic development of the Greek commercial fleet force.

Legal frame

The research is held according to the common ministerial decision No. 6792/C - 81/11-4-97 of the ministers of National Economy and Finance and Commercial Navy.

Period of Report

The results of the research are reported in the end of August 2009.

Cover

In the research we have included all the Harbour Authorities of the interior and the Greek Consular Harbour Authorities of the abroad, that observe shipping registers, which dispatch each month in the Greek National Statistical Organisation, the changes of the Greek commercial vessels that are written in their shipping registers.

Definitions

Commercial boat: Is each ship of clean capacity, at least ten GRT, intended to move selfly-reliant in the sea and to perform acts of transportation of persons or things, of fishery, of towage and of each other shipping activity.

Greek commercial fleet: Is the total of commercial vessels that is registered in Greece and belongs to natural or legal entities that live in the Greek territory. The Greek flag of the above boats shows that all the economic and commercial rules with which are carried out their marine activities, as, subsidies of ship buildings, restrictions of loading, reinvestments of dampings and other tax provisions, are determined by the proper Greek authorities. **Gross Registered Tonnage (G.R.T.)**: Is a unit of measurement of the total volume in cubic foot of spaces of loading in the interior of the hull and in the bridge, that are available for the transport of merchandise, food, passengers and crew. One GRT is equal with 2,83 cubic meters or 100 English cubic feet.

Net Registered Tonnage (N.R.T.): Is a unit of measurement, that is received by the Gross Registered Tonnage after the abstraction of volume of spaces that is used by the crew, instruments of navigation and machines, the crude oil and water reservoirs, as well as the volume of other spaces that are not used by the passengers or for merchandise.

Age of the boat: This is determined by the year of manufacture of hull that surrounds the engines.

Methodology

The research is carried out through the inventories of all the Harbour Authorities of the interior and the Greek Consular Harbour Authorities of the abroad, that dispatch in monthly base, to the Greek National Statistical Organization, the changes of boats that concern: a) the registration of new registered boats, b) the denomination of boats, g) the change of ship owning, d) the transfers from other ports, e) the deletion of boats, f) the final measurement – remeasurement of boats, g) the engine change.

These changes are used, after suitable treatment, for the briefing, via special computer program, of the archived Registry of Greek Commercial Ships, by which are produced monthly and annual results.
