# PRESS RELEASE <br> ARRIVALS AND NIGHTS SPENT IN HOTELS, SIMILAR ESTABLISHMENTS AND TOURIST CAMPSITES: 2013 (FINAL DATA) 

According to the survey of ELSTAT on arrivals and nights spent in hotels, similar establishments and tourist campsites, for the total of these establishments, in 2013 compared with 2012, an increase of $10,4 \%$ is recorded in arrivals (Tables 1 and 4) and an 11,0\% increase in nights spent (Tables 2 and 5).
More specifically, in 2013 compared with 2012, an increase of $13,5 \%$ and $13,0 \%$ is observed in arrivals and nights spent by non-residents, respectively (Tables 1-2 and 7-8) and a similar trend is observed for arrivals and nights spent by residents, which increased by $5,0 \%$ and $3,4 \%$ respectively (Tables 1 and 2 ).

The annual occupancy of the bed places in hotels and similar establishments (excluding tourist campsites), which is calculated taking into account the nights spent compared to the bed places that were in operation, was $45,2 \%$ in 2013, compared with $43,2 \%$ in 2012 (Tables 3 and 6).
More specifically, according to the monthly data, $72,6 \%$ of the arrivals and $83,0 \%$ of the nights spent, in hotels, similar establishments and tourist campsites, are recorded during the period from May to September (Tables 1 and 2).
As regards the breakdown of data by region, an increase of arrivals and nights spent in hotels, similar establishments and tourist campsites is observed in all the regions of Greece. A significant increase of arrivals and nights spent, in absolute values, is recorded in the Regions of Attica (18,7\% in arrivals and 9,1\% in nights spent), Crete ( $18,8 \%$ in arrivals and $28,2 \%$ in nights spent), South Aegean ( $17,1 \%$ in arrivals and $24,4 \%$ in nights spent), Central Macedonia (13,1\% in arrivals and $11,2 \%$ in nights spent) and East Macedonia and Thrace ( $3,3 \%$ in arrivals and 2,5\% in nights spent) (Tables 4 and 5).
In 2013, the largest share of arrivals and nights spent in hotels and similar establishments is recorded by customers (guests) whose country of residence is in Europe ( $84,6 \%$ of arrivals and $92,9 \%$ of nights spent). The largest contribution is recorded by the United Kingdom ( $12,1 \%$ of arrivals and $14,4 \%$ of nights spent), Germany ( $11,2 \%$ of arrivals and $15,0 \%$ of nights spent), Russia ( $10,7 \%$ of arrivals and $14,1 \%$ of nights spent), France ( $7,6 \%$ of arrivals and $6,4 \%$ of nights spent) and Italy (5,6\% of arrivals and 4,5\% of nights spent). When comparing the data on arrivals and nights spent by country of residence of the customers (guests) of the year 2013 with the corresponding data of the year 2012, a significant increase of arrivals, in absolute values, is observed, as regards the countries of Europe, from Russia ( $39,1 \%$ in arrivals and $37.2 \%$ in nights spent), the United Kingdom ( $8.0 \%$ in arrivals and $7.1 \%$ in nights spent), Germany ( $7.1 \%$ in arrivals and $9.0 \%$ in nights spent), Turkey ( $54,1 \%$ in arrivals and $48,6 \%$ in nights spent) and France ( $9,3 \%$ in arrivals and $8,6 \%$ in nights spent). Moreover, the corresponding data for the rest of the continents show a significant increase of arrivals, in absolute values, from Asia, with a large contribution of arrivals from the People's Republic of China ( $1,3 \%$ in arrivals and $0,4 \%$ in nights spent) and from America, with a large contribution of arrivals from USA (4,6\% in arrivals and 1,9\% in nights spent) (Tables 7 and 8 ).

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

Arrivals and nights spent at Data on arrivals and nights spent in hotels, similar establishments and camping are collected from a hotels, similar monthly, census survey. Each establishment fills in a questionnaire, for every month that is in establishments and camping operation. It is mandatory for all hotels, similar establishments and camping to participate in the survey.

Legal frame The survey is conducted pursuant to Council Regulation 692/2011 EU.

Reference unit Data refer to all establishments (hotels, similar establishments and camping) that are registered in the Hellenic Chamber of Hotels. ELSTAT receives the register every year and updates its register that is related to the survey.
Coverage The results of the survey refer to about $80 \%$ of the total bed-places that are available. The reason why there is no estimation and projection of the results to $100 \%$ of the reference population is the fact that there is no information on the exact number of months during which each establishment is in operation. The lack of this information makes it impossible to make this estimation for every month and hence for the total of the year.

Data dissemination As regards the annual data there is a press release and summary tables. Data reffer to arivals, nights spent and bed occupancy and are available on a monthly basis, at NUTS 3 level and country of residence of guests.

Reference period January - December 2013 (Final data).

Definitions Resident: a person is considered to be a resident in a country if the person has lived for most of the past year or 12 months in that country (regardless of the citizenship).
Non-resident: a person that does not live in the country (regardless of the citizenship).
Arrivals: The arrivals at the establishments are calculated for every person separately. The data refer to the total number of persons and not to the total number of rooms that were occupied. Only the persons that had at least one overnight stay in the establishment are calculated.

Nights spent: The nights are calculated for every person separately. The data refer to the total number of nights spent by every person and not to the total number of nights spent in every room.
Occupancy of bed-places: The monthly occupancy of bed-places is calculated taking into account the number of the bed-places that were in operation in each establishment. The rate refers to the occupancy that was accomplished, as opposed to the maximum occupancy that is expected according to the available bed-places.
The occupancy of the period is the result of the average occupancy rates of every month of the period, weighted by the bed-places that were in operation for each month.

Methodology This is a monthly, census survey. The data come from the establishments, which fill in a questionnaire (by paper form or on-line application) for every month that each establishment is in operation. During the year ELSTAT updates regularly the register of the hotels, similar establishments and camping, so that the data refer to the actual number of establishments that are in operation. Also, regular reminders for the submission of the data are sent to the establishments, so that ELSTAT can gather as much data as possible.
