## SECONDARY VOCATIONAL AND ECCLESIASTICAL EDUCATION STATISTICS

Pupils, school units and teaching staff: end of school year 2013/2014

ELSTAT announces data on Secondary Vocational and Ecclesiastical Education Statistics as follows:

- During the school year 2013/2014, compared with the school year 2012/2013, school population recorded a 11.3% decrease as regards Vocational Education Schools and a 8.2% increase as regards Ecclesiastical Education Schools (Table 1);
- The pupils who have graduated recorded a 3.7% increase as regards Vocational Education Schools and a 9.9% decrease as regards Ecclesiastical Education Schools (Table 1);
- School units decreased by 7.9% as regards Vocational Education Schools and by 11.8% as regards Ecclesiastical Education Schools (Table 2);
- Teaching staff decreased by 14.9% in Vocational Education Schools and by 5.0% in Ecclesiastical Education Schools (Table 2);
- The ratio of pupils to the teaching staff during the school year 2013/2014 was 7.1 to 1in Vocational Education Schools and 3.5 to 1 in Ecclesiastical Education Schools, while during the school year 2012/13 the ratio was 6.8 to 1 and 3.1 to 1, respectively (Tables 1 and 2).

On the basis of survey data, the Region of Attiki accounts for the largest share of pupils enrolled in Vocational Education Schools with 29.0% and 10.1% in Ecclesiastical Education Schools (Table 1).



Also included "absent teachers". "Absent teachers" are the teachers with a fixed post in the school unit, who are absent for more than 20 days (due to illness, training, maternity leave, etc) and their replacement is pending, as well as the teachers who are seconded to other administrative posts of the Ministry of Education or elsewhere.
 In Ecclesiastical Education there are only public school units which are supervised by the Ministry of Education, Research

and Religious Affairs.

#### Survey on Secondary Vocational Education

Secondary Vocational education encompasses:

- the Vocational Upper Secondary Schools (EPAL) and
- the Vocational Schools (EPAS)

which are supervised by the Ministry of Education. Research and Religious Affairs, by the Ministry of Rural Development and Food, by the Ministry of Health, by the Ministry of Labour, Social Security and Social Solidarity and by the Ministry of Economy, Development and Tourism.

### Survey on Secondary Ecclesiastical Education

Secondary Ecclesiastical Education encompasses:

- Ecclesiastical Lower Secondary Schools and
- Ecclesiastical General Upper Secondary Schools.

#### **Legal Frame**

The Survey is governed by:

- a) Joint Ministerial Decision No 13534/7-5-62 (Government Gazette 174/18-05-62, issue B) signed by the Minister of National Economy and the Minister of National Education and Religious Affairs on "Work programme of the Statistical Service of the Ministry of National Education and Religious Affairs.
- b) Presidential Decree No 226/2000 (Government Gazette 195/8-9-2000, issue A) on "Organization of the General Secretariat of the National Statistical Service of Greece".
- c) Law 3832/2010 (Government Gazette 38/9-3-2010, Issue A): "Hellenic Statistical System Establishment of the Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) as an Independent Authority", as amended and in force.
- d) Law 1566/1985 (Government Gazette 167/30-9-1985, Issue A) "Structure and operation of Primary and Secondary Education and other provisions".
- e) Law 2525/1997 Government Gazette 188/23-9-1997, Issue A) "Unified Upper Secondary School, access of its graduates to Tertiary Education, evaluation of the educational work and other provisions".
- f) Law 3475/2006 (Government Gazette 146/13-7-2006, Issue A) "Organization and operation of the secondary vocational education and other provisions".

# Reference period

The data of the survey refer to the end of school year 2013/2014. For comparability reasons the data of the end of the previous school year 2012/2013 are also stated.

## Methodology and coverage

The survey is an annual census survey and is conducted by the use of special questionnaire, namely the form  $\Sigma$ E-6. The survey is conducted by the Hellenic Statistical Authority on all the educational units of Greece.
