# SURVEY ON SPECIAL EDUCATION SCHOOLS END OF SCHOOL YEARS 2014/2015 AND 2015/2016

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces, for the first time, statistics on Special Education Schools. This survey includes school units of formal education under the competency of the Ministry of Education and the Early Intervention Programmes of ELEPAP (Hellenic Society for the Protection and Rehabilitation of the Disabled Children). More specifically, the survey covers the school units of Pre-Primary/Primary Education (special kindergartens and special primary schools) and of Secondary Education (special lower and upper secondary education schools, special vocational lower and upper secondary education schools and special vocational education and training workshops). On the basis of the available survey data, it is observed that:

- a) The number of school units of Pre-Primary and Primary Education amounted to 290 in the school year 2015/2016 and to 291 in the school year 2014/15. The number of school units of Secondary Education amounted to 140 in the school year 2015/2016 and to 138 in the school year 2014/15 (Table 1).
- **b) Teaching staff,** in the school year 2015/2016, increased by 4.1% in Pre-Primary and Primary Education and by 13.0% in Secondary Education, in comparison with the school year 2014/2015 (Table 2).
- c) The number of **pupils enrolled** in Pre-Primary/Primary and Secondary Education increased by 1.6% in the school year 2015/2016, compared with the school year 2014/2015. Out of the total number of pupils enrolled, male pupils accounted for 66.1% and females for 33.9% in the school year 2015/2016, while the corresponding shares for the school year 2014/2015 were 65.6% and 34.4%, respectively (Tables 2 and 3).
- **d)** The most prevalent **special education need** among pupils enrolled was *intellectual disability,* accounting for 37.1% and 37.9% for the school years 2015/2016 and 2014/2015 respectively, followed by *autism* with 28.9% and 26.9% in 2015/2016 and 2014/2015, respectively (Table 3).
- e) The ratio of teaching staff to pupils was 1 teacher per 2.83 pupils in the school year 2015/2016 and 1 teacher per 3.04 pupils in 2014/2015 (Table 2).
- f) The Region of Attiki, in the school year 2015/2016, accounted for 35.1% of the total number of pupils enrolled in the Special Education School Units of Greece, while in the school year 2014/2015 the corresponding share was 34.8%. The Region of Kentriki Makedonia follows, accounting, in the school year 2015/2016, for 17.3% of the total number of pupils enrolled in the Special Education School Units of Greece, while in the school year 2014/2015 the corresponding share was 17.4% (Table 2).

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More specifically, Table 1 and Charts 1 and 2 depict the number of Special Education School Units in the school years 2014/2015 and 2015/2016.

The following tables and charts depict data on pupil's population and teaching staff in the Special Education School Units of Greece.

Chart 1. Number of school units by type, school year 2014/2015




Chart 2. Number of school units by type, school year 2015/2016





## Survey on Special Education Schools

The special education school units of Pre-primary/Primary and Secondary Education are the following:

- Special Kindergartens
- Early Intervention Programmes of ELEPAP (Hellenic Society for the Protection and Rehabilitation of the Disabled Children) Kindergartens
- Special Primary Schools
- Special Lower Secondary Education Schools
- Special Vocational Lower Secondary Education Schools
- Special Vocational Education and Training Workshops
- Special Upper Secondary Education School
- Special Vocational Upper Secondary Education School

This survey is conducted, on a yearly basis, aiming at collecting data on the number of pupils enrolled, the school units and the number of teaching staff.

### Legal Frame

Regulations 452/2008 and 912/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council.

# Statistical Units

The statistical units are the school units of Special Education.

#### Coverage

Greece total.

## Dissemination of results

The data are posted on a yearly basis on the website of ELSTAT and are published in a relevant Press Release.

# Reference period

The data of the surveys refer to the end of school years 2014/2015 and 2015/2016.

# Methodology and coverage

The survey on Special Education Schools is an annual, census survey, conducted by ELSTAT. The data are collected from the questionnaires that are filled in by the relevant school units and subsequently they are checked and tramsitted to ELSTAT by the releant Directorates of Primary and Secondary Education of the Ministry.
