
SURVEY ON LIBRARIES OF GREECE, 2014

The Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT) announces, for the first time through this Press Release, data of the Survey on Libraries of Greece conducted for the year 2014.

The Survey on Libraries of Greece (excluding school libraries) is a census survey conducted every two years and records important information concerning libraries, such as: their legal status, the type of the library, the existence of branches and mobile units, collections of books, journals and manuscripts, data on personnel, facilities and equipment of the library, library traffic and services provided to readers, classification of library material, information on audiovisual material and on the access of the library to electronic documentation over the Internet.

This survey covers all libraries, excluding school libraries. In 2014, the total number of libraries amounted to 474, encompassing the National Library of Greece, 45 public libraries, 164 municipal libraries and 265 libraries of legal persons (under public and private law). Out of the total number of libraries, 244 are general libraries and 230 are specialised libraries, the majority of which are university libraries. These libraries have 150 branches and 31 mobile units.


As regards library traffic and lending of books, the following comparative data are observed for the years 2014/2012 and 2012/2010:

- a decrease of 1.9 % and an increase of 8.7 %, respectively, in the number of readers — visitors;
- an increase of 3.8 % and a decrease of 1.2 %, respectively, in the number of books lent;
- an increase of 4.3 % and 7.6 %, respectively, in the lending of books for external use;
- a decrease of 48.8 % and an increase of 0.5 %, respectively, in the access of users to electronic databases;
- an increase of 29.9 % and 20.5 %, respectively, in the access of users to websites of libraries (Table 1, Graph 2).

Figure 2. Library traffic- lending of books, 2010, 2012 and 2014




As regards the collections of books, journals and manuscripts the following comparative data are observed for the years 2014/2012 and 2012/2010:

- books: an increase of 1.5 % and 0.7 %, respectively, in titles and an increase of 6.5 % and 1.6 % , respectively, in the number of volumes;
- journals: a decrease of 1.5 % and an increase of 2.6 %, respectively in titles and a decrease of 2.2 % and 0.2 %, respectively, in the number of issues;
- manuscripts: a decrease of 0.8 % and an increase of 3.6 % , respectively, in the number of titles and a decrease of 0.8 % and an increase of 3.4 %, respectively, in the number of volumes (Table 2, Graph 3).

Graph 3: Collections of books, journals and manuscripts of libraries, 2010, 2012 and 2014




With regard to personnel employed in the libraries, when comparing the years 2014 with 2012 and 2012 with 2010, a decrease of 6.9 % and 8.1 %, respectively, is recorded in the total number of personnel employed in libraries. More specifically, the number of “librarians with specialized qualification” fall by 8.1 % and by 4.8 %, respectively, and the “other personnel with library experience” showed a decrease of 3.6 % and 12 % respectively. Finally, a decrease of 6.8 % and 10.9 %, respectively, was observed in the “other personnel” of the libraries.

Legal framework	Law 3832/2010, as amended and in force.
Reference period	The year 2014.
Methodology	It is a census survey.
Information about the survey	“Title” means the name of a work (book, periodical, etc) which may consist of one or several volumes, e.g.
