




## PRESS RELEASE

### PRODUCTION INDEX IN INDUSTRY: September 2013

The Production Index in Industry (IPI) in September 2013 compared with September 2012 recorded a decline of 1.8%. In September 2012, the annual rate of change of the IPI was  $-7.2\%$ .

In the 9-month period from January 2013 to September 2013, the average rate of change of the IPI was  $-3.6\%$ . In September 2012, the corresponding average rate of change of the IPI was  $-4.3\%$ .



Information:

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### **1. Annual rates of change of September 2013 compared with September 2012.**

The IPI in September 2013, compared with September 2012, decreased by 1.8% due to the annual changes of the sub-indices of the industrial sections:

- a. Mining and quarrying production decreased by 2.6%.
- b. Manufacturing production decreased by 4.0%.
- c. Electricity production increased by 6.8%.
- d. Water supply production decreased by 3.8%.

### **2. Average rates of change of the period January - September 2013 compared with January - September 2012.**

The IPI in the 9-month period January – September 2013, compared with the period January – September 2012, decreased by 3.6% due to the 9-month average rates of change of the sub-indices of the industrial sections:

- a. Mining and quarrying production decreased by 8.8%.
- b. Manufacturing production decreased by 1.2%.
- c. Electricity production decreased by 9.5%.
- d. Water supply production decreased by 2.5%.

## METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

<b>Generally</b>	The Industrial Production Index (IPI) is being compiled since 1959.
<b>Purpose of the index</b>	The IPI is an important business cycle indicator, which shows the monthly activity in the Mining-Quarrying, Manufacturing, Electricity and Water Supply sectors. A more specific object of the Industrial Production Index is to compare the magnitude (volume) of the current month's output at any given time with the corresponding figure for a given base period. The IPI shows the evolution of value added, at factor cost, of production, at constant prices.
<b>Legal basis</b>	The compilation of IPI is governed by Council Regulation (EEC) No.1165/98 "concerning short-term statistics". Furthermore, the IPI is governed by the Regulation (EEC) No.1893/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council, by the Commission Regulation (EEC) No.656/2007 and by the Regulation (EEC) No.451/2008 of the Council.
<b>Reference period</b>	Month
<b>Base year</b>	2005=100.0.
<b>Revision</b>	The IPI is a fixed base index. Pursuant to the provisions of Council Regulation No 1165/98 concerning short-term statistics, the index in question is updated every five (5) years in years ending in 0 or 5.
<b>Statistical classifications</b>	At the level of categories of economic activities the new Eurostat classification NACE Rev. 2 was used (Regulation 1893/2006), while at the level of main industrial groups, the allocation of two-digit and three-digit NACE Rev. 2 headings to categories of aggregate classification was used, in accordance with the Council Regulation 656/2007. At product level, the new Eurostat classification CPA 2008 was used, according to the Council Regulation 451/2008.
<b>Geographical coverage</b>	The Index covers the whole country.
<b>Coverage of economic activities</b>	The index covers all the sections of industry, the main industrial groups, all the levels of economic activities (divisions, groups, classes) and the level of products.
<b>Statistical survey</b>	The data are collected from a sample of 1,468 enterprises. The survey covers a total of 349 products and the measurement of the surveyed products is made in terms of output quantities or in terms of production value or turnover, according to the specific situation in each branch of economic activity.
<b>Publication of data</b>	The IPI with the new base year (2005) is being released since March 2009 with January 2009 as first reference month. Data with base year 2005=100.0 are available from January 2000 onwards.
